Bulldogs take a big bite out of Sharks, 40-14

Zephyrhills remains unbeaten in Class 5A, District 11 and now has four consecutive victories

The Zephyrhills High football team opened the 2019 season with three straight losses, but things seem to be getting better each week since that rough start. That welcoming trend continued last Friday in Holiday with a 40-14 win over Class 5A, District 11 rival Anclote.

Not only did that give the Bulldogs four consecutive victories, but it keeps them in contention for a district title that would extend their school-record playoff run to six straight seasons.

As the regular season nears its conclusion, the Bulldogs and Sharks are on opposite ends of the spectrum. Zephyrhills is 4-3 overall and 3-0 in the district while the Sharks, who have lost four in a row, are now 2-6 and 1-2 in 5A-11.

"Tough times never last, but tough teams do," said Zephyrhills coach Nick Carroll, who has led the team to its past three playoff runs. "That's what we've been preaching since we lost three in a row."

The Bulldogs' turnaround will be put to the test this Friday when they travel to New Port Richey to face district rival River Ridge, which also is undefeated in the district with a 3-0 mark. The Royal Knights are 5-2 overall.

Bulls, Bulldogs, Coyotes chase dominant showing by host Sunlake

The host Sunlake Seahawks dominated the Sunshine Athletic Conference East Meet

The SAC East meet took a sharp turn just a few days before. Previously set for Crews Lake, a scheduling mix-up changed the venue to the campus at Sunlake. The Seahawks, dominant all season, did not need the boost on their home turf as they cruised to team victories on both the boys and girls sides.

On the girls side, the Seahawks scored a perfect 15, meaning they took all five top individual scoring spots. They nearly did it on the boys side, only Wiregrass Ranch's Sebastian Hernandez broke up the Seahawk phalanx, taking third.

"I just went out and tried to beat as many of them (Seahawk runners) as I could," Hernandez said.

Hernandez ran a personal best 16:28 on a perfectly flat course over almost all grass. It made for a big

ZSC doubles pair tops tough competition in season opener

The doubles team of Gary Krause and Ross Lacombe defended their home court to open the 2019-20 season

The days are getting shorter and the nights cooler and the two-legged birds that roost in Florida during the winter months are starting to arrive, just in time for the 2019-20 shuffleboard season to start. The very first event of the season began at Zephyrhills Shuffleboard Club on Oct. 7 and was a state doubles tournament. Early matches began to sort out which teams were headed to the main event and which to the consolation bracket.

By Tuesday, Oct. 8, the last few match ups were being sorted out. On the men's side, 50 shufflers competed for the honor of winning the first event of the season and it was a hot contest. ZSC host shufflers Gary Krause and Ross Lacombe were early main event finalists. They awaited the result of what turned

out to be one of the more exciting matches of the tournament, that of Hall of Famers Earl Ball and Henry Strong against Dean Myklejord and Saint Petersburg shuffler Erik Hahmann.

Hahmann is part of the youth movement emerging from the St. Pete club and part of the crossover that is expanding the sport across the region. Teaming up with Myklejord made for a great pair and excellent competition for the titans of Ball and Strong. They met in the main event semifinals and split the first games.

In the third game, Myklejord/Hahman roared out to a 42-11 lead after three rounds. They led 52-19 before Ball and Strong started to gain back the lost ground but it was too late. Up 68-33 and holding the hammer, Myklejord hit an eight to win the third game 76-33 and take the match 2-1, advancing to the main event finals.

In the final, Myklejord/Hahman jumped out to an early lead 39-23 but found themselves in trouble a few rounds later as two shots landed in the kitchen and Krause/Lacombe went up 35-19. A couple rounds later, Lacombe logged a big score and the team took a 51-36 lead. At 66-54, Krause placed a puck in the 10 triangle to win the first game 76-54. Myklejord/Hahman were not about to fold. They raced out to a 22-0

early lead and continued to stretch it, eventually up 43-7. While Myklejord/Hahman clawed back some points, finally at 74-38, Hahman hit the game-winning shot to the the match 1-1.

Into the third game, Krause/ Lacombe took a 35-10 lead and went up 51-17 on a great shot from Krause. However, Myklejord/Hahman were still not finished. Hahmann scored a 15 to climb back into the game and it was 59-46 before Krause cleared two scoring pucks from Myklejord/Hahman and scored two of his own to make it 74-46. One score away, Myklejord held off defeat one more round by clearing the board but eventually the hammer came back to Krause/Lacombe and Lacombe hit an eight with his final shot to win the game and the match 2-1.

"I knew that if I didn't get it (winning shot) that Gary would pick it up with the other hammer," Lacombe said. "I knew when we got the lag for the third game that we'd win."

It was a stiff competition, nonetheless. "They (Myklejord/Hahman) had won so much that we knew we would have to play our best game," Krause said. "When you're in a state tournament, no one wants to give in and they're all great shooters."

