Pioneer Florida Museum and Vil*lage was the place to be to watch horse* pulls, admire crafted quilts and check out historical sights

Two rows of stout horses made quite a show of being walked down from their trailers in a field above the Pioneer Florida Museum and Village, pass- low 70s for the most part. ing crowds of spectators, many of whom gathered along a hillside to watch the competition.

"It's a full house," said Darryl Pennington, one of the museum's longtime board members who watched the horse pull and made his rounds on Saturday in a golf cart. "This is one of our larger events."

Although attendance numbers were not available at press time, executive director Stephanie Black was pleased with a crowd that seemed to be larger than in recent years.

"We did have increased attendance this year," she said. "We had a drop (in attendance) during Covid and after Covid, but it picked up this year. It was a great day. It wasn't 90 degrees and it wasn't 50 de-

Morningside cruises to 26-6 win over Hunter's Run

The host team improved to 4-1 at the season's midway point in the Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League

Morningside shared a Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League title with a combined team of Settler's Rest/Sweetwater two years ago. This year, they are in prime position for another champion-

Morningside, which competes in the Wednesday league (there also is a Tuesday league) and is the lone team from Dade City, improved to 4-1 with last week's 26-6 win over Hunter's Run.

Morningside took a commanding 14-2 lead at the break over Hunter's Run, a team that has struggled of late following several years of being one of the league's top contenders.

Morningside was the league's runner-up last season, finishing behind Settler's Rest/Sweetwater, which has won three of the last four titles outright. Ironically, Morningside's only loss of the season so far came against Settler's Rest/Sweetwater.

Those two rivals shared the league championship in 2022. In a match that came down to the wire, Morningside defeated Settler's Rest/Sweetwater by two points in the final week of that season. Despite talk of a possible playoff both teams agreed to

settle for being co-champions.

"We're doing alright for having some less experienced players," said Morningside captain Dennis Frey, citing the loss of Howard Collins, who has missed several weeks with a pulled muscle.

Against Hunter's Run, Morningside got by with a solid lineup that includes standouts like Tom Reynolds, Chuck Baker and Art Granlee.

Baker competed in a world tournament last July in Lansing, Mich. In a group of 16 players he was ranked 13th and wound up with just two loss-

The script for the Zephyrhills boys basketball team's seven seniors could not have been written any better. The host Bulldogs gave that group of long-term plenty to celebrate on Senior Night with an 87-55 rout of Patel last Wednesday at Alan Reed Court.

The team's seniors are Jakobe Campbell, Teddy Sands, Jeremiah Clark, Darryl Vereen, Brody Kuzmaak-Griswold, Joseph Stosh and J.J. McGovern. Most of them are starters who have helped the Bulldogs to a 13–11 record so far.

In the dominating performance against Patel, the Zephyrhills seniors combined for 54 of the team's 87 points. That marked the highest total in a game for the Bulldogs this sea-

"They're all good kids and they all work really hard," Zephyrhills coach Mike Novak said. "It was good Senior Night for them. They were focused and got going from the



Milton Oren Jones

JONES, Milton Oren, former President of Pasco-Hernando State College, passed away at his home on Jan. 28, 2024. He was 90 years old. Milt was an educator, soldier, counselor, choral director and soloist, and life-long public servant. Born in Largo, Milt was the son of W.A. and Aletha Jones. Milt graduated as Valedictorian of Largo High School, received his undergraduate degree from Stetson University, his Master's Degree from the New Orleans Baptist Theological Seminary, and his Ph.D. from Florida State University. In 1972, he was selected as the founding President of Pasco-Hernando State College, a position he held for 24 years. PHSC started from his dining room table and grew to three campuses and two satellite locations during his tenure. The "Milton O Jones Student Services Building" on the West Campus of PHSC was named in his honor following his retirement. Milt was commissioned as an Infantry Officer at Stetson, served two years on active duty with the 25th Infantry Division, and more than 28 years with the Florida National Guard. He held numerous command positions, culminating as a Colonel and Deputy Brigade Commander. Milt is a graduate of the Army War College and was awarded the Expert Infantryman's Badge, the Legion of Merit, and the Florida Cross for military service. Milt spent his life devoted to community service. He and his wife, Alice, were active Rotarians. After serving locally in Rotary leadership for many years as President of his Dade City club and Governor for District 6950, Milt went on to become a Direc-

