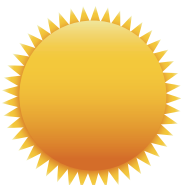

Combined team captures Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League title for third straight season

Unlike last year when Morningside and the combined team of Settler's Rest/Sweetwater shared the title in the Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League, there are no co-champions this season. Set-

tlar's Rest, which combines with neighboring mobile home park Sweetwater, won it all.

Settler's Rest/Sweetwater won the championship in 2021 and now has two outright titles to go along with a share of another over the past three seasons.

"We've got the players," said Lawrence Pittman, a player who runs the social media program for Settler's Rest/Sweetwater. "We've just got to play our game."

In 2021 as a first-year team in the league, Settler's Rest/Sweetwater won its first title by unseating Hunter's Run, which had an impressive run of six league championships in seven seasons.

City adds sidewalks, animal control services

Monday's city council meeting saw the city add to it's trails and sidewalks, as well as contract with Pasco County for animal services

The Consent Agenda for Monday's city council meeting was straightforward. The first three items all were approvals of meeting minutes from Oct. 10, Oct. 24 and February 2023. These three items were bundled and passed together with all seven of the Consent Agenda items 5-0 with.

Item 1.4 approved a software purchase for the Zephyrhills Police Department. As the city moves to consolidated dispatch, ZPD needs to purchase Computer Aided Dispatch (CAD) software to access the Pasco County system. The item approved spending an initial \$184,733.68 for the software itself and \$36,416 in recurring costs for maintenance and subscription renewal. The contract with Central Square/ONE Solutions also allows Central Square to setup the agency's account for direct billing.

Item 1.5 asked council to approve a resolution requesting enforcement of Chapter 14 of the Pasco County Code: "Animals within the Zephyrhills municipal boundaries. The city will be charged annually using a formula based on the net operating cost per capita of providing services to the residents of unincorporated Pasco County and those municipalities also served by the animal services department."

Item 1.6 renewed the interlocal agreement between the City of Zephyrhills and Pasco County. The last interlocal agreement was executed in 1996. While the agreement still must be presented to the Pasco County Board of County Commissioners for

Zephyrhills has enough to field two softball teams

Greater turnout allows Bulldogs to split into varsity and junior varsity teams for this season

For teams to succeed in sports, depth often factors into the equation as much as talent does. This year, the Zephyrhills High softball program once again has both.

Several key returners should lead to an improvement at the varsity level, but the junior varsity team has only been active in one of the previous three seasons.

There were only enough players to field a JV team for two games last year. Zephyrhills had JVs in 2021, but the entire softball program shut down after eight games in 2020 due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Both were in action last week at Craig Milburn Field with the home squads earning a split against The Villages Charter. The JV team got things started with an 11-1 win over the Buffalo. Coupled with a season-opening 12-1 romp of Sunlake, the JV team went into the spring break with a 2-0 record.

The varsity team, however, wound up on the other end of a lopsided game. The Bulldogs lost 12-0, falling to 2-4 so far this season. In that span they

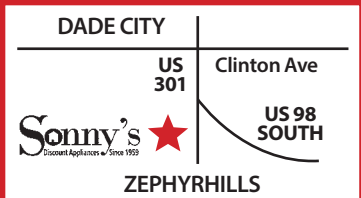



final approval, it will be funded at \$147,574 for 2023 and contained in the City's FY23 Budget. The projected line item in the budget was \$152,563. This item was pulled and passed 5-0.

Item 1.7 asked for approval of a Task Order with BGE, Inc. for construction of sidewalk development at: West Elementary School, Raymond B Stewart Middle School, 16th Street and Woodland Elementary School. The \$130,000 bid is contained within the FY22-23 Budget. The item passed 5-0.

In Business Items, Item 2.1 brought up a conditional use to allow for the storage of recreational vehicles at Trump Place Boat & RV. This project was denied back in December but at the last council meeting, it received 4-1 approval to exceed height limitations for a proposed, 8,700-square-foot building. Monday's items asked council to approve a conditional use as is required by LI Zoning in the Land Development Code.

