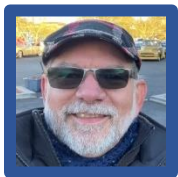

The Accessory Corner

March 2023

This month's accessory is something I've had for quite a while. Made by the Hudson Motors Specialties Co. or "Hudco" it made changing the bands on the Model T a little more enjoyable. I picked it up a few years ago at the Long Beach Model T swap meet. It was purchased from a well know Model T accessories collector named Joe Ballard. If anyone knew Joe, you'd know he had one of the largest collections of Model T Ford accessories around. He had a couple of these covers, so I was able to purchase one from him. The cover allows easy access to the transmission bands without having to remove the entire hogshead.

The cover fell out of favor due to cost and the invention of the removable (detachable ear) bands in the early 20's. The detachable bands eventually became Ford standard equipment in late 1925 making the Hudco removable cover obsolete. The cover was invented around the 1919 timeframe.



We are so happy that you're renewing with us as we love having all of you. Here are a couple of reminders to make registration as seamless as possible:

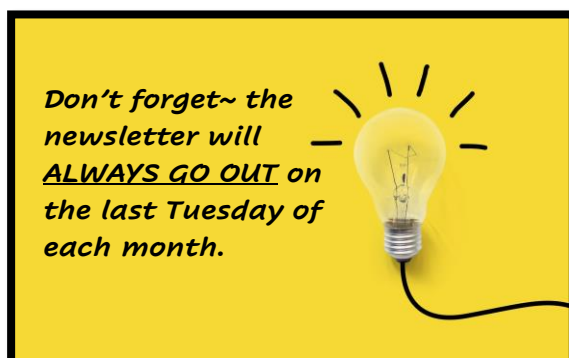

The Ford Model T Was an Iconic Automobile

Ford Motor Company was incorporated in 1903. Before 1908, Henry Ford announced that he would manufacture a vehicle large enough for a family to purchase at an affordable price. This model would also offer a regular operating maintenance cost for the consumer. He also said the vehicle would be made with the best materials and assembled by the best factory employees.

Color—Black. All-steel body with pronounced streamline effect. Low, deeply-cushioned seats. Double ventilating windshield. One-man top. Standard equipment includes weatherproof side curtains opening with all four doors, windshield wiper, nickeled headlamp rims and four cord tires. Starter and demountable rims, \$85 extra. Balloon tires, \$25 extra.

Color—Windsor Maroon with upholstery to harmonize. Composite body. Nickeled radiator and headlamp rims. Double ventilating windshield. Plate glass windows with rotary lifts. Standard equipment includes side curtains on rear windows, dome light, hooded sun visor, windshield wiper, rear view mirror, dash lamp, starter, demountable rims and four cord tires. Balloon tires, \$25 extra.

Color—Black. All-steel body with streamline treatment. Large compartment under the sweeping rear deck. Double ventilating windshield. Standard equipment includes weather-proof storm curtains opening with both doors, windshield wiper, nickeled headlamp rims and four cord tires. Starter and demountable rims, \$85 extra. Balloon tires, \$25 additional.

Color—Channel Green with upholstery to harmonize. All-steel body. Nickeled radiator and headlamp rims. One-piece ventilating windshield and hooded sun visor. Plate glass windows with rotary lifts. Wide shelf behind seat for parcels. Large dust-proof rear deck compartment for luggage. Standard equipment includes starter, windshield wiper, rear view mirror, dash lamp and four cord tires. Balloon tires, \$25 extra.

Some of the people involved with the Ford Model T at the beginning were Henry Ford, Childe Harold Willis, Joseph A Galamb and Eugene Farkus. The Ford Model T was a small, lightweight vehicle that many customers admired and enjoyed.

From 1908 to 1927, the Ford Model T dominated sales in America. The price for a Model T Touring vehicle was \$290 or \$580 for the Tudor sedan. Drivers at the time could also enroll in a program called the "Ford Weekly Purchase Plan," where the customer could make a deposit of five dollars at many authorized Ford Dealers across America to purchase a new Ford Model T.

With seating capacity for five individuals and with low trim body lines, the Ford Model T combined beauty and utility for the customer. The Touring car had four doors that made it easier for passengers to enter and exit. The instrument panel inside provided the utmost convenience for the driver and passengers when traveling.
