

Bulldogs romp Coyotes 35-7 for first win



Scheduling quirks result in two victories in four days for Zephyrhills, which also beat Tarpon Springs on Monday

COVID-19 has wreaked havoc on the Zephyrhills football team this season. After a player tested positive for the virus, two games were cancelled. Another game against Sunlake was eliminated when a player from that team tested positive, leaving the Bulldogs with some ground to make up.

No problem for the Bulldogs, who through rescheduled contests got two wins in four days. Zephyrhills, which lost its first two games, evened its record at 2-2 with a 35-7 win over Cypress Creek last Friday, marking the first-ever meeting between those schools. On Monday, the Bulldogs won by an even greater margin, 42-0 at

Tarpon Springs in a game also rescheduled due to COVID-19. 'We're still learning, but we're finding our identity," said Zephyrhills coach Nick Carroll, who is in his fifth season coaching


Playing two games in four days, he noted, "just helps them get game reps. We're starting to get in shape."

Zephyrhills, which opened this season with losses to Tampa Catholic and Sickles, two prominent teams in Hillsborough County, goes for a third straight win in this Friday night's homecoming game against Anclote. The Sharks are struggling with a 1-4 record.

Zephyrhills nearly had a shutout win over Cypress Creek, which managed to score in the final minutes of last Friday's game. The fifth-year Coyotes, who dropped to 2-3 got a late 55-yard touchdown pass from quarterback Owen Walls to Dontrell Cerkley. That play was set up by Walls' 25-yard pass to Brycen Hernandez.
"We decided to put it into Owen's hands and let him throw

the ball a little more. I kind of wish that happened earlier in the game," Johnson said, adding, "I'd like to play Zephyrhills again to-

Consistency is a word most golfers know all too well with amateurs and professionals, as well as newcomers and veterans alike, striving to maintain that certain level of performance from tee to green. The Zephyrhills and Cypress Creek boys golf teams simply aim to stay away from being inconsistent on

The Bulldogs finished last at Silverado in a trimeet last week, tallying a score of 193 for nine holes. Perennial contender Sunlake won with 164 strokes, just six fewer than runner-up Cypress Creek. The Seahawks also had the individual medalist with Max Berlie shooting an impressive 34

Like the Bulldogs, the Coyotes seek to play a bit more consistent in a rebuilding season.

"While we were not happy with our performance as a team, we know we are young and we know we are getting better each day," said first-year Zephyrhills coach James Kirk, who also coaches junior varsity basketball for the Bulldogs. "We don't focus on the past, but instead on what lies ahead, which we believe are good things to come as long as

we keep working on getting better."

Cypress Creek coach Matt Schaeffer, who also is in his first year, said his players stepped up in the absence of their top golfer, Connor Newbold, who was sick and missed that tri-match.

The unanimous sentiment among local bowlers in the men's league at Pin Chasers, which closed in March due to the coronavirus pandemic and reopened in July, is that it is the best around — bar

"They're pretty competitive," said manager Amy Higgins, in what likely is an understatement considering the league brings out top-notch caliber bowlers from throughout east and central Pasco.

Tristan Emerson, one of the shift managers at Pin Chasers, took Higgins' assessment a bit further when asked about league play. Having bowled at the Zephyrhills-based alleys since he was an eighth-grader at Centennial Middle School, he is well aware of the

talent that comes out on Thursday nights.

"We have multiple bowlers who have scored multiple perfect games," said Emerson, who works most nights but finds time to bowl in the Saturday night league.

In a league that runs from mid-August through the first week in May, there always are some rather impressive scores. Topping that list will be perfect 300 games and two men's league bowlers have accumulated more over the years than anyone else at Pin Chasers. Drew Markwardt, who has bowled at Pin Chasers since he was 11, has 116 perfect games while P.J. Campbell has cracked that coveted 300 mark 46 times.

Noted Emerson, "They have a very talented team."

Not only does the men's league bring out some very good bowlers, but families and friends often come along. That makes for a busy night at the front desk as well as in the kitchen and bar areas for employees.

