

Last Saturday morning I decided to make a run out to Boulder City for the Antiques in the Park swap meet. Every May Boulder City holds their annual Boulder City Jamboree. The Jamboree has everything from art shows to classic cars, swap meets to yard sales and antique shops to restaurants.

Usually, I hit a few yard sales and antique shops but as most of you know I'm taking care of my 92-year-old father, so my time is limited, so I only had time for the Antiques in the Park swap meet. I figured I'd get there early in the morning ahead of the pickers while the venders were setting up to sneak the best deals and before the crowds moved in and then head back to Vegas. When I got there the pickers were already there hovering over the venders like vultures circling roadkill!

Fortunately, I scored a couple nice old porcelain signs before the vultures swooped in and a nice Jefferson Electric Company Model T coil tester. Last month I covered the Jefferson Combination Coil Tester, so it just seemed fitting that I cover my newly acquired Jeffersons No. 25 tester this month. This tester is very complete and even has the original wires (and he even threw in an early brass top coil!) Jefferson seemed to offer a small line of Model T testers with their combination tester being their best seller. This no. 25 tester didn't have sockets for testing bulbs like their combination tester but would test spark plugs in addition to coils. Jefferson eventually got into radio, vacuum and transistor testers. Jefferson is still in business today making transformers and test meters of all sorts.




