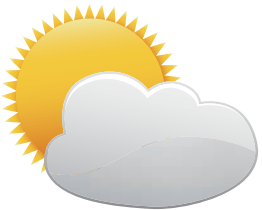

The Zephyrhills Moose Lodge 2276 will host a number of events to help raise money and collect toys this Christmas

It's the most wonderful time of the year. So the Andy Williams Christmas classic goes. Christmas time is a time when friends and families get together and celebrate. It's also a time when service organizations step up their games in order to make sure everyone's Christmas is a merry one. Moose Lodge 2276 of Zephyrhills works in partnership with the Lions Club of Zephyrhills and the United States Marine Corps Reserve to

distribute toys to children, through the Toys for Tots Program. They fill an enclosed, 40-foot trailer before it's all said and done.

The way it works is the Moose Lodge hosts a quartet of events to collect both monetary donations and unwrapped toys, they present the collected items to the Marine Corps Reserve and then children can pick up the toys at the Lions Club, located at 5827 Dean Dairy Rd. in Zephyrhills. The partnership goes back spanning a couple of decades. The Moose Lodge and Lions Club began their partnership 15 years ago. The four events they put on stretch back 10 years.

"The ball started rolling 15 years ago and it's snowballed from there," Moose Lodge Administrator Chuck Plourde said.

The Moose Lodge has collection events starting as early as this Friday. This Friday, Nov. 26 is the lodge's

See-Click-Fix App streamlines citizen-city interactions

The new application allows Zephyrhills residents to report problems in the city with just a few taps of their phones

Ever had to report something to the city; a code violation, a pothole? Was it difficult finding the right department and whom to speak to? If you have a smartphone, Apple or Android or even just access to a computer, there's a new and wildly efficient way to report these things. It's an application called See-Click-Fix and it's footprint is expanding daily. Cities like North Port and Saint Petersburg, as well as counties like Pinellas and Sarasota are using it.

This is how it works. Residents can download the application on their Apple or Android device. The app can even be accessed on the City of Zephyrhills website under the "Report a Problem" tab. Then the resident can click the "New Request" button. From there, a map application called ESRI, not unlike GoogleMaps, will determine if the request is being made in city limits or not.

A resident can elect to submit the request anonymously or publicly. A contact form with name, address, phone number and email will need to be filled in order to establish city residency but the information can be kept private. This is to prevent spamming requests. It also gives the city a means to reach back out to the petitioner if there are any questions or to notify the work being completed.

A resident can create an account or have their information saved by their own device. Once residency is established and the problem is established within city limits, the request menu becomes available. There are dozens of types of requests and See-Click-Fix will route the request to the appropriate department and also see if a request for the same issue has already been made.

"If it's a pothole, the request will go to public works, if it's a water leak, it'll go to the

Marijuana dispensary coming to Zephyrhills

While work continues to evolve on the new veterans clinic off Eiland Boulevard near the intersection with U.S. 301, another building in that vicinity has been tabbed for a marijuana dispensary that will be among one or two other businesses.

Both buildings are SL2 Consulting projects with construction on the veterans clinic beginning earlier this year and targeted to be open sometime next spring. The other building, just north of the

