August 2024

President David Freeman called the meeting to order with 27 people present. We had a guest, Malek Santos and return guests, Phil Kaiser, and Kayla Adams.

The Board of Directors has awarded life-time members Bob and Val Swaddling and Ed McGowan the honor of being “Lifetime Members” for their service to the club and the magical arts. Also given awards were Craig Fennessey and Ryan Stiner for their past service as presidents.

President Freeman led us into a discussion about recalling the first magic trick that we did. The Svengali Deck seemed the most mentioned.

Phil Schwartz presented number 105 in his series Magic History Moments on Thayer Marketing. He showed how Vermont-born magic maker and dealer, Floyd Thayer, impressively promoted his company’s magic with unique and creative efforts. Phil showed Thayer souvenirs given at SAM (1914) and IBM (1927) gatherings, pocket-sized catalogs, book catalogs and Thayer publications including the Thayer Magical Bulletin (1914-1925), Thayer Ballygram (1925-1943) and the Trick of the Month Club (1931-1934). Phil also showed several of Thayer’s famous turned pieces — a Nikko silk ball, a dye tube, a ball vase and a rice vase. Our club historian also did a little magic himself. He poured rice into the Thayer rice vase and changed it into an orange.

The meeting show began with Bob Swaddling showing his amazing ability to cut to any card names in the deck. He then went into a tribute to his friend, the late Tommy Cooper of England by wearing and using a fez and many of the classic Cooper comedy lines. He concluded with a coconut appearing under the fez.

Dennis Phillips and Dan Stapleton teaming up with adaptations of the classic Binary Cards. Dan had an interactive method of revealing the unknown number by having the audience stand up and then sit down if he correctly revealed the secret chosen number. Dennis

Phillips did a mind reading effect, using the same method, but hid the simple mathematics by using word lists rather than numbers.

Paul Thomey had a clever 5 cards to pocket routine done one at a time. Kayla Adams and Phil Kaiser did a mind reading effect using a long strip of paper with dozens of popular song titles. A spectator chose where to cut the paper and Kayla was able to get a mental impression of the song. Greg Solomon filled us in on his recent lecture tour of Scotland and has a collection of funny gags. One effect had a spectator select one of 5 cards but somehow all the cards became the same one and a fan of cards instantly became all different size cards.

Mike Flanigan combined a reveal of a selected card and the classic seated “Slick Tie” rope escape. He got a great response. Ryan Stiner did a show-and-tell with his collection of Tarot cards. Phil Kaiser finished out the show with metal bending of a fork and a great presentation of Dan Harlan’s “Hold it Buster” which is a family story of a card game used to get a boy to do family chores.


My long-time friend Mark O’Brien is a You Tube presence, and you can enjoy all his posts and videos with magic and illusions.


