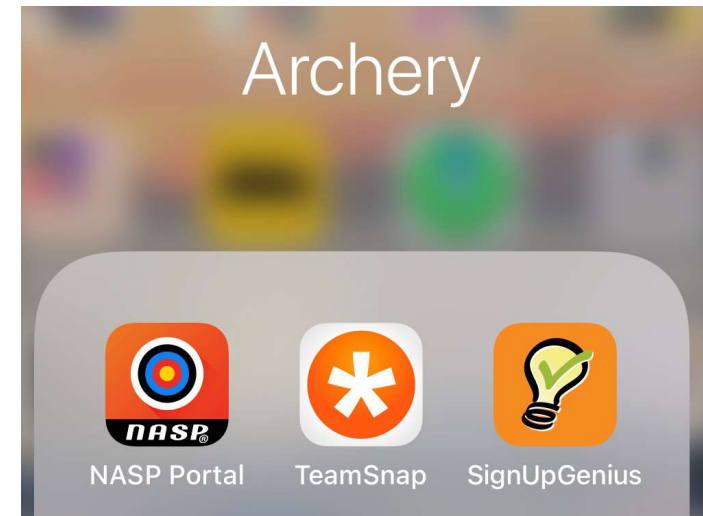

 - Elementary Schools practice @ 5:30 on assigned day below:
 - Hilltop will practice on Mondays,
 - JRE will practice on Tuesdays,
 - South will practice on Wednesdays,
 - West will practice on Thursdays.
 - Middle School (Mon, Tues, Wed) @ 6:45;
 - SignUpGenius for MS to select primary practice day
 - High School Tues @ 7:45.
 - Saturday rostered archers will practice at 9:00am.
- Extra practices over school breaks and Saturdays will be announced pending coaching availability.

Tournament Schedule

- Local Tournaments – schedule to be posted on ArgyleArchery.com
 - Team Mgrs responsible for individual flight times.
 - Coaches will establish minimum schedule.
 - Fee of usually \$15 per tournament payable when signing up for tournaments.
- Travel Tournaments
 - State Belton, TX, March 25 or 26
 - All archers should plan on competing one of the days.
 - State Qualifier in January, a must to attend State
 - Fee included in season registration rate.
 - National Salt Lake City, UT, April 25-26
 - Must shoot a good State Score to qualify.
 - Fee covered by program if attending.
 - Open/Championship Myrtle Beach, SC, June 5-7
 - Two tiers – same Tournament
 - “Open” is open to all archers.
 - “Championship”, must score well at Nationals to qualify.
