Fusion High School Leadership Program

The Fusion High School Leadership Program encourages young people to follow Jesus passionately by developing the disciplines of Biblical and academic study, prayer, and Christian service through involvement in The Way Christian School. The Fusion program recognizes the student as a homeschool student independent of The Way Christian School's academics.

This program is designed for mature Christian high school students who are able to work independently and are self-driven to accomplish goals and tasks.

The family of the student will purchase curriculum or pay independently for the online tuition for the high school student and provide all academic supplies needed for their studies. Curriculum must be approved by The Way Christian School. The curriculum must be an organized course of study. Parents are responsible for grading and the completion of all coursework.

The family will pay a monthly fee for the 9 months of the school year. Please contact us for current tuition rates.

The teacher will assist the student in overall planning (not lesson planning) and organizing their studies as well as offer support when needed. The teacher can help with curriculum choices and planning for the correct high school credits that each student requires. Meeting the minimum requirements for graduation is the responsibility of the parents and student. A parent must submit a copy of the student's academic progress including grades and the percentage of total course completion. These reports will be submitted quarterly.

The teacher's priority is to his/her k-8 students therefore it is imperative that the high school student be a diligent, motivated worker.

The High school student will be allocated 75% of the school day hours to their academic work. The remaining 25% of the school day will be spent serving the students and teachers as a volunteer. These hours can be used on college and other applications.

Each student is different and has been blessed with a different set of gifts. With this in mind, the type of service will vary for each high school student. The teacher will work with the student to organize a daily routine with the high school student. Jobs may include grading, tutoring, teaching art or pe, story time, working on special projects, etc.

Daily attendance is of utmost importance to the high school student and to the the others at the school. Attendance will be recorded and the absence policy will reflect that of the other students.

Each student must apply for the program by filling out the application forms and submitting them to the school.

Parents must sign the Fusion program acknowledgement page and turn into the school office.
