Music & Motorcycles switched to the spring

19th annual event put on by Main Street Zephyrhills formerly took place in the fall but will now remain in April

The 19th Annual Music & Motorcycles brought an impressive crowd to the downtown area last Saturday. Formerly held in the fall, the traditional event

organized by Main Street Zephyrhills took place in the spring for the first time and will be scheduled each April.

Judging by comments from organizers and those who came out to enjoy the festivities along 5th Avenue, the change of dates is a good thing.

"It's not too hot yet and it gives us something to do on a nice weekend," said Rosalyn Weeks, a snowbird from Pennsylvania who came downtown with her husband Oliver. "We're heading back up north in a few weeks, so we want to enjoy one last event here."

"The sponsors all asked us to change (the time of year)," said Gail Hamilton, the city's Community

Melonie Monson and Steve Spina win municipal elections

Monson replaces former mayor Gene Whitfield and Steve Spina defeats incumbent Alan Knight for a city council seat

Zephyrhills welcomed a new mayor and a city councilman after last week's municipal elections that featured five candidates overall. The Alice Hall Community Center polling location stayed open until 7 p.m. on April 11 to allow local residents to cast their ballots.

Melonie Bahr Monson won among three candidates vying for mayor while Alan Knight lost his Council Seat 2 to Steve Spina, formerly a two-time city manager. The mayor's race included challengers Nick Deford, a local pastor, and businessman Martin Harm. Spina and Knight, the incumbent, sought the council seat.

Monson garnered 59 percent of the votes, well ahead of Deford's 32 percent and Harm's nine. Spina tallied 61 percent of the vote compared to Knight's 39. Knight, who had been in the Pasco County School District for 35 years as a teacher and coach, has resided in Zephyrhills for more than 50 years.

Bob Winters, president of the Zephyrhills Volunteer Fire Rescue Association and a community leader who sold Winters' Mobile Home Park in 2020, was among many locals who attended the recent debates at the community center in Zephyr Park.

On the council result, he said, "We couldn't have gone bad with Steve or coach. It was a win-win there.

As for the mayor's race, Winters noted that

Four teams compete in middle school track and field meet

The John Long boys and Weightman girls were track and field team winners in what, in essence, served as a preview for the upcoming Pasco County Middle School Athletic Conference East Meet set for April 26 at Cypress Creek.

All but two east-side teams — Cypress Creek and Pasco — took part in last week's four-team field at Bulldog Stadium. Stewart and Centennial, who share that Zephyrhills High facility, were included with Centennial being the host team.

"It's a nice opportunity for us to see what athletes we're up against," Centennial athletic director Kim Valdner said of the four-team meet preparing her athletes for the upcoming conference meet. "It's pretty competitive with four teams."

As for the team scores, in the boys division John Long totaled 82 points with runner-up Weightman scoring 76. Third place went to Centennial with 25 points and fourth-place Stewart had 10.

John Long, runners-up in the boys and girls divisions at last year's conference meet, has yet to lose a boys meet this season. They won three previous

meets before last week's competition in Zephyrhills.

"Weightman's got some great sprinters, but as always it comes down to depth," said John Long coach Damon Zassenbraker, who also coaches football for the Longhorns. "We have a lot of depth in

Tax collector Mike Fasano announces April will be Lauren’s Kids charitable giving month

Pasco County Tax Collector Mike Fasano announces that Lauren’s Kids will be the tax collector’s featured charitable organization for the month of April. Lauren’s Kids is an organization that works with local school districts to prevent childhood sexual abuse through education and awareness. Additionally, Lauren’s Kids helps heal survivors with guidance and support.

Lauren’s Kids was started in 2007 by Lauren Book, now a state senator and herself a victim of years of childhood sexual abuse by a trusted caregiver. Senator Lauren Book has taken her own experiences and has turned them into an opportunity to help children find hope and healing.

The Pasco County Tax Collector’s Office will promote the Lauren’s Kids specialty license plate and charitable check-off during the month of April. It is estimated that one in three girls and one in five boys in the United States are sexually abused before the age of 18. A staggering 90 percent of the victims personally know the predator who preys on them. Sadly, it is estimated that 30 percent of childhood sexual abuse is never reported.