How to cope with physical changes resulting from cancer treatment

Among American and Canadian women, breast cancer ranks as either the most commonly occurring cancer or a close second. The World Cancer Research Fund says there were two million new cases of breast cancer in 2018 across the globe, while the American Cancer Society notes the chance that a woman will die from breast cancer is about 2.6 percent.

Fortunately, for most women, a cancer diagnosis is not terminal. Early detection and thorough treatment helps to improve the fiveyear survival rate, especially for those with cancer that is localized to the breast or has only minimally spread. Women may have to undergo various forms of treatment, including radiation, chemotherapy and surgery.

The National Cancer Institute notes that, while they're effective, breast cancer treatments can cause changes that affect a woman's physique, body image and sexuality. Some changes will be short-term, such as hair loss or fatigue. Others may be permanent, such as breast loss or scarring from lumpectomy and mastectomy. Fertility also may be affected, potentially compromising a woman's ability to get pregnant after treatment.

Regardless of the changes, breast cancer patients must realize they are not alone. Scores of women have experienced similar feelings and can be sources of support and inspiration during recovery. In addition, a handful of strategies can help women confront the physical changes resulting from cancer treatment in a

- Understand that it is okay to feel frustrated, upset or angry with the changes that have occurred. It doesn't make you shallow. Anyone has the right to grieve treatment options that have changed their bodies in various ways.
- Attempt to focus on how cancer treatment and the entire experience has made you stronger and more in tune with life. Cancer can

be a wake-up call that sparks positive changes going forward. Focus on your strengths, rather than on what you cannot reverse.

- Look for new ways to enhance your appearance, like a new hairstyle. A makeup makeover also can help. Some women like to splurge on a stylist who can help shape a wig or offer them some innovative ideas to change their ap-
- Speak with a doctor about what you can do to treat and camouflage skin changes from treatment. Topical creams may alleviate redness or dry patches while other remedies can minimize surgical scarring.

The changes in body image that breast cancer survivors experience tend to be connected to the features that society characterizes as "feminine." Loss of one or both breasts can greatly affect body image. However, if mastectomy surgery is necessary, speak with your doctor about reconstruction possibilities. There also are very good prosthetic inserts and bras that can mimic the look of natural breasts under clothing.

Physical changes are common after cancer treatment. Women can try a handful of strategies to successfully confront these changes.





The Zephyrhills defense bottled up the Cypress Creek quarterback for most of the game, sacking Walls four times with Mike Barber adding an interception. Those sacks, some of which were shared by two players, came from Maguire Neal, Theotis Smith, Nelson Nieves, Willie Queen, Dajuan McCullough and Nick Sheldon.

Offensively, the Bulldogs took a 21-7 halftime lead and cruised the rest of the way with a running clock implemented midway through the fourth quarter once they had gone ahead by 35 points. The Florida High School Athletic Association mandates a running clock whenever a

team gets ahead by that margin.
The Bulldogs marched 80 yards downfield on seven plays to score on their opening drive. Raleigh Allen, who has replaced T.J. Jackson at quarterback, connected with Jackson on a swing pass in the right flat that resulted in a 45-yard touchdown.

Before the break, Zephyrhills added a 23yard scoring run by Tre Gallimore and a 1-yard plunge into the end zone by Zyre Roundtree on

a drive set up by Barber's interception. Gallimore added his second touchdown of the game early in the third quarter. After reeling off a 21-yard run he scored from 10 yards out on fourth down. He needed just three yards for a first down on that carry, but got much more. Gallimore added his third touchdown on a 17yard run early in the fourth quarter.

In the dominating win over Tarpon Springs, marking the second game in a row that the Bulldogs won on the road and by virtue of a running clock, the offense continued to excel.

Jaylin Thomas, another running back in a deep backfield, led the way with three rushing touchdowns against the Spongers. Roundtree also scored on a run and Clayton Cornelius caught an 11-yard scoring pass from Jaxson Rivera, who also saw some time at quarterback.

The final score came on the defensive side of the ball when Gallimore returned an interception into the end zone from 25 yards out.


