



Player/Parent Code of Conduct Form

Youth sports programs play an important role in promoting the physical, social and emotional development of children. It is therefore essential for parents, coaches and officials to encourage youth athletes to embrace the values of good sportsmanship. Moreover, adults involved in youth sports events should be models of good sportsmanship and should lead by example by demonstrating fairness, respect and self-control.

We therefore pledge to be responsible for our words and actions while attending, coaching, officiating or participating in a youth sports event and shall conform our behavior to the following code of conduct:

1. We will not engage or encourage anyone else to engage in unsportsmanlike conduct with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
2. We will not engage or encourage anyone else to engage in any behavior which would endanger the health, safety or well-being of any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
3. We will not engage or encourage anyone else to engage in the use of drugs, alcohol, or any tobacco product while at a youth sports event and will not attend, coach, officiate or participate in a youth sports event while under the influence of drugs or alcohol.
4. We will not engage or encourage anyone else to engage in the use of profanity.
5. We will treat and encourage others to treat any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee with respect regardless of race, creed, color, national origin, sex, sexual orientation or ability.
6. We will not engage or encourage any other person, to engage in verbal or physical threats or abuse aimed at any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.
7. We will not nor will we encourage any other person, to initiate a fight or scuffle with any coach, parent, player, participant, official or any other attendee.

We hereby agree that if I fail to conform my conduct to the foregoing while attending, coaching, officiating or participating in a youth sports event I will be subject to disciplinary action, including but not limited to the following in any or order or combination:

1. Verbal warning issued by a league, organization or referee official.
2. Written warning issued by a league, organization or referee official.
3. Suspension or immediate ejection from a youth sports event issued by a league, organization or referee official who is authorized to issue such suspension or ejection by a youth sports organization.
4. Suspension from multiple youth sports events issued by a league, organization or referee official who is authorized to issue such suspension by a youth sports organization.
5. Season suspension or multiple season suspension issued by a board of the youth sports organization.
