Adding color to the parade as they joined Zephyrhills High and Junior High bands to provide marching music were the Brewster Vocational High School Band of Tampa, Pasco High and Junior High School of Dade City and the Gulf High Band of New Port Richey.

The social hall of St. Joseph Catholic Church with its restroom facilities was opened to the out-of town band students. Ice water and cookies were provided for the visiting musicians.

The parade went international by having a Canadian car entry.

Royalty gracing the parade included Miss Anna Jo Davis, reigning Miss Zephyrhills, Pasco County junior royalty and Zephyrhills royalty Prince Stevie Kennedy and Princess Linda Marie Bacon. Twenty-seven contestants for the 1964 Miss Zephyrhills title, wearing pretty formals and holding arm bouquets provided by their sponsors, likewise were added grace notes.

Mayor C. N. Chamberlain gave the welcome address and F. Earl Hart voiced the Lions Clubs' appreciation. R. L. Bryan, for six years secretary of the Zephyrhills Colony Company before World War I, and Mrs. Bryan, who now live in Bartow, were among the old-timers introduced.

The beauty pageant contestants were presented to the audience by Mrs. Robert Ahrens, chairman.

The Lions Den did a brisk business, with Jaycee Keystone

Cops Art Natali and Jerry Uterhardt tossing all and sundry into the hoosegow and having them "fine" their way out with coins paid over to "Judge" Richard Petteplace.

Pie-eating contests, music by the Zephyr Plow Boys FFA string band, the Rambling Serenaders and singing by the Zephyrhills Glee Club were on the afternoon program. Mrs. J. W. Stoutenburg and Mrs. Charles Roberts were featured in piano duets.

Other highlights included piano selections by George Neukom Jr., who wowed spectators with his enthusiastic renditions of "Dixie," "Everything's Gonna Be All Right," and selected marches.

Featured entertainers were the Merriell Miller dancers under the leadership of Mrs. Miller and John Barber of Hunt's Point, Nova Scotia. Mr. and Mrs. Roy Lee danced the old Laces and Graces, while Barber, with Mrs. Beatrice Szemko as partner, danced specialties.

For this phase of the program Mrs. Miller, who had worn a green taffeta colonial gown dripping with champagne lace for the parade, was dressed in a gay 90's outfit with a black and white striped skirt, white Gibson girl blouse, a hat of like vintage and high top shoes.

Concessions did brisk businesses, and children and the young-at-heart adults rode carnival rides. Generally speaking, they had themselves a ball.

Thousands View Parade, See 2 Follies Programs

Despite graying skies and threats of showers, thousands of area residents and winter visitors lined the route, including 11 blocks of flag-decked 5th Ave. Saturday to watch the ever-colorful parade staged annually in conjunction with the Lions Club-sponsored Founders' Days Festival. A light ran began to fall as the last-in-line horseback riders passed the receiving stand.

Automobiles attracting special attention were those in which Mrs. L. M. Neukom rode as the oldest businesswoman in Zephyrhills; Mr. and Mrs. Ralph Manahan, Mrs. Ford White and Mrs. Walter Gall, all costumed as old timers, representing the Pioneer Florida Museum

Assn.; three cars carrying Gold Star Mothers; a like number with Moose Lodge members; six cars which Shriners rode; and another carrying officers of the Zephyrhills Garden Club.

Entries lending patriotic notes, in addition to the Veterans Council color guard, firing squad, and riding and marching units, including a Veterans of Foreign Wars contingent from Dade City; Boy Scouts, Cub Scouts, Girl Scouts and a Navy recruiting car. Other outstanding entries included the Yell-O-Rockers Square Dance group dancing as they rode, the Zephyrhills Tourist Club float and marching group, First United Methodist Church float, Bank of Zephyrhills float with children of employees as riders, the Ralph's Trailer Park float, the Meals on Wheels cart and bike, the Mobile Home Exchange float, Pasco-Hernando College float, the Sunnyside Serenaders, baton groups, New River 4-H Club bike group, various automobiles in which Lions Club dignitaries and others rode, business firm and city vehicles.



Everyone loves a parade -- or so they say -- and that seemed to be the feeling in Zephyrhills Saturday morning when the second annual Founder's Day parade marched its way through downtown Zephyrhills.

The parade, featuring more than 80 participants, was led by Police Chief William Eiland, the VFW Color Guard and Parade Grandmarshal Rosemary Wallace Trotman.

What followed was a potpourri of business, club, mobile home park and individual entries, including clowns, marching bands, riding bands, a double-decker bus, horses, buggies, antique cars, floats, Uncle Sam and the Republic's elephant, beauty queens, politicians, and off course children.

Taking the honors bestowed by parade judges James Bailey, Joellen Farnham and John Knowles in the eight different categories were: Holiday Inn State Fair, Tampa, Best Business entry; Zephyrhills Lioness Club, Best Club Entry; Baker Acres RV Park, Best Park entry;




