

KNOW your chemistry! If you are home-schooling your children, this is an excellent practical example of learning chemical reactions.



# DO NOT MIX THESE CLEANING PRODUCTS



Do not self-administer anything other than Over-the-Counter medications without the direction of a licensed physician who is trained in pharmacology! (MD or DO)

Even with OTC medications, follow the directions and keep notes of what you took! The foundation of medical treatment is keeping records.

Just because medications sound alike to you, it does not mean they have the same physiological effect.

Biochemistry is something I am familiar with, from graduate studies (UNCC1974).

I had a friend ask me if he could "just take more of my water pill because it is what's in the miracle drug the President praised?"

#### NO!

These drugs below may sound alike to you, but they have totally different actions.

<u>Hydroxychloroquine</u> increases lysosomal pH ( acid -base balance). In inflammatory conditions, it blocks receptors on plasmacytoid dendritic cells (PDCs). It decreases TLR (toll like receptor) signaling, reduces the activation of dendritic cells and the inflammatory process. TLR recognizes DNA-containing immune complexes and leads to the production of interferon and causes dendritic cells to mature and present antigen to your immune system T cells, therefore reducing the anti-DNA auto-inflammatory process.

This drug may lower inflammation and lower the cytokine storm response in some people. Only a doctor can advise you if it is appropriate for you, the risks and an experimental dosage!

<u>Hydrochlorothiazide</u> is a diuretic (encourages you to pass urine out). It belongs to the thiazide (means that it contains sulfur) class of diuretics. It reduces blood pressure by acting on your kidneys to reduce sodium (Na+) reabsorption in the distal convoluted tubule of the kidney. It works a bit like what happens when you let some air out of your tires. Your tire pressure lowers.

This drug is for a different purpose.

Stay safe!

A friend of mine was concerned about the oxygen levels in his blood so I was going to recommend a pulse oximeter. A few years back



I bought one for around \$15

#### The New Thinking needed in Magic:

Walk around and close up magic will be radically different following the peak of this pandemic. Even stage magic using audience volunteers will change.

With Covid 19 spectators and volunteers are going to be highly conscious and sensitive about personal hygiene. The new reality is "hands-off magic".

Saying "all the magic happens in your hands" will no longer be desirable. Sadly, Sponge Ball magic may be a thing of the past, as will be borrowing rings, bills, cell phones or coins, unless they can be soaked in sanitizer, Shoes may be okay with precautions.

You will have to forget people touching cards and coins and maybe even a mentalist will have to forget pencils and paper that are handled by the spectator.

Forget The Classic Force and use the Rifle Force. It is not quite as mysterious but neither is a card deck soaked in hand sanitizer.

You can be fairly certain that noisy kids and spectators will not be rushing the stage to grab your props.

Obviously, things in the mouth will be a no-no. Does anyone want your possible Covid 19 breath coming from a popping balloon? Will they want to handle a balloon that you have touched?

Right now, during this pause in your magic life, you need to rethink what the New Reality of your magic will be.

He had been living at an assisted living facility in Florida with his wife of more than five decades.



Curren had worked in sales until he decided he wanted to be a professional magician, his son said. Sheila was his assistant.


As a magician, Curren loved sharing magic tricks with children.

On left the is the classic Abbotts Super X Suspension

In the middle photo is the cage to Abbotts Dove Catching. The net can be seen resting on the wall. Also against the wall is my home made Dove Frames.



On the right is my "Water from India" running gag props. I made and painted these. The solver bowl is a giant Morrissey Lota Bowl and the receiving vase was made from a heavy plastic patio plant urn. There is a whole in the bottom

and as the water is dumped in periodically, it flows into a plastic tub in the base. The gag (I saw it first in the Kalanag Show on TV) is that you dump the water out of the bowl and pat it on the bottom a couple of times saying "Water from Injah. Empty!".


A half dozen times throughout the show, you walk over and do that. Near the end of the show you slowly turn over the gold urn saying , "No more water from Injah. Empty!"


