Registration deadline for local members is Feb 27th, see attached registration form for more details. Don't forget to order your commemorative club T-Shirts and show off our club spirit.



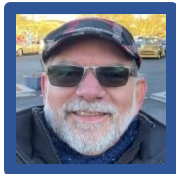

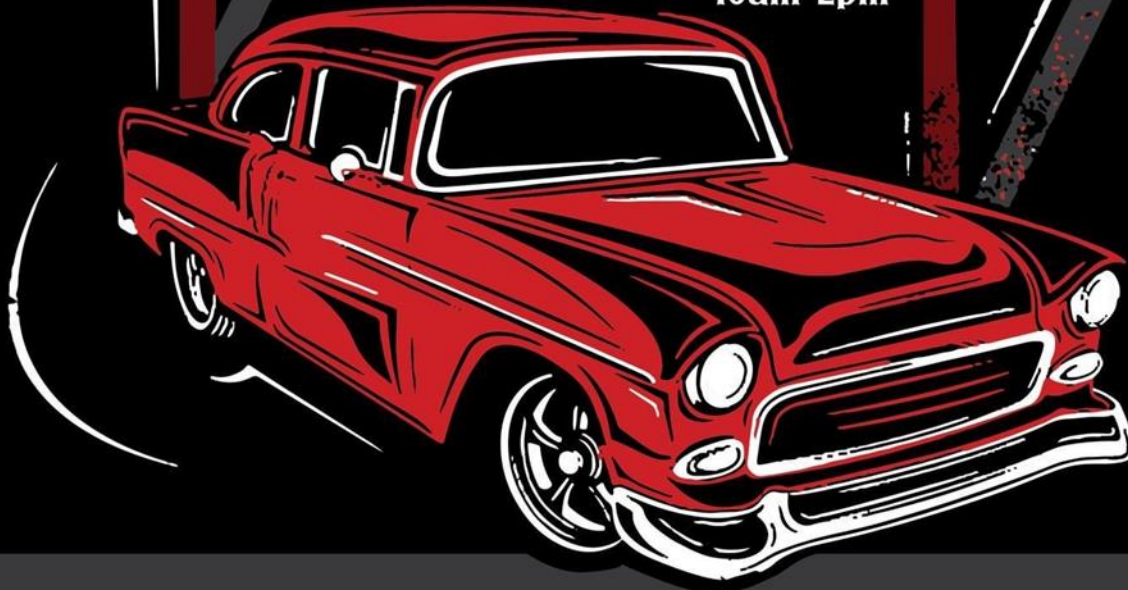
