### **MENTAL HEALTH**

Mental Health support services are to enable individuals with significant functional limitations to achieve and maintain community stability and independence in the most appropriate least restrictive environment. This service focuses on obtaining independent living skills and is therefore appropriate for older adolescents.

- Services provided by qualified mental health professionals
- Support community stabilization for individuals with significant functional limitations.
- Perform behavioral inventions to stabilize individuals in the least restrictive setting
- Provides daily living support.
  Independent living skills training monitors health, nutrition, and physical condition monitors medication compliance and assists clients with accessing community resources.
- Funded by Medicaid

Mental health support staff will provide training and reinforcement of functional skills. Appropriate behavior related to the individual's health and safety, actives of daily living, use of community resources assistance with medication management, nutrition, and physical condition.



# ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR ADULT MENTAL HEALTH SERVICE.

The individual must demonstrate a clinical need arising from a condition due to mental behavioral, and emotional illness that results in significant functional impairments in major life activities individuals must meet certain criteria on a continuing or intermittent basis.

- Have difficulty in establishing or maintaining normal interpersonal relationships to such a degree that they are at risk of hospitalization, homelessness, or isolation from social support.
- Exhibit such inappropriate behavior that repeated interventions by the mental health services or judicial systems are necessary.
- Exhibit difficulty in cognitive ability such that they are unable to recognize significantly inappropriate social behavior.
- Require help in basic living skills such as maintaining personal hygiene, preparing food and maintaining adequate nutrition or managing finances to such a degree that health or safety is in jeopardy.

### Eligibility for IIH & TDT

Two of the following must be documented for the individual on a continuing or intermittent basis.

- Problems in establishing/maintaining impersonal normal relationships such that they are:
- A. At risk for hospitalization
- B. Out of home placement due to conflicts with family or community.
- Shows such inappropriate behavior that repeated interventions by:
- a. Mental Health
- b. Social Services
- c. Judicial System
