

## What is an Event Chair?

---

An event chair is a parent or teacher who oversees a PTO event. The chair is given a budget and support from the PTO Board so that they can successfully run an event. The chair collects parent/teacher volunteers, organizes the event, makes a flyer, buys supplies, sets up the event, attends the event, etc.

## I'm nervous to Chair...

Most chairs come on as co-chair first so they can be a part of the process while still being able to ask a lot of questions. If you feel nervous but are interested in an event you can volunteer to Co-chair so you can get familiar with the event.

## Can I Chair with a Friend?

Yes! We are happy to have more than one chair for an event. In fact some events really require more than 1 chair. Holiday Family Fun Night for example takes many chairs!
