- The “why” behind the Advisor Meeting - to provide a chance for collaboration between the Advisors of different schools (especially since we are typically singletons)
- Growing Your Chapter
 - Yukon Shares Out Application for NHS Membership Google Form
 - One example of induction process
 - Run GPA report in Aug/Sep
 - Send out Invite Sep/Oct
 - Candidacy Oct - March
 - Induct in April
 - Can have the Faculty Council use a Rubric to score applications before admission
 - Yukon Share Out Membership Contract
 - Add Letters of Recommendation to the Application
- Increasing Chapter Participation & Service Ideas
 - Write participation in Chapter Service projects into your bylaws.
 - Members must participate or be dismissed.
 - Warning Letter for uncompleted service hours
 - Group points versus individual points - Mustang
 - Group points- projects that the chapter does together
 - Individual points- projects that members do on their own
 - Be wary of donation-based service
 - Meeting points - write into bylaws - Mustang
 - Leverage the Officers to recruit student leaders for chapter-based service events - North Rock Creek

- Service Ideas
 - Get IT to put a link to a Google Form for community members to let you know about potential service events (or post on socials) - Mustang & North Rock Creek
 - Reach out to the elementary PTO
 - Book Buddy through elementary before school or after school - Mustang
 - Google Form from Teachers, print out, have NHS students deliver the messages from the teachers to the students - Guthrie
 - Positive Post - Its, write the affirmations on posts, put on desks for in the morning - Yukon
 - Tutoring
 - Be careful about having students miss class time for volunteering events
 - Run eligibility reports to make sure members are in good standing with grades
 - Google Script - Mustang
 - Rostering in IC by making an "Activity" course
 - In whatever ways that coaches can get an eligibility report, have the NHS do the same
