


- Drone Cages: Our drones are equipped with enclosures that completely surround the drone, protecting the propellers and preventing them from coming into contact with people or objects.

Disney's Dazzling Drone Light Show: A Game-Changer Driving Unprecedented Crowds and ROI

A new drone show is coming to Disney Springs

A new drone show, "Disney Dreams that Soar Presented by AT&T," is coming to the Disney Springs shopping, dining and entertainment complex at the Disney World Resort in Florida this summer.

During the nine-minute show, 800 drones will be choreographed to form images of Disney characters set to familiar scores. The show will also feature an original song.

The nighttime show will run from May 24 to Sept. 2. Showtimes will vary but it will run twice each night.







Walt Disney World and Disneyland have been dazzling guests for decades with their nighttime spectaculars. Incorporating everything from elaborate fireworks displays and inspired water projections to stunning pyrotechnics and the half-million-plus LED lights that brought the fan-favorite Main Street Electrical Parade to sparkling life, these evening events have consistently provided a perfect way for patrons to cap off a busy day at the parks.

With its new Dreams That Soar show — performed nightly through Sept. 2 at Orlando's Disney Springs shopping and dining district — the company is continuing this tradition, but ratcheting it up with a fresh technological twist. More specifically, the limited-time evening event is leveraging 800 drones to retell some of Disney's most iconic tales. But as the production's title cleverly suggests, its content is solely focused on flight, including nods to popular franchises and characters that are associated with their ability to take to the skies.

As expected, this approach sees the likes of Peter Pan, Dumbo, and even the helium balloon-propelled house from Pixar's "Up" brought to life by the carefully choreographed, sky-illuminating tech. But the spectacle's specific theme also opens the gates to science fiction films and heroes, from Wall-E and "Big Hero 6"'s Baymax to everyone's favorite space ranger, Buzz Lightyear. Of course, Disney's biggest sci-fi properties — "Star Wars" and "Marvel" — are not only present and accounted for, but serve as two of the nearly 10-minute performance's most significant inclusions.





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