On the ladies side, Mary Eldrice and Arlene Guerrini were taking on Sue Dungey and Joan Cook. Eldrice/Guerrini went up big in the first game, leading 51-14 and did not look back. Up 66-38, Guerrini hit an eight with her hammer to setup her partner Eldrice who landed a seven with her hammer to win game one. Eldrice/Guerrini got the hot start again in the second game and led by as much as 38-5 before Dungey/Cook came storming back and closed to within one point (28-27).

Dungey/Cook took the lead at 44-36 only for Eldrice/Guerrini to swing it back again

53-34. Up 60-49, Eldrice/Guerrini had to endure another big swing from Dungey/Cook. Dungey/Cook took the lead back at 60-40 and finished out to win the second game and tie the match 1-1. There were five lead changes in the game.

The final game was much closer, even if it had its share of lead changes. A big round from Eldrice scored 15 points and put the team up 65-35. Guerrini got it to within one score of the win (73-51) but Dungey/Cook were not going down easily. They scored a seven to bring the score to 73-58 and Dungey knocked a Eldrice/Guerrini puck into the kitchen, while scoring seven of her own. Eldrice was able to clear one of her pucks out of the kitchen but soon the score was 73-66, both teams within one good shot of winning.

Fortunately for Eldrice/Guerrini they had the hammer. With the board cleared, Guerrini had one last shot, if it was a scoring shot, they'd win, if not it would be on to another round.

"There was a lot of pressure on that last shot," Guerrini said. "I thought I had shot it too far and on the line but I didn't. We needed it too because they (Dungey/Cook) were already at 66. I knew we had to have that eight."

The pair actually won the same tournament to start the 2018-19 season and won all five tournaments where they played together.

"I was getting nervous, I missed a few shots and I thought we were in trouble," Eldrice said. "But things started to perk up and my teammate picked me up and we won it."

"The last five years, the district goes through Zephyrhills and River Ridge," Carroll said, adding that he told his players that the second half of the Anclote game "will determine where you are for the rest of the district." That stern warning came, in part, as a result of Anclote trailing 14-7 at halftime and tying the score at 14 early in the third quarter. The Bulldogs answered that challenge by scoring 26 points the rest of the way while keeping the Sharks scoreless in that span.

the first two of running back Zyre Roundtree's four touchdowns — a 12-yard run that capped a six-play, 65-yard opening drive followed by a 15-yard run on Zephyrhills' third possession — the Sharks capitalized on a pair of turnovers to tie the game at 14.

A fumble by Zephyrhills quarterback T.J. Jackson was scooped up and returned 26 yards by Sheldon Marcelle for one touchdown and Thomas Crawford returned a Roundtree fumble 63 yards for another score.

After that, however, the Zephyrhills defense dug in and did not allow another point. The Bulldogs closed out the game with four straight touchdowns, two in the third quarter and two more in the fourth.

Roundtree scored on a 2-yard run in the third and on a 44-yard scamper to close out the scoring. In between Jackson connected with Tre Gallimore on a 15-yard scoring pass and Gallimore returned a punt 32 yards into the end zone. Gallimore finished with four receptions for 94 yards.

"In the second half we made some adjustments on where we ran the football," Carroll said.

Jackson, a sophomore in his first year as a starter, wound up with 176 total yards worth of offense. The left-hander completed 8 of 16 passes for 116 yards and scrambled for 60. Roundtree, as he has done in nearly every game, led the Bulldogs in rushing with 154 yards on 17 carries.

Zephyrhills defenders, led by Demitris Wright and Brian Ashmore, pressured Anclote quarterback Chris Kehoe throughout the game. Wright was in on three sacks and Ashmore contributed two.

Cornerback Zion Williams also fueled the Bulldogs' defensive effort with an interception he returned 27 yards.

