Newcastle Yowies will provide a 3m x 3m marquee. Stallholders are required to supply their own power.

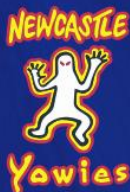

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Stallholder Terms & Conditions

Fees: Fees are charged per 3m x 3m site based on the selected option above. Payment details will be provided to successful applicants following acceptance of their Expression of Interest.

Public Liability Insurance: A current Certificate of Currency for Public Liability Insurance must be provided to secure your booking.

Cancellations: No refunds will be provided for cancellations.

Allocated Area: Stallholders must trade only within their allocated site. Site locations are determined by event organisers and cannot be changed during the event. All sites must be left clean and tidy at the conclusion of the event.

Site Set-Up: Stallholders are responsible for ensuring their stall is established and operated in a safe and professional manner and complies with all applicable safety requirements.

Power: All stallholders are responsible for supplying their own power. Any generators, leads or other electrical equipment brought onto the event site must comply with applicable safety requirements.

Risk Assessment: Each stallholder is responsible for identifying and managing risks associated with their stall, activities, equipment, products and operations.

Directions: Stallholders and vendors must comply with any reasonable direction given by Newcastle Yowies, its authorised representatives, Port Stephens Council or relevant event personnel in relation to safety, risk management and event operations.

Indemnity: Stallholders/vendors agree to indemnify Newcastle Yowies, its members and agents, and Port Stephens Council, its officers and agents, against liability, claims, demands, expenses, fees, fines, suits, proceedings and actions arising from the stallholder's participation in the event.

Liability: Stallholders/vendors occupy and utilise their allocated site at their own risk. Newcastle Yowies and Port Stephens Council accept no liability for loss or damage to a stall, display, equipment or other property, or for loss of income resulting from event cancellation or removal from the event due to non-compliance with the conditions or applicable safety requirements.
