Combined team captures Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League title for third straight season

Unlike last year when Morningside and the combined team of Settler's Rest/Sweetwater shared the title in the Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League, there are no co-champions this season. Set-

tler's Rest, which combines with neighboring mobile home park Sweetwater, won it all.

Settler's Rest/Sweetwater won the championship in 2021 and now has two outright titles to go along with a share of another over the past three sea-

"We've got the players," said Lawrence Pittman, a player who runs the social media program for Settler's Rest/Sweetwater. "We've just got to play our game."

In 2021 as a first-year team in the league, Settler's Rest/Sweetwater won its first title by unseating Hunter's Run, which had an impressive run of six league championships in seven seasons.

City adds sidewalks, animal control services

Monday's city council meeting saw the city add to it's trails and sidewalks, as well as contract with Pasco County for animal services

The Consent Agenda for Monday's city council meeting was straightforward. The first three items all were approvals of meeting minutes from Oct. 10, Oct. 24 and February 2023. These three items were bundled and passed together with all seven of the Consent Agenda items 5-0 with.

Item 1.4 approved a software purchase for the Zephyrhills Police Department. As the city moves to consolidated dispatch, ZPD needs to purchase Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) software to access the Pasco County system. The item approved spending an initial \$184,733.68 for the software itself and \$36,416 in recurring costs for maintenance and subscription renewal. The contract with Central Square/ONE Solutions also allows Central Square to setup the agency's account for direct bill-

Item 1.5 asked council to approve a resolution requesting enforcement of Chapter 14 of the Pasco County Code: "Animals within the Zephyrhills municipal boundaries. The city will be charged annually using a formula based on the net operating cost per capita of providing services to the residents of unincorporated Pasco County and those municipalities also served by the animal services department."

Item 1.6 renewed the interlocal agreement between the City of Zephyrhills and Pasco County, The last interlocal agreement was executed in 1996. While the agreement still must be presented to the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners for

There were only enough players to field a JV team for two games last year. Zephyrhills had JVs in 2021, but the entire softball program shut down after eight games in 2020 due to the coronavirus pan-Both were in action last week at Craig Milburn

As a military spouse, Margrit had the opportunity to live in many locations. She lived in the Netherlands, Virginia, Texas, Mississippi and Pennsylvania. In addition to the places she called home, Margrit traveled extensively and saw many other parts of the world with her family. A woman of many talents, she sang, played accordion, mastered the harmonica, taught ballet and aerobics, and even appeared in several television commercials. HOLLYWOOD -- Vancouver-born Ryan Reynolds, now 46, is returning to Canada to build a 1.2-millionsquare-foot movie studio in Markham, Ontario, Canada, for a mere \$1.5 billion. Reynolds got more gold than Fort Knox from starring and producing "Deadpool" (2016), which cost \$58 million and made \$782.6 million, and "Deadpool 2" (2018), which cost \$110 million and made \$785.8 million. The upcoming "Deadpool 3" will cost \$200 million and costar Hugh Jackman and Leslie Uggams.

Lest we forget Tom Cruise, whose "Top Gun: Maverick" grossed upward of \$1.4 billion, making it the 12th top grossing film of all time. "Maverick" falls behind No. 1 grosser "Avatar" (\$2.9 billion), No. 2 "Avengers: Endgame" (\$2.7 billion) and newcomer and No. 3 "Avatar: The Way Of Water" (\$2.2 billion).

Cruise began shooting "Mission: Impossible --Dead Reckoning Part One" and "Dead Recknoning Part Two" back in February 2020, but they were shut down due to COVID and restarted shooting March 24, 2022. The films wrapped December 2022, with a total cost of \$290 million. "Part One" opens July 2023 and "Part Two" opens June 2024. "Mission Impossible: Fallout" (2018) cost \$178 million and grossed \$791.7 million. Need we say more?

Patricia Heaton (who filmed 209 episodes of "Everybody Loves Raymond" and 215 episodes of "The Middle," before being disappointed by only 18 episodes of CBS' "Carol's Second Act") is moving back into movies with the psychological thriller "The Beldham," costarring Corbin Bernsen. Heaton's already completed "Mending the Line," with Brian Cox, and "The Unbreakable Boy," with Zachary Levi.

Bernsen has the upcoming HBO miniseries "White House Plumbers," with Woody Harrelson, Justin Theroux, Domhnall Gleeson and Lena Headey, as well as the Showtime series "The Curse," starring Emma Stone, due soon.

Here's a final word on Raquel Welch, who died Feb. 15 at 82. When she passed, the last vestige of the classic Hollywood sex symbol went with her. The many times I saw her, she created the kind of stir accorded with Elizabeth Taylor or Marlene Dietrich, and she was always beautiful, approachable, glamorous and -- above all -- classy.

In 1973, I was writing five columns a month for movie magazines, and I was taken by her stunning performance in "The Three Musketeers" (and said so in print). One night, while covering an "A list" party at a private club, I saw Raquel Welch walking toward me. She said, "Hi, you've been pointed out to me as Tony Rizzo." I nodded that I was, and she continued, "I spend a small fortune on clipping services and have read several articles you've written praising my acting. I just wanted to thank you in person." She extended her hand, then turned and walked away. I said, "Don't let me down," to which she replied: "Don't worry I won't!" Now that was class!
