### The Accessory Corner

I was doing a little spring cleaning (very little spring cleaning actually) by getting rid of a bunch if weeds that had taken up residence in my back yard and came across this accessory wishbone support made for the early 1909-1918 T's. You might be thinking, "You come across Model T parts while removing weeds in your back yard?" Well, if you have ever seen my back yard you'd understand and really, in my defense the weeds were really tall!

It reminds me of what Jeff Foxworthy said, "If you finally get around to mowing your grass and find that car you thought was stolen years ago, you might be a redneck!" I guess you never know what you might find in that tall grass!

Ok, back to the wishbone support. I found this years ago while deer hunting in northern Nevada. These were used to help support the bottom of the axle on the earlier cars where the wishbone mounted above of the axle, giving the axle much more needed support, and improve safety.

This support I found looks like it broke loose from the car since both mounting ears are missing but could be easily repaired.

A few companies made these but this one I found happens to be made by APCO. I found an ad for this support on-line along with a couple other period advertisements from other companies who also made front axle support. These actually worked quite well and are still being made and sold by a few Model T parts suppliers.






