**I Head:** What is the key to sharing the Gospel?

1) Whose work is it? Luke 10:2 / John 4:34-38, 6:63 / Acts 4:24-31

2) If the Gospel is good news, then what's the bad news? Romans 2:11-24, 11:16-22

3) What shall we take with us? Hosea 10:12-13, 14:1-4 / Luke 3:7-14

Principle question: If God saved everyone you prayed for yesterday, would there be anyone new in heaven? Statement of faith: Jeremiah 3:22-23

**II Heart:** What did the Apostle Peter do?

4) Does he start with a promise of salvation? Acts 2:14-36

5) What is the crowds' reaction? Acts 2:37 Who convicts sinners? John 16:7-11

6) How does Peter deal with the crowds' godly sorrow? Acts 2:38-42

Principle question: How do you talk to someone about God's righteous judgment of sin? Statement of faith: Acts 4:8-12

**III Hands:** What must we do beyond speaking the Gospel?

7) Do we walk the walk? 1 Timothy 4:12 / Titus 2:7-8 / 1 John 3:17-18

8) Do we talk the talk? Matthew 12:33-37 / Ephesians 4:29 / James 3:3-12

Principle question: How can you show that the cross is a sign of how seriously we should take our actions, that it's more than just our justification? Statement of faith: Titus 2:11-14

**IV Feet:** If you show no hope, who will ask you to explain?

9) Do we have the joy of the Lord? Psalm 63:1-11 / Romans 15:13 / 1 Peter 1:3-9

10) Looking at Paul's testimony, Acts 22:1-22, 26:2-23

Principle question: Does your testimony reflect that you are working for Jesus? *Statement of faith:* Ephesians 2:10
