The Empowering Ahtna and Copper Basin Communities: Advancing Sustainability, Workforce Development, and Climate Resilience Project Area Map shows Census Designated Places (CDPs) for AITRC's participatory federally-recognized Tribal communities: Cantwell, Cheesh'na (Chistochina), Chitina, Gakona, Gulkana, Kluti-Kaah (Copper Center), Mentasta [Lake], and Tazlina. The Area Map also shows CDPs for three neighboring communities: Glennallen - the proposed project location (Inset A), the current AITRC location (Inset B), Glennallen Schools and Prince William Sound College - Copper Basin Extension Campus (Inset C), Slana - Slana School (Inset D), and Kenny Lake - Kenny Lake K-12 School (Inset E). The communities are part of three census blocks (IDs: 020660001001, 020660001002) on the EPA IRA Disadvantaged Communities map, which span over 36,000mi². The location of the Environmental and Food Security Complex is highlighted in inset A, as well as within the community site plan.
