## VOLUNTEER REQUIREMENTS

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Dear Prospective Member,

The St. Clair Fire Protection District is an expanding and ever-growing department, with ever increasing demands. We would like very much to have interested people involved in helping us to provide the services to the community. Hopefully, you could be part of our organization.

We demand a lot from our members, and therefore, we try to give them as much as we possibly can. We will provide the best training and equipment that we have available to us and always strive to improve at all times. The Fire Service is a field that is ever changing and training is very important.

It is our hope that you will read and ask any question you might have. We hope you will join our TEAM. Please, don't be afraid to ask any questions.

### **REQUIREMENTS: "AS OF JANUARY 1, 2013"**

- 1) Attend "MINIMUM" eight (8) hours of District approved training per month. Training day/times as follows;
  - A) Saturday 9:00 A.M. (0900 hours)
  - B) Monday 7:00 P.M. (1900 hours)
  - C) Wednesday 9:00 A.M. (0900 hours)
- 2) We expect you to put in a "MINIMUM" twenty-four (24) hours per month at the firehouse, over and beyond the training sessions. It is suggested that you periodically switch firehouses (House 1 and House 2). These hours would be time spent at the firehouse. The twenty-four (24) may be broken down into four (4) hour increments. During this time you will work along side Full-time staff members and completing the "RED BOOK". ***Red book must be completed prior to responding to any emergency calls.*** Anything less than twelve (12) hour shift "SHALL" be completed between the hours of 6:00 A.M. and 6:00 P.M.
- 3) Required to attend: "MINIMUM" of two (2) Public Relation events in a calendar year.
- 4) Upon completing "Red Book," respond to alarms so you may utilize the training you have gained through the training sessions.

**NOTE: Failure to meet these requirements for one (1) quarter is grounds for dismissal from the department.**

If you are accepted you will need to present copies of the following:

1. Drivers' License
2. Social Security Card
3. Any Professional license
4. Current EMS Cards
5. High School Diploma/Missouri Options/GED
6. Fire/EMS Certifications
7. Military Discharge form DD-214
