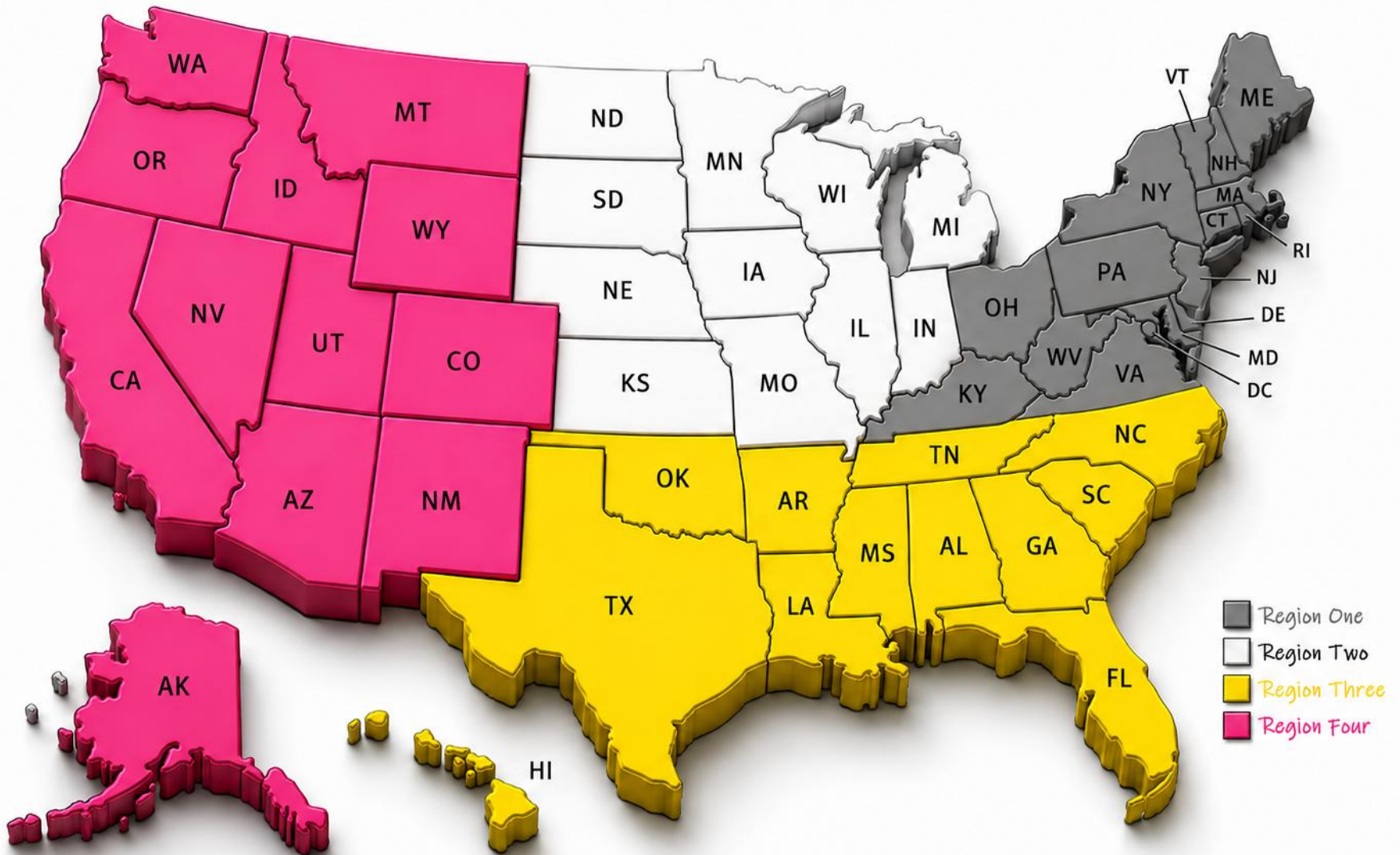

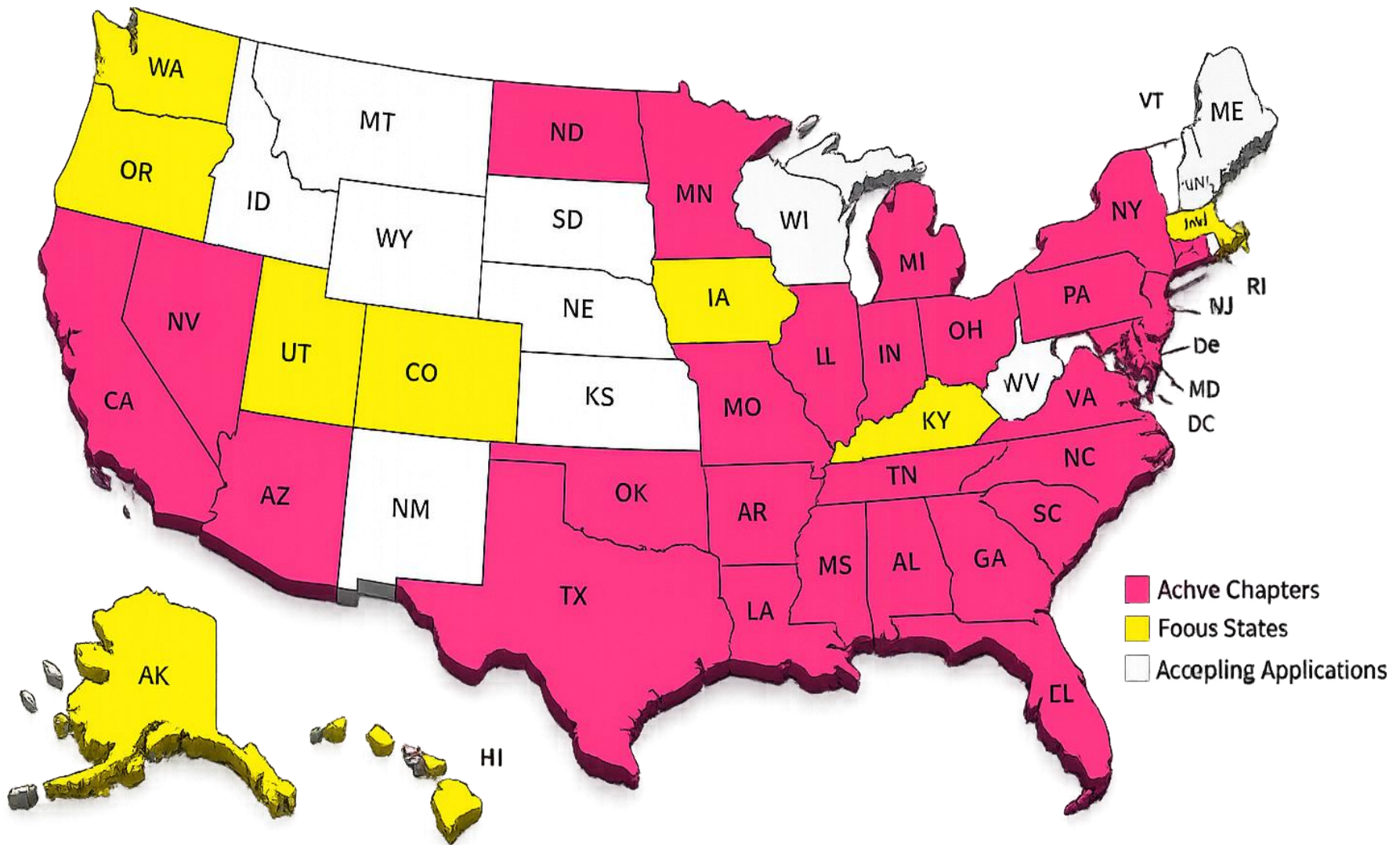

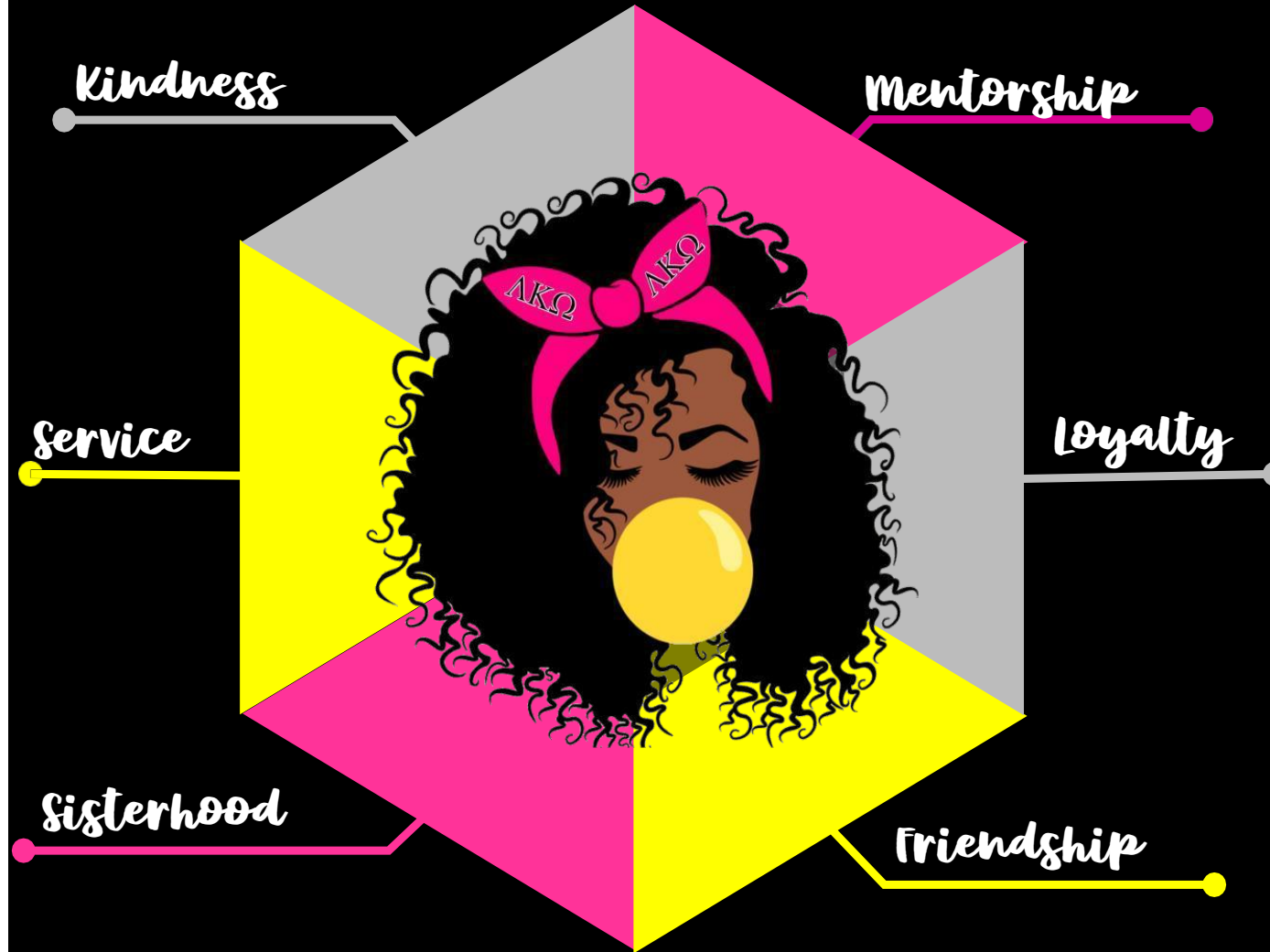
Why ΛΚΩ

Unestablished chapters

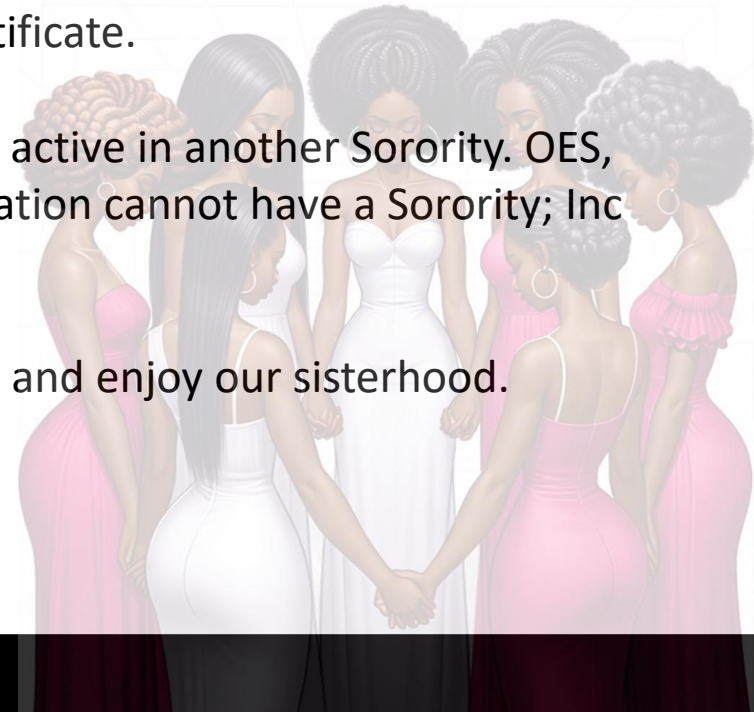
Membership Requirements

We keep our membership intake and initiation rituals private. In no way will we degrade your character for “Letters”. We have a standard membership recruitment and intake process during which interested ladies learn the history and values of Lambda Kappa Omega. Interested ladies will participate in activities designed to cultivate sisterly bonds. Lambda Kappa Omega has a very high retention rate! We Do Not Give our LETTERS away! They must be earned! We believe that “If it’s earned, it is appreciated more!

Lambda Kappa Omega does not have age limitations for persons interested in collegiate chapters. Women wishing to join our non-collegiate chapters must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or an accredited certificate.

Lambda Kappa Omega does not accept women currently active in another Sorority. OES, Links, and other sisterhoods are acceptable. The Organization cannot have a Sorority; Inc this includes Divine Nine Organizations.

We encourage people of all ages and nationalities to join and enjoy our sisterhood. However, we do not use the term Multicultural Sorority.



Youth Programs



Kappa Gamma Omega Youth Sorority was founded in 2007 as an extension of Lambda Kappa Omega Sorority, for girls ages 13-17. Through this sorority, the girls will participate in social and environmental programs while preparing for future endeavors through service, sisterhood, and scholarship.



Lambda Crystallites is a non-profit organization that enhances girls from ages 7-12 on embracing their internal and external image through sisterhood, friendship, and knowledge. While participating in a social environment, the young ladies are being prepared for their current and future endeavors.



The Future Crystallites Program was established in 2018. For girls ages 4-6 with Mothers, Grandmothers, and Aunts who were members of Lambda Kappa Omega. Since then, the program has opened to all youth.