sively with Rotary, including more than fifteen international trips. Milt also traveled several times to Haiti to assist in building a muchneeded hospital. District 6950 established the "Milton O. and Alice Jones Outstanding Rotarian Award," a prestigious award that is given annually in their honor. Milt is survived by his wife of 35 years, Alice, grown children, Kathy Lewis, Kenneth Jones Sr. (Helen), Scott Jones, and Lara Tibbals (Wesley), grown step-children Ann Pirttima (Eric), Lynda Furney, and Nancy Brown (Gene). He had 10 grandchildren, Jessica Smith, Kenneth Jones Jr. (Wendy), Joshua Lewis (Jessica), Jason Lewis (Celia), Jennifer Mullet, Cannon, Briggs and Claire Tibbals, Madden and Pryce Jones, and five step-grandchildren, Andrew Pirttima (Shelby), Alicia Murphy, Dillon Crossgrove, Lance Furney, and Christopher Brown (Jamie), as well as eight great grandchildren and four great-great grandchildren. Milt is also survived by his brother, Philip Jones (Peggy), and many more wonderful nieces, nephews, and cousins. He was predeceased by his parents, his sister, Dee Jones, and his brother, Ronnie Jones. The family will receive visitors on Feb. 10 at Hodges Funeral Home, 11441 U.S. Hwy 301 in Dade City, from 10-11 a.m. A Celebration of Life will begin at 11 a.m. All are invited. 

MOMENTS IN TIME: The History Channel

* On Feb. 19, 1906, American industrialist W.K. Kellogg teamed with Charles C. Bolin to found the Battle Creek Toasted Corn Flake Company, now known as the multinational food manufacturer Kellogg's, after 25 years of working for his brother, John Harvey Kellogg, and buying out his in-debt brother's business.

* On Feb. 20, 1935, Danish-Norwegian explorer Caroline Mikkelsen became the first woman to set foot on Antarctica, though whether on the mainland or on an island is disputed. A small coastal mountain discovered that day is named for her.

On Feb. 21, 1947, Edwin H. Land publicly demonstrated his instant camera, called the Land Camera, which could produce a black-and-white photograph in just 60 seconds. Two years later he put 57 Polaroid Land Cameras in Boston's Jordan Marsh department store before Christmas, and they sold out within the first day after their demonstration. On Feb. 22, 1989, Tina Turner won a Grammy award at age 49 for Best Female Rock Vocal Performance for her album "Tina Live in Europe," featuring recordings from her Private Dancer and Break Every Rule tours.

* On Feb. 23, 2011, 77-year-old broadcaster Larry King announced plans to conduct a one-man comedy tour after retiring from his popular talk show on CNN. The new venture was set to begin in April of that year in Connecticut and end in June in Las Vegas. * On Feb. 24, 1836, showman P.T. Barnum exhibited an African American slave, Joice Heth, with the claim that she was the 161-year-old former nursemaid to George Washington. After her death from natural causes, and a public autopsy by a respected phy-

sician who claimed she was no more than 79 or 80, Barnum eventually admitted to the hoax, which was frequently mentioned by his critics and followed him for the remain-On Feb. 25, 1993, the Florida Marlins introduced their 8-foot-tall, 250-pound mascot, Billy the Marlin. HOLLYWOOD -- Former exercise guru Richard Simmons has kept a low profile for the last five years, but came out of hiding to denounce a proposed film starring comic Pauly Shore as Simmons.

"Hi, everybody!" wrote Simmons on a Facebook post. "You may have heard they may be doing a movie about me with Pauly Shore. I have never given my permission for this movie. So don't believe everything you read. I no longer have a manager, and I no longer have a publicist. I just try to live a quiet life and be peaceful. Thank you for all your love and support!"

Unfortunately for Simmons, they don't need his permission to make a movie about him. Celebrities are considered public domain. Now should the filmmakers defame or malign you, then you have recourse to sue. But he's got another problem besides the feature film rumored to be in development. A short film starring Shore as Simmons, titled "The Court Jester," already premiered at the Sundance Film Festival on Jan. 19 and is available on YouTube.
