# **IT'S TIME FOR ACTION!**

- In 2022, more than 42% of pastors gave serious consideration to quitting the ministry (Barna).
- About 25% of Americans identify as practicing Christians (Barna, WSJ), a decline of 50% in the last 20 years.
- As many of the major institutions of our society are fracturing (media, politics, academia), the church is under attack, often perceived as judgmental, exclusive, and irrelevant.
- Some thriving, mission-focused churches are perpetually relevant, making a difference in people's lives and in their communities. In doing so, they provide a Christ-centered model for the reform of the church.
- We exist to help churches thrive.

- We are a team of Pastors and retired Pastors, Seminary Professors, Christian Business Leaders, Certified Coaches and Psychologists.

#### HOW WE HELP

- We provide individual weekly coaching, support, and assessments for each pastor as they lead change and manage complexities in their congregations.
- We work individually with each church to create, equip and inspire disciples who envision, structure and launch programs that powerfully impact their communities, our society, and the world.
- We collaborate with other Christian organizations to provide resources to our churches beyond the scope of our services.

# OUR REACH

- We started recruiting churches in June 2023 and, thanks to God and the generosity of our donors, began our program of workshops and coaching with 44 churches in October 2023.
- Currently, DRC churches are in Texas, Minnesota, Ohio, Iowa, and South Dakota.
- The membership of these churches combined exceeds 36,000 disciples.
- Denominations currently served include Baptist (Converge), Presbyterian, Evangelical Free, Episcopal, and Non-Denominational Churches.
- We currently have a waiting list of 100+ churches. Expanding our donor base to be able to serve them is one of our top priorities.
