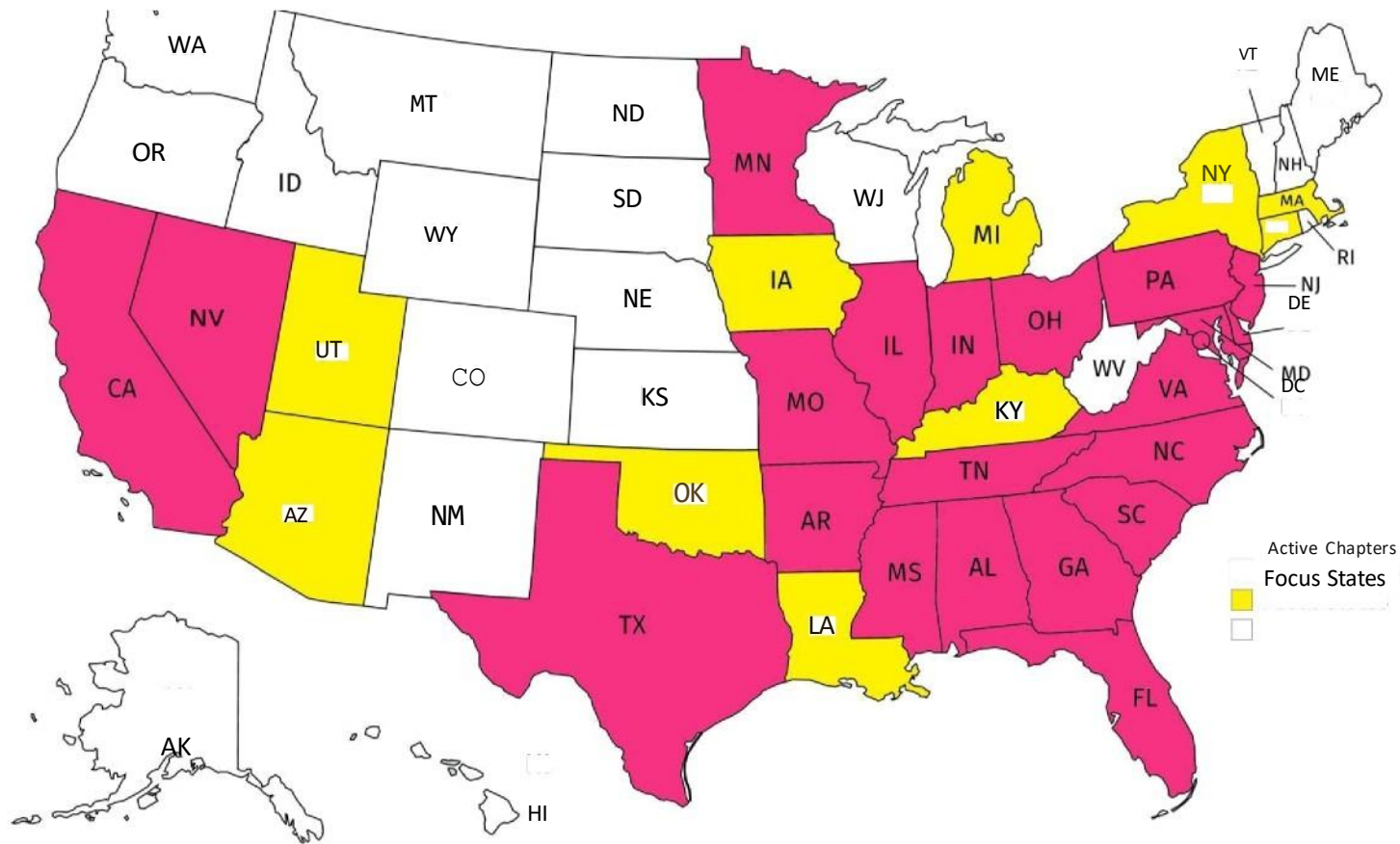

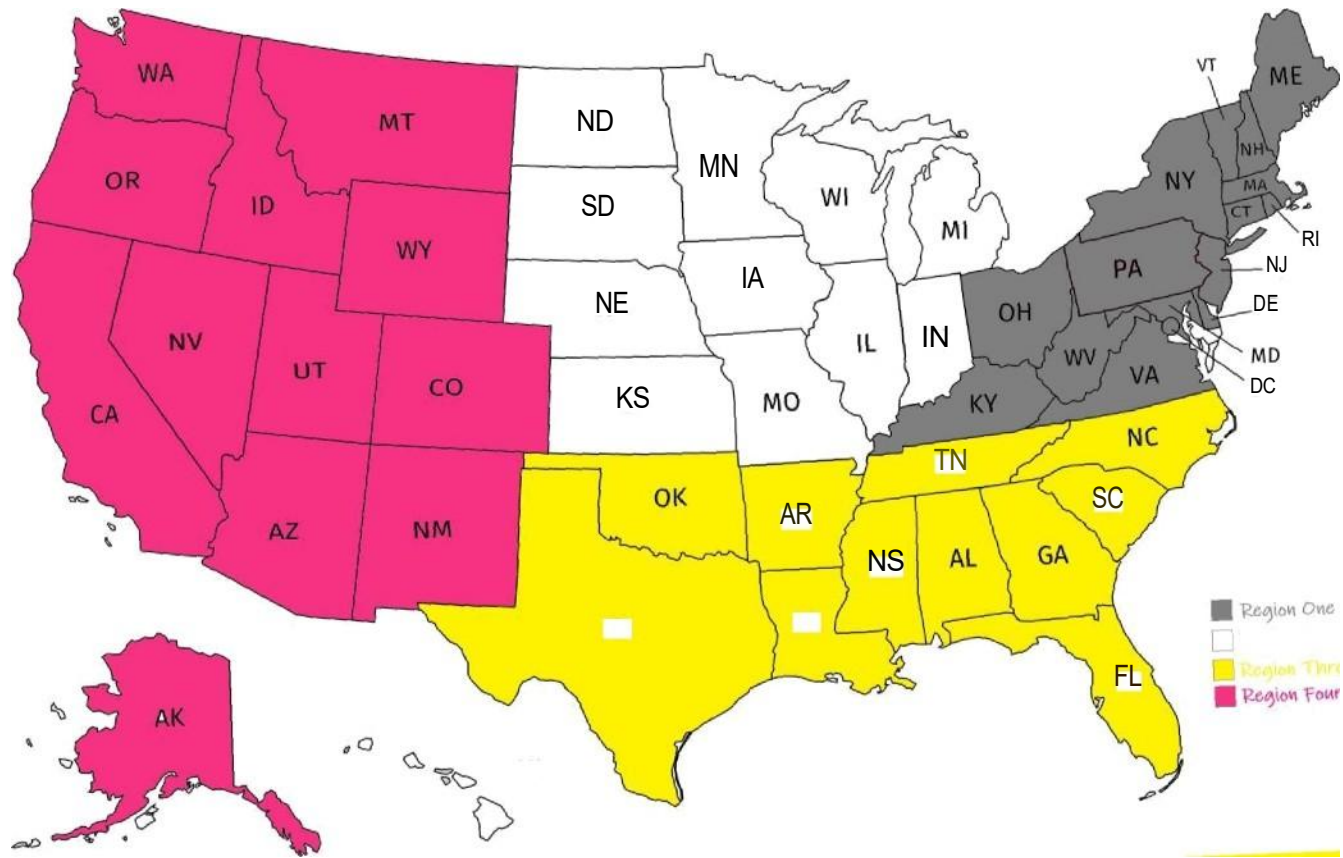

Trailblazers....

- Lambda Kappa Omega does not have age limitations for persons interested in collegiate chapters. Women wishing to join our non-collegiate chapters must be at least 18 years of age and have a high school diploma or accredited certificate.
- Lambda Kappa Omega does not accept women currently active in another Sorority. OES, Links, and other sisterhoods are acceptable. The Organization cannot have a Sorority; Inc this includes Divine Nine Organizations.
- We encourage people of all ages and nationalities to join and enjoy our sisterhood. However, we do not use the term Multicultural Sorority.

WHAT TO EXPECT FINANCIALLY

Fees and Obligations Include

Application Fee \$25.00 (One time Fee)

Membership Fee \$400.00 (One-time Fee)

Ceremony/ Shipping Fee /Test Fee \$100.00 (One time Fee)

Membership Renewal \$100-\$150 (Annual)

Ceremony Garb -The Intake Coordinator will give details (\$75-\$100)

National Conference (\$250-\$675+ lodging & Travel) Based on your Selection

To help offset the cost we offer the Double Goods Fundraiser for the Conference

We receive 50% of goods sold. The sorority has sold over 25k in popcorn

If you do not attend the Conference, funds will go to the General Conference Fund, Youth Fund, and the local chapter you will be joining. Popcorn sales can also be used for the Ceremony/ Shipping Fee /Test Fee.