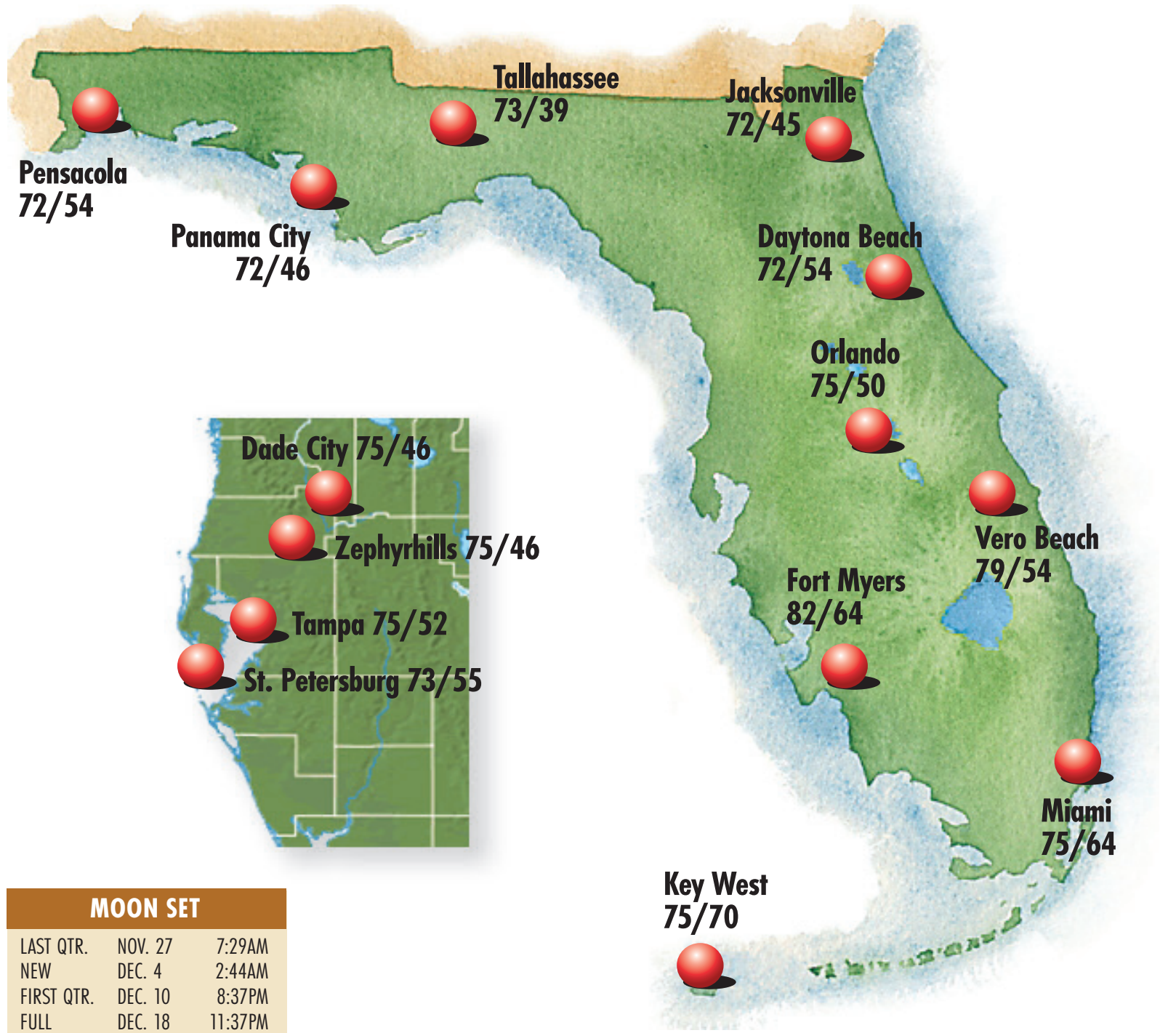

Twas the Night Before the Christmas Ball, a dance featuring a classic rock band from 7 to 11 p.m. Attendees are asked to bring either a \$5 donation or an unwrapped, new toy to the event.

On Saturday, the events really wind up. The lodge will host a Poker Run for bikers. Registration for that starts at 8:30 a.m. There are three other Moose lodges in the area that will be part of the run. Attendees are also asked for a \$5 donation or toy.

The Car & Truck Show is also on Nov. 27, 11 a.m. to 3 p.m. All cars and trucks must be registered for judging. There are awards, prizes, a 50-50 raffle, and silent auction together at the car show. Food and drinks will also be available.

The last of the four events is the Christmas Ball, again that Saturday but from 7 to 11 p.m. This ball will feature a country music band and have a special ceremony that will total up the donations and formally present them to the Marine Corps Reserves.

"Our goal this year is to raise \$25,000 on top of the toys we get donated," Plourde said. "Last year our totals were down but we expect to be back to pre-Covid numbers this year."