"We discussed the economic viability of our industrial corridor," councilman Ken Burgess said. "It looks like they are ready to close in another building. It looks like a good plan and will have some of the buildings we are looking for."

This item was approved 4-1 with no public comment and with councilwoman Jodi Wilkeson dissenting.

In the City Manager's Report, there was a request to add a special use permit to sell alcohol at the April 15 Music & Motorcycles event, put on by Main Street Zephyrhills, from 4 to 9 p.m. Main Street Director Gail Hamilton spoke to council, stating that Music & Motorcycles was the primary fundraiser for Main Street events throughout the year. The event was moved from September to April in order to avoid the rainy season. The item passed 5-0.

In the City Attorney's Report, Item 4.1 established requirements for the proper disposal of

pet waste. The FDEP has mandated daily loads for impaired water bodies and the implementation of a pet waste ordinance is an approved stormwater best management practice. Thus, the item codified: (Section 5) All pet owners and keepers are required to immediately collect their pet's waste when deposited on any property, public or private, not owned or possessed by that person and to properly dispose of the pet waste.

There was discussion as to what the punitive fines were. Zephyrhills City Attorney Matthew Maggard stated that the fines were not enumerated in the city ordinance but that the city is adopting the same fee schedule that Pasco County uses. The item passed 5-0.

In Citizen Comments, Randy Stovall came up to announce a town hall for upcoming municipal candidates at Alice Hall on March 20. The meet and greet part of the town hall will commence at 6:15 p.m. and the forum at 7 p.m.

In Council Comments, Zephyrhills Planning Director Todd Vande Berg touted near completion of the intersection improvements at Eiland Boulevard and Simmons Road.

Zephyrhills Public Works Director Shane LeBlanc stated that "substantial" completion of the project was slated for March 22 but Vande Berg thought it could take until the end of the month.

Councilwoman Jodi Wilkeson brought up the issue with Metro Development and the transmission pole and inquired of Maggard if there was any progress on the negotiations to move the transmission pole and complete Kosick Road from U.S. Highway 301 to Wire Road. Maggard said that they were still at a stalemate with Metro and the county. The city is refusing to approve any more plats in the development and Metro is still waiting on a county right of way, Maggard explained.

"It (denying more plats) seems to be the only leverage we have at this time," Maggard said.

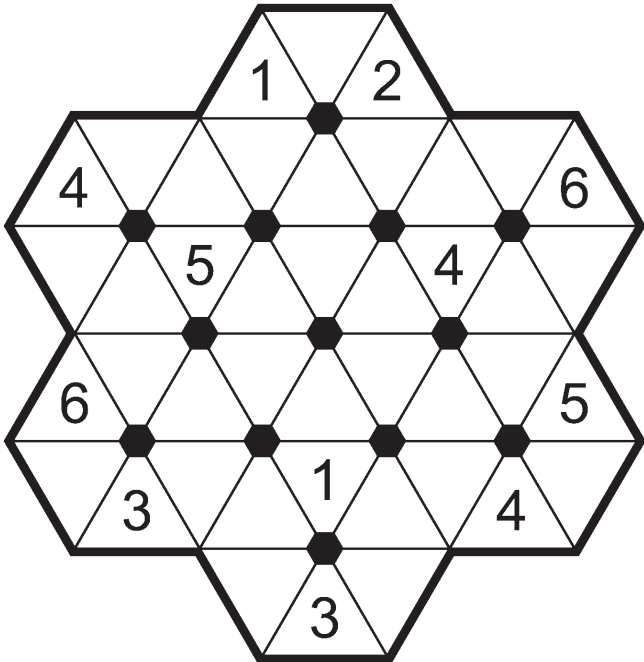
- Lynn Riggs, the beloved theatrical staple about a young farm-girl named Laurey and her two suitors continues to be produced across the country.

"They got the best of both teams and knocked us off," said Bryan Jorgensen, captain of Hunter's Run.

Jorgensen and Yvon Cote have ranked among the top players for Hunter's Run on those league-winning teams. But Cote, who is from Ontario, recently sold some property and went back up north a bit earlier than expected.

