Anesthetic and surgical procedure(s) to be performed:	
I, the undersigned owner or agent of the pet identified above, authorize the staff of Bayshore Animal Hospital to perform the above procedure(s). I understand that a non-refundable deposit of \$75.00 is required prior to scheduling any surgical procedure. Bayshore Animal Hospital will absorb this deposit if cancellations or changes are not made at LEAST 24 hours in advance, and a new deposit will be required upon rescheduling.	
I understand that some risks always exist with anesthesia and/ or surgery and that I am encouraged to discuss any concerns I have about those risks with the attending veterinarian before the procedure(s) is/are initiated.	
I understand that the attending veterinarian will make every effort to contact me regarding treatment in the case of unforeseen emergencies. If unable to contact me, the staff may or may not have my permission to proceed with life sustaining procedures:

By checking [yes] above, I understand that in order to administer life-saving medications intravenously as easily and quickly as possible, my pet may have an I.V. catheter placed prior to undergoing anesthesia at an additional fee. While I accept that all procedures will be performed to the best of the abilities of the staff at this hospital, I understand that no guarantee or warranty has been made regarding the results that may be achieved.	
I also assume full responsibility for any additional expenses incurred after the surgical procedure is performed, such as follow up radiographs, re-check physical exams and additional surgery due to post-op complications. These are more likely to occur when there is a failure to comply with the aftercare instructions.	
A complete physical exam will be performed on your pet prior to the surgical procedure if it has been longer than 30 days since the last exam. However, this may not identify all systemic or metabolic problems. For this reason, it is strongly recommended that your pet have an age-appropriate pre-anesthetic blood panel to evaluate major organ functions prior to anesthesia.	
All hospitalized patients will be free of fleas. If your pet is found to have fleas, it will be treated with Capstar. This flea treatment will be added to your bill.