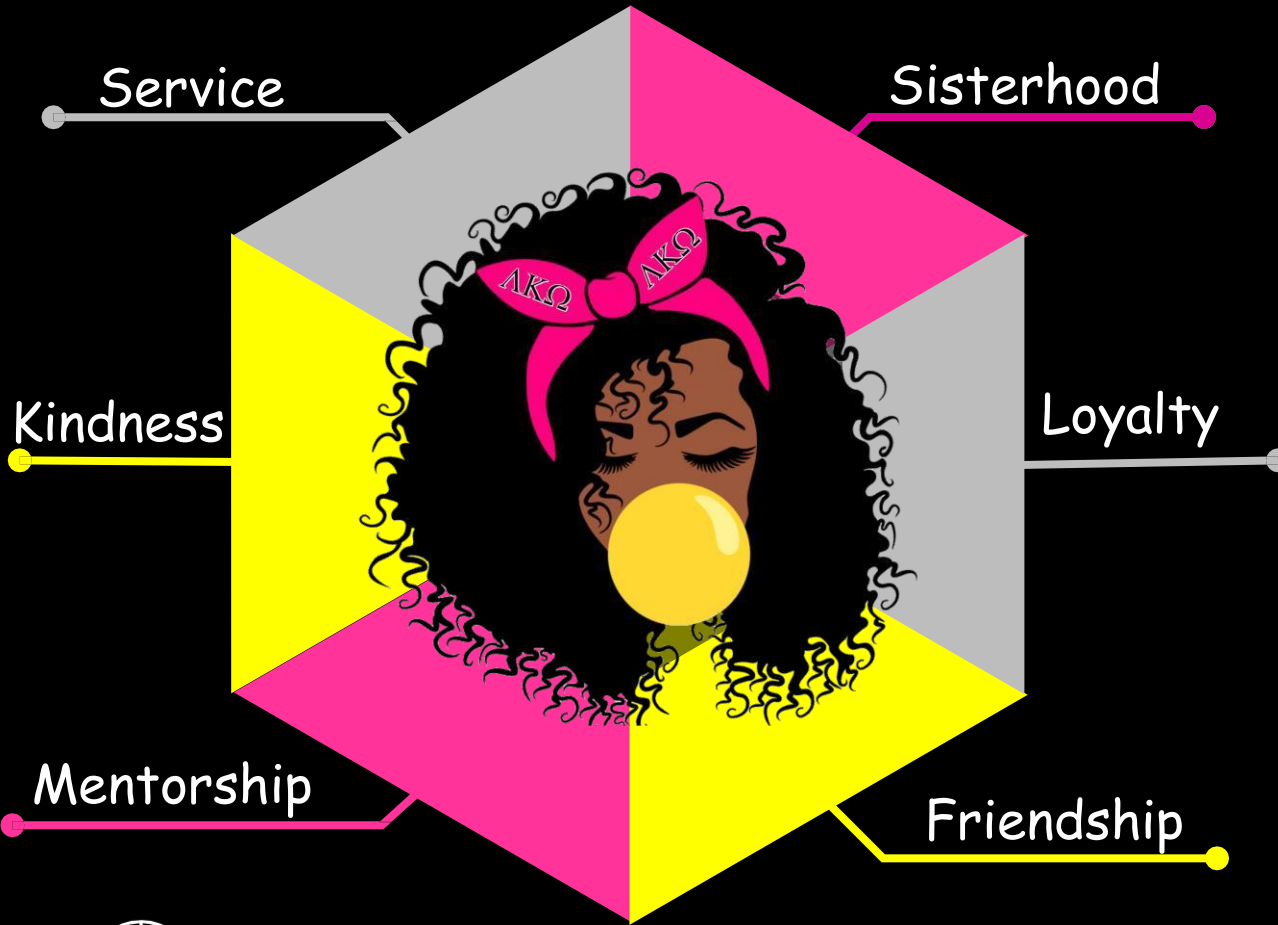