Plourde mentioned that in recent years, the lodge raised up to \$30,000 in just donations. The Moose Lodge likes to keep things local. They use the money collected to purchase even more toys to fill the 40-foot trailer. While they shop at corporate giant Walmart, whose corporate headquarters is in Bentonville, Ark., they use the local Zephyrhills Walmart to purchase the additional toys. The Christmas Ball will also be where announcements and prize drawings are made. The final total of money raised will be announced and also the lucky winner of the Wheel Barrow of Cheer will be announced. The wheelbarrow fundraiser has already garnered \$4,000 in raffle ticket sales.

The otherwise private Moose Lodge is throwing open its doors for this charitable endeavor, starting this weekend.

"All these events are open to the public, everyone is invited," Plourde said.

Students can sign up for the Toys for Tots Program at their schools on or the Toys for Tots website: www.toysfortots.org. East Pasco County and Zephyrhills residents, who register with the Toys for Tots Program can pick up the toys at the Zephyrhills Lions Club on Dec. 19.

THANKFULNESS TO GOD cp
SELF-RIGHTEOUS THANKSGIVING

Men and women often-times give their testimonies of faith and prayers to God which sound more like self-praise rather than prayer and thanksgiving unto our Lord God.

In Luke chapter 18, the Lord tells a parable unto his disciples and unto certain unrighteous ones who trusted in themselves for their righteousness. The Lord made the comparison of the Pharisee, who went to the temple to pray, and the publican who went into the temple to pray. The Pharisee prayed thus "with himself," he thanked God that he wasn't like other people and that he fasted and paid tithes. He was happy and thankful for who he was and what he was doing for God. **But how did he leave the temple after praying to God?**

He left...unjustified and unrighteous before God and still a sinner.

But the publican on the other hand, realizing that he was a sinner and un-right before God, stood afar off. He would not lift up his eyes to heaven, and he smote upon his breast, and prayed, "God be merciful to me a sinner." **God heard his prayer. The publican went home justified before God,** rather than the other man, the Pharisee, of whom was not justified.

As our apostle Paul tells us in all of his writings to the Church, the body of Christ, that by the blood of Christ's cross, and by his humility for us on Calvary's cross, that we, who are not under the law for righteousness, can be justified as well. The handwriting of the law was taken out of the way, blotted out, and nailed to Christ's cross (**Colossians 2:14**): "Blotting out the handwriting of ordinances that was against us, which was contrary to us, and took it out of the way, nailing it to his cross." In this dispensation of God's grace, the Lord is dispensing grace, mercy, and peace to all who by faith in the Lord Jesus Christ, will believe His Words to them, in that he died on the cross to pay for their sins, he was buried, and he arose from the dead on the third day for their justification, they shall be saved (**Read 1 Corinthians 15:1-4**).

Ephesians 2:8 For by grace are ye saved through faith; and that not of yourselves: it is the gift of God: 9 Not of works, lest any man should boast. **Romans 3:21** But now the righteousness of God without the law is manifested, being witnessed by the law and the prophets; 22 Even the righteousness of God which is by faith of Jesus Christ unto all and upon all them that believe: for there is no difference: 23 For all have sinned, and come short of the glory of God; 24 Being justified freely by his grace through the redemption that is in Christ Jesus:

Classes that make exercise fun

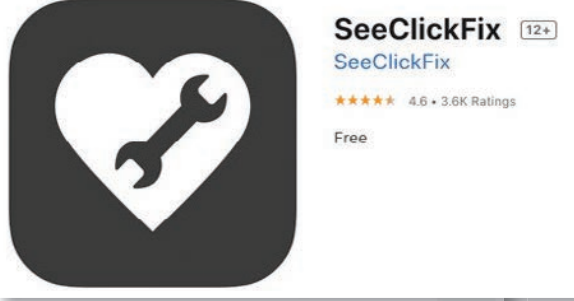

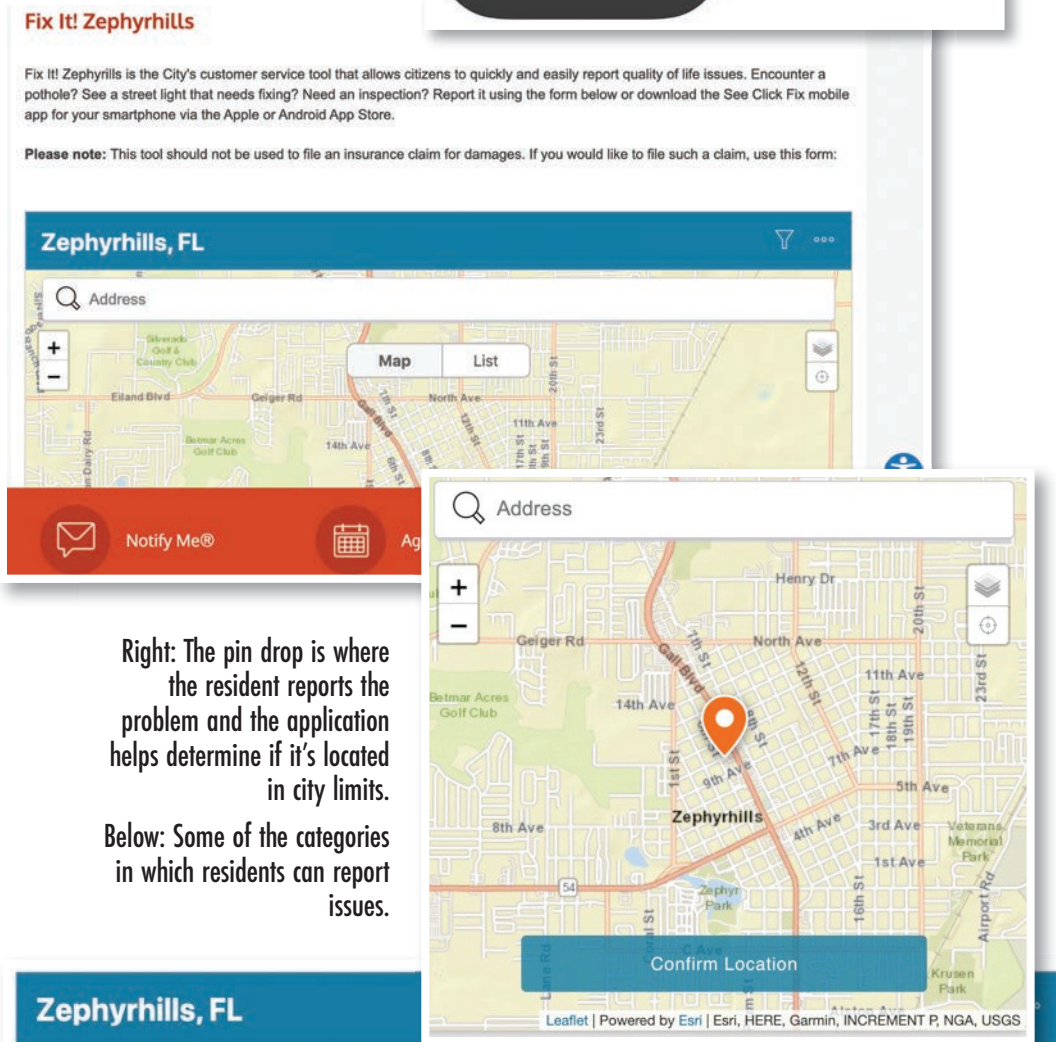


Right: The See-Click-Fix application can be downloaded to an Apple or Android smartphone.

Below: Even if residents don't have a smartphone, the application can be used on the City of Zephyrhills website.

