SYSTEMS AND COMPATIBILITY

SURFACE PREPARATIONS

Suitable for aluminium vessels.
Use in accordance with the standard Worldwide Marine Specifications.
All surfaces to be coated should be clean, dry and free from contamination.

High pressure fresh water wash or fresh water wash, as appropriate, and remove all oil or grease, soluble contaminants and other foreign matter in accordance with SSPC-SP1 solvent cleaning.

Consult your International Paint representative for the system best suited for the surfaces to be protected.

MAJOR REFURBISHMENT

Interspeed 376 should always be applied over a recommended primer. The primer surface should be dry and free from all contamination, and Interspeed 376 must be applied within the overcoating intervals specified (consult the relevant product data sheet).

REPAIR

Aluminium substrates should be abrasive blasted using aluminium oxide, or other metal free abrasive to give a surface profile of 25-50µ. The blasted surface should then be recoated before visible oxidation occurs. Clean the entire area with close high pressure fresh water washing using a fan-jet lance held close to the surface (3,000 p.s.i., 211 kg/cm²) as soon as the vessel enters dock and before it dries out. Consult International Paint for alternative methods of surface preparation. Areas of breakdown, damage etc., should be prepared to the specified standard (eg. Sa2½ (ISO 8501-1:2007)) and primed prior to the application of Interspeed 376. Apply Interspeed 376 within the overcoating interval specified for the primer (consult relevant primer data sheets).

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LIMITATIONS

If the following maximum recommended exposure times before flooding are exceeded, antifouling performance may be impaired:

Temperate conditions - 3 months

Tropical conditions - 28 days

It is recommended in this case that the surface be high pressure fresh water washed prior to immersion. On immersion, Interspeed 376 will exhibit little colour change. However, on exposure, the product will darken in colour, depending on exposure period and climatic conditions.

Overcoating information is given for guidance only and is subject to regional variation depending upon local climate and environmental conditions. Consult your local International Paint representative for specific recommendations. Apply in good weather. Temperature of the surface to be coated must be at least 3°C above the dew point. For optimum application properties bring the material to 25-30°C, unless specifically instructed otherwise, prior to mixing and application. Unmixed material (in closed containers) should be maintained in protected storage in accordance with information given in the STORAGE Section of this data sheet.