Individuals who have vehicle registrations coming due in April can trade-in their existing license plate for a Lauren’s Kids specialty plate. Customers may also purchase the tag for newly registered vehicles. Customers who purchase a specialty tag will be entered into a drawing for a gift card. Additionally, customers may also check the box on the back of their registration

form to donate a specific dollar amount to the cause. Cash donations separate from vehicle registration and renewals will also be accepted.

“The Pasco County Tax Collector’s Office has been an invaluable partner in the fight to prevent child sexual abuse and help survivors heal since 2015,” said Senator Lauren Book, Founder of Lauren’s Kids. “Their commitment to community service and the safety of all is reflected in their work with Lauren’s Kids, and we are so grateful to have their continued support in the fight to protect childhood.”

“I encourage customers to consider supporting the excellent work that Senator Lauren Book and her organization do to help children heal from dreadful abuse,” Fasano said. “Senator Book estimates that 95 percent of sexual abuse is preventable through education and awareness. It is an honor for the Pasco County Tax Collector’s Office to once again team with Lauren’s Kids to train a new generation of children about this crime and how they may find help and healing if they do become victims of it. Your purchase of a specialty tag or a donation in any amount to Lauren’s Kids will make a world of difference to a hurting child in our community.”

The specialty tag and the check-off promotion run through the month of April. Contributions to Lauren’s Kids can be made at all five tax collector locations in Pasco County: Wesley Chapel, COMPARK 75 – 4610 Pet Lane; Gulf Harbors, U.S. Highway 19, New Port Richey; Land O’ Lakes, north of the

Central Pasco Government Center; East Pasco Government Center, Dade City; and the West Pasco Government Center, Little Road, New Port Richey. Contributions can also be added to renewals that are processed via the mail. Monson, formerly the executive director of the Greater Zephyrhills Chamber of Commerce, was an ideal candidate.

"I think she's extremely qualified," he said. "She can walk into that job very well. I think she's ideal. She's really involved."

For her part, seeking the role of mayor is something Monson said has been in the works for the past 10 years.

"I actually started joking with my grandkids about 10 years ago," she said. "I knew that, five years ago, when (Whitfield) retired that I would do it. The stars aligned."

Monson chose to have her election night celebration at the Sarah Vande Berg Tennis & Wellness Center off Simons Road.

"It was so great," she said of celebrating the results there on election night. "We wanted to have it there so I could show off the venue."

Surrounded by family and friends, excluding her late father Ron Bahr who passed away in 2020, Monson shared an observation from that night: "I don't think I've seen my mom (Edna Bahr) smile so much in years."

Spina celebrated on election night at the Silverado Golf and Country Club. He is a resident of Silver Oaks.

"It feels good," he said.

Monson plans to meet soon with Whitfield "to find out all the ins and outs," she said, adding, "The things I've done for the past 10 years have prepared me for this."

Spina, who is very well familiar with the city and its inner workings as a longtime administrator, will now seat in the row of council members. He had semi-retired, serving part of last year as an interim city manager in Temple Terrace.

Still, being up there with council members will give Spina a different perspective, which he is looking forward to.

"It will be a lot different. You're looking at things at kind of a different level," Spina said while manning a Zephyrhills Noon Rotary booth last Saturday at the Music & Motorcycles event sponsored by Main Street Zephyrhills. "Running was an experience. I've never done that before. That was totally different."

Spina said he "felt good" about his chances of winning the council seat. "I was out there. The best part was talking to people and hearing what they had to say."

our distance runners coached by Ricardo Sanchez.”

In the girls division, Weightman won with 84 points, 20 more than runner-up John Long. Stewart took third with 27 and Centennial was fourth with just three points.

“There are some dedicated track athletes. They run in clubs,” Weightman athletic director Wayne Ackett said of the girls from his school. “The girls have a much better chance (at the conference meet) than our boys this year.”

Regardless of the outcomes in the boys and girls competitions, Tom Mine, Weightman’s former athletic director who is an assistant track coach, noted that the meets are unlike several other sports when it comes to the amount of participants and the camaraderie between teams and opponents.