That loss of a good player, coupled with some getting out of the league or passing away in recent years, adversely affected Hunter's Run.

"It's the story of Hunter's Run," Jorgensen jokingly said. "All our good players either die or (leave the) league."

Settler's Rest/Sweetwater earned its most recent championship with last week's 27-5 home victory over Hunter's Run at the Settler's Rest horseshoe pits. The lone loss came in the season opener against Morningside, which defeated American Condo 20-12 on the road in a season finale.

Morningside and Settler's Rest/Sweetwater met twice this year and split their series.

"It was a two-point difference in the total score," said Tom Reynolds, a co-captain at Morningside. "We beat them on their court and they beat us on our court."

For the team that plays its home games at Settler's Rest, co-captains are Dave Howes and Ron Knowles. They are among several key returners for the team and, not surprisingly, that duo won their round in last week's season finale.

"We have a lot of good pitchers," Knowles said. "They all pitched last year for us. It's been a lot of practice and they've done real good."

Regardless of the outcomes, Hunter's Run player Joe Stewart notes that the matches are so much more than about simply winning and losing. Of course, being part of the previous run of succession for Hunter's Run doesn't hurt.

"Having a good time; that's all that matters," he said after shaking hands with his opponent, Cliff Sullins.

Knowles concurs with Stewart. For him and others still pitching, getting to enjoy the sport is the ultimate goal.

"I'm 87 and I'm still into this game as much as I was years ago," Knowles said.

Like many teams, at the start of each season the rosters are not usually filled. Some teams, however, wind up with better turnouts than others.

"When we opened the season we didn't know if we were going to have enough (players)," Knowles said. "Then, they just seemed to come out of the woodwork."

Just because league play is over, some aren't done playing. Knowles and Howes, both of whom have won numerous championships in Maine, plan to compete at the top level when they head back north in April.

We're going back and see if one of us can retake the championship," said Howes, adding that horseshoes "is bigger down here. There's a lot more people who live down here and you can pitch in the winter and the summer."

have been outscored by a 44-27 margin, including just one run scored in their past two games. “Both teams have work to do,” said Kristen Dumont, now in her fourth season coaching the varsity team. “They’re just not hitting.”

Only two starters graduated, leaving the Bulldogs with much the same team as last year. Most of those players also are on travel teams. That includes senior co-captains Alex Bowe-Wooton, a pitcher and outfielder, and Madison Schroeder, a shortstop who has signed with Warner University in Lake Wales.

“They’re talented. We just need them to work together,” Dumont said. “They all have the potential.” Bowe-Wooton has a special place in the coach’s view since she is the first player Dumont has coached for all four seasons.

“Just to see her strive to be better and not settle for anything but her best speaks volumes about her dedication,” Dumont said of Bowe-Wooton. As for Schroeder, a transfer from South Carolina, the coach views her as a leader in the field and at the plate.

“Her actions definitely speak volumes about her,” Dumont said.

As for having enough players to field two teams, she said, “The JV’s our feeder program ... they’re progressing to come to the varsity. There’s a handful that are potentially varsity (players).”

JV coach Maya Clark, a 2012 Zephyrhills graduate, and assistant Kourtne Cross, who graduated from Zephyrhills in 2014, are entrusted with running what so far is an unbeaten team. Of course, they prefer having a JV team, as do the freshmen and sophomores on that roster.

“Close relationships,” is why Dakota Deck prefers a JV team. In the JV win over The Villages, starting pitcher Hannah Waydka tossed a one-hitter with eight strikeouts and just one walk. Plus, nearly everyone in the lineup got a hit.

“Even the girls who didn’t hit in the first game got a hit in this second game,” Clark said.

At the varsity level, Zephyrhills won just five games last season and seven two years ago. The bar has been set higher for this season. Dumont indicated that some of the more accomplished JV players could be called up late in the season to help with that goal.

“We have a great team, there’s no doubt about that,” Dumont said, noting that compared to varsity squads in her previous seasons, “this team has more potential.”

Potential enough to be a playoff team? “I hope so,” she said.