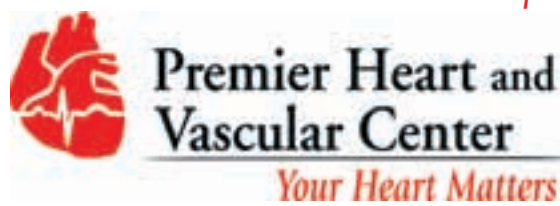

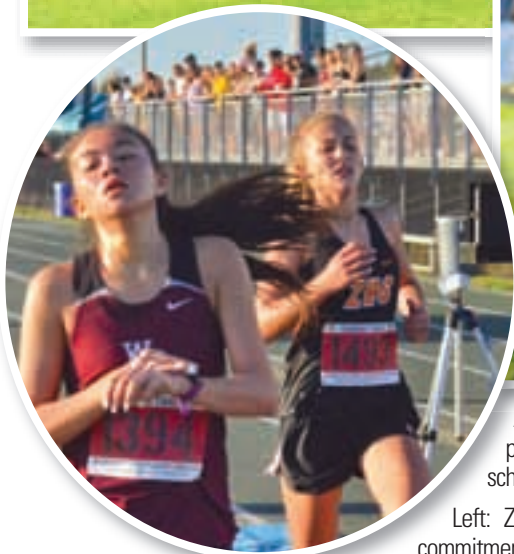
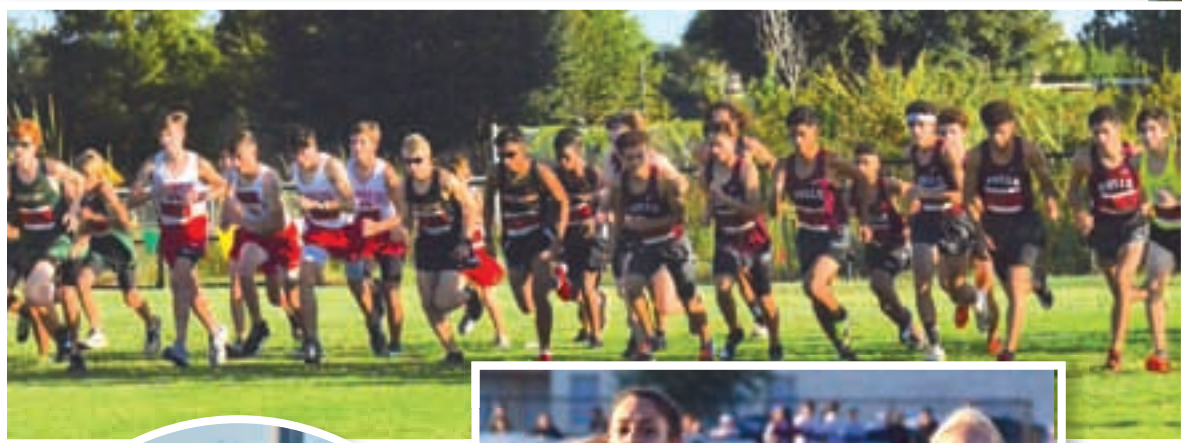

day across the board as personal records fell like autumn leaves.

The Wiregrass girls had a solid group effort from all seven of their varsity runners, all coming in the top 17 and the top three all coming in sixth through eighth. Junior Mya Hill led the way in sixth with a 20:46. Hill almost broke up the Sunlake perfect score, breathing down the neck of Sunlake's Emma Burleson into the finish line. Freshman Hannah Sheen ran a personal best 21:13 for seventh and Breanna Preiser was 10 seconds off her PR in an eighth-place, a 21:21 time.

The marks got the Bulls second (51) behind Sunlake (15) on the girls side and third (76) behind Land O' Lakes (67) and Sunlake (20).

The Zephyrhills boys, despite being down one of their top runners in Roberto Gomez and two more runners at JROTC Raiders competition, still managed to place fifth on the back of an eighth-place finish from senior captain Joseph Hoppe. Hoppe is in hot pursuit of the school record (16:10) and while it still seems so far away, Hoppe's personal record of 16:53 on a fast course Saturday morning, indicates that he might have a chance. Hoppe's previous PR was a 17:12 set last week at Crews Lake. He managed to axe 19 seconds off his time in back-to-back weeks and the competition certainly will ramp up as Hoppe and the Bulldogs enter the state series, starting with districts on Oct. 24 in Weeki Wachee. Still, it was the first time a male runner at Zephyrhills broke 17 minutes since 2004.

"Once the Sunlake runners pulled away, I was just running for time," Hoppe said. "I looked at my watch when I got to my markers and I knew what I had to do."

On the girls side, Madison Poe led the charge, placing 14th just missing the catch of Wiregrass Ranch's Brianna Patane at the finish line. Not far behind Poe was the Bulldogs' other team captain Emmalise Feliciano, taking 16th in 22:48.

"This course made the race faster and that helped me a lot because I was cramping," Poe said. "It was not my best time today but I

haven't been practicing (cross country) enough because I've been committed to volleyball. Volleyball season ended last week, so I hope to get my time down from here."

The Bulldog girls took third (98) behind Wiregrass Ranch and Sunlake.

"We're not just looking at what we have right now, we're looking at what we're going to have in years to come," Bulldog coach Vinny Baez said.

The Bulldogs have some individual and also some team goals still in sight for this year.

"The majority of our runners do better every race," Bulldog coach James Kretschmar said. "It (qualifying for regionals as a team) looks really good with the extra teams (adding an additional spot for regionals)."

If both boys and girls team squads made the regional meet, it will be the first time since 1995. It's a feat that Baez and Kretschmar have been working steadily toward for a few seasons now. It could happen on Oct. 24.
