



PROGRAM DESCRIPTION

Essential in winning souls to Christ is the ability to share the Gospel, how to be saved, when and wherever. We use a symbolic system to help disciples testify to Christ's saving grace even when "surprised" by unexpected questions. The new disciple is walked through choosing the symbol that speaks of salvation to them, then placing that symbol next to those Scriptures in their Bible in a sequence, or road map, that can lead another to faith in Christ.

HOW TO - creating a symbol, putting it in your Bible and on bookmarks

We're all familiar with highway, stop, and yield signs. Signage makes up a natural part of our lives and by shape and color convey instant meaning. Shape, color, even placement matter in signage, so then we teach disciples to check out the Gospel path to Christ. First, we ask them to consider what sign or symbol (keeping it simple enough to draw small) would most suggest to them the saving grace of our God and savior, Jesus Christ? Once they have their symbol, we have them work on their path to Christ. They can use the first lesson they receive from Table Time, or those Scriptures most meaningful to them for salvation. Once they have their "road" they install their signage in sequence from first to last. At each sign they reference the next sign's location (tip include page number), marking each with their symbol or sign. Another good practice is to place the entire road map list in either the front or rear of the Bible for quick reference (tip, include page numbers).

PASS IT ON

This simple program is a way for the disciple to always be ready, in season and out of season (when tired, distracted, or surprised), to preach the good news coherently, fully showing the love of God towards the world, for which Christ died and was raised that He might bring salvation to those called to be sons and daughters of the Most High.

This symbol you will remember the rest of your life and prayerfully use many times over.
