#### A Trip To The Model T Museum







This is a necessary trip for all T owners. The museum is located in Richmond, Indiana. Richmond is the border town of Indiana and Ohio. Owned and operated by the Model T Ford Club of America, the museum originally opened in Centerville, Indiana in 2007. It was relocated to Richmond in 2012 and now has a second building across the street called the "Annex" that houses a complete repair and machine shop along with 22 additional T's and a couple of tractors. The Club, the museum and the research library are now together.





The museum houses two 1909 (early serial numbers) Model T's. Notice no windshield, two levers and two pedals. These cars also have all wood bodies, gas lamps, water pumps and speedometers, but the first cars did not come with windshields, you had to get your own.





Through the years T's came with a multitude of carburetors, plus after market options.





The museum is the current host to serial number 5,000,000.







All major varieties of T's are represented showing the versatility of both T's and TT's.





The Annex has doubled the museum's space.







The Annex allowed for the addition of a repair shop with a full machine shop.





To help understand the workings of a Model T they have a complete chassis with cut-away components.





Along with a beautiful Depot Hack they have a 1917 dump truck that was donated from William Palmer of the Southern Nevada Model T Club! Look close that might be William under the truck.

#### **Eureka & Palisade Tour**

One Saturday, after breakfast, some of our club members wandered over to see the Eureka & Palisade. She's an 1875 steam train that resides right here in North Las Vegas. The locomotive and tender had just returned from a two week run on the Cumbres and Toltec Railroad in Southern Colorado.













Our host Dan and his crew were most gracious to allow us to explore and examine the train. It turned out that meeting and talking to the "train guys" was as exciting as seeing the train itself.