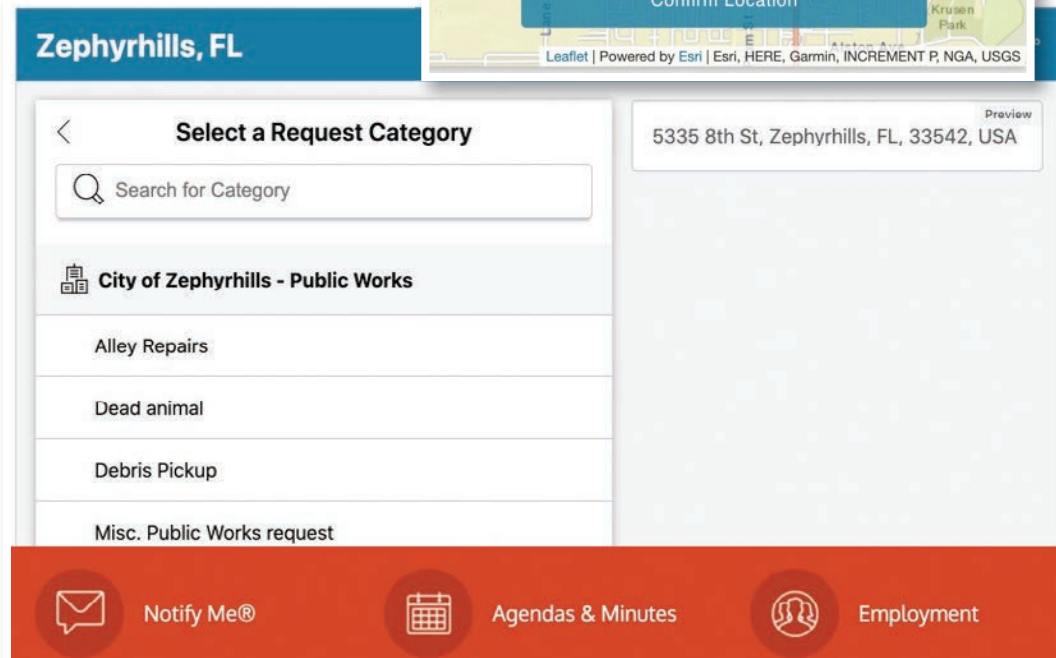

utilities department," IT Director Mike Panak said. From there, there's an option to take a photo (only available on smartphones) of the request/issue. The resident fills out a description of the issue, their contact information and then submits the request.

"It's easier for the citizen to make the request and easier for city workers as it flows into their department programs," Panak said.

See-Click-Fix is now fully integrated in the different city departments' software programs. It didn't used to be. In fact, city officials first became aware of the application back in May of 2018 but the app was not fully integrated into the back end products or software. Currently, different departments use different software applications. The building department uses EnerGov, the utility department uses CityWorks, public works and code enforcement use PubWorks.

"At that time, See-Click-Fix did not interface with all those back end applications," Panak said. "We would have had to come back and manually enter all the information. It would have doubled the work."

City officials were also skeptical as the startup company that developed the application could be sold to anyone at any time. It was enough for city officials to table it, temporarily.

In the interim, both EnerGov and PubWorks created their own applications but they only worked with their own software. For Zephyrhills city officials, it was still a "pass." Eventually, CityWorks, the software for the Zephyrhills Utility Department, started interfacing with See-Click-Fix. Panak and other city officials were warm to it but they still wanted an app that would interface with all of their departments.

The deal got one step closer when the See-Click-Fix app was bought, but by CivicPlus, the web hosting company that the City of Zephyrhills uses. CivicPlus would help create the online request form but the digital landscape was still scattered. PubWorks had their own app, EnerGov had their own, CityWorks was using See-Click-Fix but it still wasn't quite enough.

"Then, about one year ago, we all got together and approached PubWorks about wanting to use See-Click-Fix for all of our front end application use," Panak said. "After some discussion with the owner, they agreed."

The City of Zephyrhills became the first client of PubWorks to go live with See-Click-Fix this past September. With the help of hosting company CivicPlus, See-Click-Fix became the interface application for all city departments and their respective software applications.

"At that point it was a no-brainer," Panak said.

The city announced the launch of the application at the Oct. 11 city council meeting. City officials want to get the word out that this new app is the easiest and fastest way to report issues within the city to the city itself. The rollout has been slow due to the lack of a current public information officer but See-Click-Fix is now the preferred method of reporting issues within the city.

