The Alpha Chapter & Youth were able to attend the Political Activism talk with state Rep. Darisha Parker.

Representative Parker is the prime sponsor for House Bill 1100. This Bill is to create a grant program to provide eligible public-school entities with funding to acquire and distribute menstrual hygiene products at no expense to students. It would also authorize the Pennsylvania Dept of Human Services and Health to apply for a federal waiver to allow people receiving SNAP and WIC assistance to purchase menstrual hygiene products with program funds.

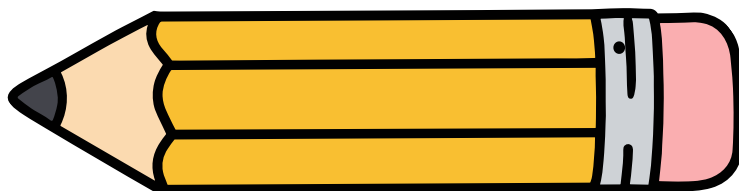
