#### SUMMARY OF EVENTS

- Date of Massacre: 30 Aug 2021
- Context: 35 men were in negotiations with Taliban via local clergy elders.
- Who was Killed: Mostly Directorate of Nat. Security Officers, under command of Colonel Mohammad Azim Sedaqat (<a href="https://www.esample.com/security-blocks-nature-12">https://www.esample.com/sec
- Terms: Agreement confirmed to surrender weapons and vehicles to Taliban in exchange for immunity.
- Taliban Players: Included Mohammad Ali Sedaqat (Commander in Province), Mulla Aminullah (Governor of Daykundi Province), Mawlavi Shir Mohammad, Mawlavi, Saad Mohammed, and Jamhor
- Events: Surrendered weapons and vehicles as agreed. Hands tied upon surrender. Once unarmed and bound, Taliban began executions. Prisoners fled resulting in Taliban firing small arms and RPGs indiscriminately into Spargag village.
- Number of confirmed dead: 13 total; 2 civilians and 11 Nat. Security Officers.

- 2. Before the Taliban everything was normal, we lived our life normally in Kabul city. I was working as English Teacher and recently started working as a skills trainer, besides this it was to complete my master's degree but unfortunately Afghanistan fell to the Taliban and everything changed overnight, we lost everything.
- 3. I was working in U.S Department of State founded project as Research Consultant& Interview Facilitator. During my time I interviewed the selected participants about, peace, security, government services and international aid and moreover, I have surveyed 500 people in Kabul city about insecurity reasons, challenges of foreign visitors and government services.
- 4. When evacuation process stated I took my document and went to the Airport, three times I have tired but the Taliban and 01 National Force didn't allow me to reach foreign troops, show my document. Because I am from Hazara ethnic minority that's why they didn't allow me to the Airport. Systematic discrimination against Hazara people is not new it has a long story more than a century. Taliban and ISIS-PK consider Hazara people their sworn enemy and target them directly.
- Owening well- founded fear of prosecution, colonel Mohammad Azim Sedaqat who used to work as Ant-Terrorism Manger at National security in Daykundi province alongside 11 other national security officers went to a remote area, the Taliban contacted him to hand over all weaponries and vehicles he accepted provided they insure their amenity, after agreement they were to come in appointed location but against the agreement on Monday, 30 August, Taliban surrounded them and massacred 13 national security officers and a civilian in Daykundi province of Afghanistan. My uncle along with some of his men could flee and now living covertly in unknown place. After the painful tragedy the Taliban has included our name on under prosecution list, so we all left our homes and living in hiding. Following are the details:

There of them were my closed relative.

- 1. Because of the Taliban is looking for all of us to prosecute and by this pressures on to give up. If the Taliban reach us surely kill us.
- 2. We are 10 people living in a small room in a very bad situation. Because there is not job, no security and no financial rescuers, every member of my family are suffering of fear and depression. Just my nephew is 2 years old others are above 18.


#### Summary from previous slide

## Written statement of massacre by Mohammad Azim Sedaqat



- Survivor of Massacre
- Currently in Hiding with Wife and Three Children in



We 35 personnel of Daykundy National Security, left the province and went to Khider District, Dahan-e-e Qul village, and from there we contacted to Mawlavi Shir Mohammad and Mawlavi Saad Mohammad the Taliban Disarmament commission in charges to hand over our weaponry and vehicles and in rerun receive immunity letter of the Taliban, but Mulla Aminullah the governor of Daykundy with interference of Mohammad Ali Sedaqat an irresponsible armed commander and Jamhor the governor's advisor alongside 350 others attacked on us and 11 national security personnel and two civilians (a man and a girl) were killed though they turned over. I want from international community and human rights organizations retribution of the main factors of this tragedy.

#### ADDITIONAL STATEMENT BY MOHAMMAD AZIM SEDAQAT, NDS



•my said: for 10 days we were in contact with the Taliban to negotiate, we came to an agreement to hand over 35 weapons and 7 vehicles provided that gives us immunity letter. The governor said i will send the Red Unit ( it is like special force and so dangerous) to receive the weaponry and vehicles. then I said, don't send the Red Unit because makes worry people, but Mohammad Ali Sedaqat changed governor's mind. we were going to visit another colleague, suddenly the Taliban arrived back of us with 20 cars and 350 fighters, the Taliban first shotted a RPJ which killed a girl, then continued firing, I ordered the troops to escape and separated, one group ( 11 who were killed) escaped among houses, then gave up escaping and hand over their guns and killed them all

As reported on August 30, 2021, Taliban shot dead 14 people belonging to the Hazara community in Khadir District of Afghanistan's Daykundi Province. Among those killed are 12 soldiers, who reportedly surrendered, and two civilians.


#### **Elaat Roz (Daily Kabul Newspaper)**

Local sources in Khadir district of Daikundi province say 14 people, including two civilians, have been killed by Taliban insurgents in the district. A resident of the scene, who spoke on condition of anonymity, told the daily Al-Ittihad-e-Rooz that the Taliban had arrested and then shot and killed 12 members of a large number of honest individuals, former government soldiers who had tried to surrender to the group. Two civilians, including a girl, were also killed by the Taliban during the clashes, according to the resident. He added that "General Sedaghat Pashturq" commanded Taliban forces during the clashes. He is one of the local Taliban commanders.

Local media in Daikundi also confirmed the killing of 14 people, including two civilians, in Khadir district. Siddiqullah Abed, the Taliban's police chief for Daikundi, denied in a statement to Nasim Radio that former government soldiers and civilians had been killed.