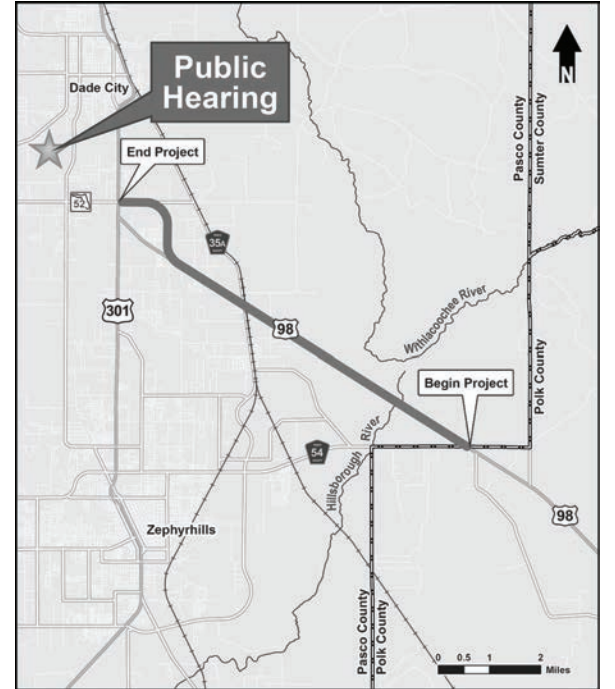
"People are still calling (on the phone), especially with code enforcement but we'd like to divert that traffic to the application," Panak said. "Now, people can take a photo on the spot and submit the request right from their phone."

The project will realign US 98 from north of Townsend Road to US 301. The realignment allows US 98 to align with the Clinton Avenue (New SR 52) intersection at US 301 and was the results of a separate Alternatives Corridor Evaluation (ACE) study (WPI Segment No. 443368-1). The project will improve safety along this segment of US 98 and improve freight routes.

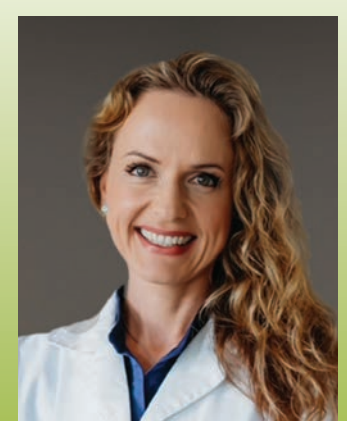

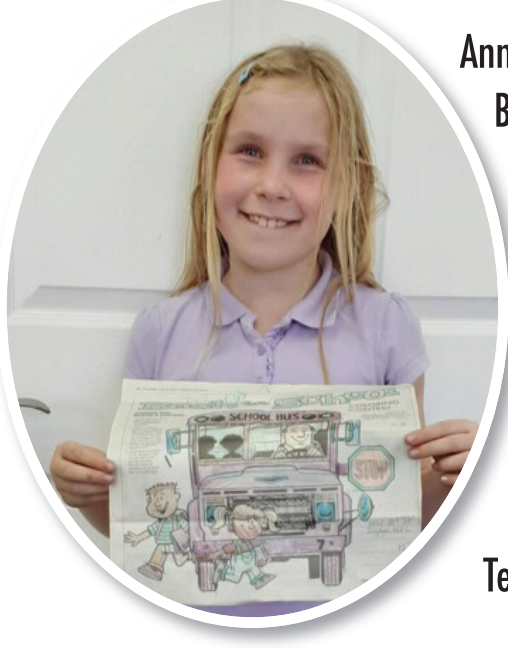

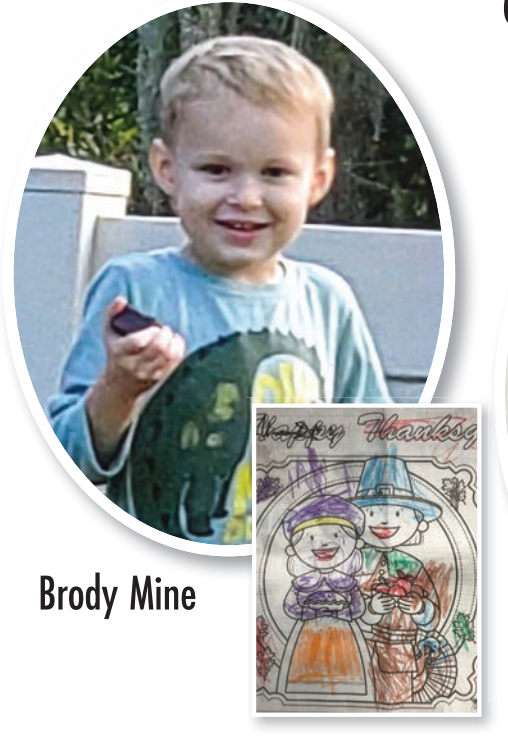

HOLLYWOOD -- Ryan Gosling began his career on "The Mickey Mouse Club," but we'd never have expected him to play "Ken" to the sexy Margot Robbie's "Barbie." Now that Disney owns Mattel, he'll be back in the "club." His last film, "First Man" (2018), barely broke even, but he's since filmed Netflix's most-costly film ever, the action thriller (with a \$200 million price tag) "Gray Man," co-starring Chris Evans, Ana De Armas and Billy Bob Thornton. Will Ken's missing equipment be restored for the Disney movie, or will Barbie dump him again?

Margot Robbie is still one of the busiest actresses in films. She stars in the still-untitled David O. Russell film with a magnificent cast, including Christian Bale, Ramı Malek, Robert De Niro, John David Washington, Zoe Saldana, Mike Meyers, Michael Shannon and Chris Rock. She also toplines "Babylon," as silent-film legend Clara Bow, co-starring Brad Pitt, Toby Maguire and Jean Smart (due Christmas 2022), and she's in the all-star ensemble of Wes Anderson's latest, "Asteroid City," with Tilda Swinton, Bill Murray, Adrien Brody, Tom Hanks, Scarlett Johansson, Bryan Cranston and Jeff Goldblum. Anderson's recent release, "The French Dispatch" (made two years ago and pulled from theaters), got positive reviews from 74% of respondents on Rotten Tomatoes.

The original David Lynch "Dune" (1984) tried to tell the entire story in one film, but making it a huge two-part screen epic seems to have worked for this one. It grossed \$41 million in its first weekend and pulled in nearly 2 million viewers on HBO Max at the same time.

Sure as shooting, the upcoming film "My Son Hunter" won't be favorable to either President Joe Biden or his son Hunter. CVS store, is in the early stages of construction. Truelieve, headquartered in Tallahassee, has more than 100 marijuana dispensaries in Florida. Aside from locations in the Sunshine State, the company that grows, harvests and produce cannabis plants in an eco-friendly environment also has dispensaries in Massachusetts, Connecticut and California.

Lawrence Migliara, a managing partner for SL2 Consulting, said Truelieve would take up 4,000 square feet in the new building. That leaves 2,500 square feet for one or two businesses with the space not yet taken.

"I'm sure that will change as we get closer to being done (with the Truelieve facility)," he said. The marijuana dispensary will be the first stand-alone facility in Zephyrhills with city manager Billy Poe noting that there is only a CBD store downtown. Poe said he was not yet hired in his current position when the process began, adding that "it just has to go through all the city codes."

Cannabis Doc, which sublets space in a building at 6747 Gall Blvd. across from Pin Chasers and just south of the Golden Corral, actually was the first of its kind in Zephyrhills. Cannabis Doc, which has medical marijuana doctors to address healing needs and also has locations in New Port Richey and Tampa, opened in Zephyrhills in 2019.

City planner Todd Vande Berg previously has noted how vital that area has become to the city and how it is reflecting current and previous growth and expansion.

"The intersection of U.S. 301 and Eiland Boulevard has evolved into the city's busiest intersection with a lot of new growth," he said. "It recently includes the Wawa, Culver's and now the veterans clinic with additional retail along the frontage of 301 and more outparcels for development in the rear."

That area of retail and commercial development, Vande Berg noted, also ties into residential growth — just completed, ongoing and planned — throughout the city and its outlying areas in recent years.

"The significant amount of housing increases continues to attract the attention of commercial businesses," he said.

On another note, Vande Berg expects Chipotle, a Mexican restaurant located at 7646 Gall Blvd., to be open.

"We signed off on the development order, so that's ready to open right away," he said. "That's the last step."

Also at the top of the hill on U.S. 301 near Walmart is an ongoing project for a large drive-through car wash project.

"We've approved the site plan," he said, adding, "That's something that should start soon and will probably take six months or so to build."
