# Christmas spirit shines at Symphony of Lights

While there are plenty of festivities and special events to attend throughout the east and central Pasco communities during the winter holiday season,

few draw as much fanfare as the annual Symphony in Lights.

In what has become a festive tradition at this time of year, The Shops at Wiregrass Ranch brings together shopping and those simply wanting to lift their holiday spirits to another level. At the center of the outdoor mall are a handful of large trees with lights that twinkle in time to music.

Additionally, beginning Dec. 1, local talent groups also perform mini-shows on a small stage in front of the trees. The talent shows, along with the music and light shows, run nightly.

# Hercules Park where history meets the future

*Local dignitaries and city officials break ground on the new 12-acre park where Hercules Powder Company once stood*

What was once the Hercules Powder Company Camp No. 39 established in 1946, will now become the site of a very progressive park for the community of Zephyrhills. Several city officials, dignitaries, Zephyrhills Police, Wharton Smith Company Construction Group employees and citizens from the community joined together for a groundbreaking ceremony for this new project in the Zephyrhills community.

When Hercules Powder Company occupied the 80 acres of land, there were 60 to 70 company built prefabricated homes. The homes were occupied by employees of the company who rented the homes for \$4 per room a month. Hercules employed more employees than any other employer in the area.

When asked what it was like to live here, Celia Dobson Paul, who lived on this land from birth until she was 10 years old, said, "You know how children say that it feels like Christmas every day? Well, that is what this community was like. We never had to worry about crime or being snatched up. It was a true community."

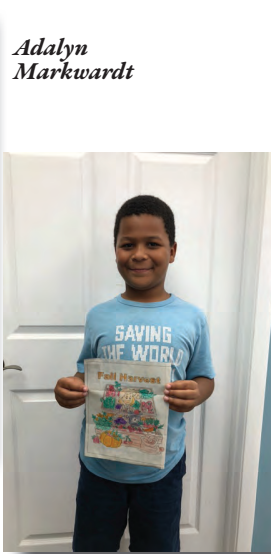

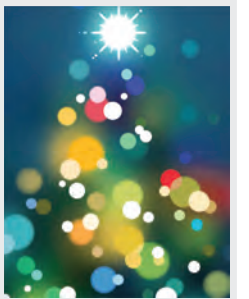

We absolutely love it," said Fran Rooney, who has come for the annual show and to shop several times per year since she and her husband retired from Indiana and moved to Wesley Chapel in 2001.

As popular local disc jockey Mason Dixon counted down — 5...4...3...2...1 — hundreds of people stopped by to see the music start to play and lights on the trees twinkle as part of the Symphony in Lights display. That was just part of the Thanksgiving holiday weekend at the large outdoor mall. Shoppers took advantage of Black Friday deals that carried over through the weekend.

"I'm just about done now," said New Tampa's Louise Pennett, noting that she and her sister, Margaret Cote of Lutz, spent all day Saturday shopping for their adult children and grandchildren.

Added Cote, "We took time out for lunch and had to take stuff back to the car so we could stay and see the lights."

One family, like many, make coming to the Symphony in Lights Show an annual event. Among the children running around with some playing duck-duck goose before the show started were the Islas triplets and their siblings. The 7-year-old triplets — Scarlett, Olivia and Joaquin — were joined by Ella, their 3-year-old sister, and Isaiah, a 2023 Wesley Chapel High graduate.

"We keep coming back because the kids love the lights," said Isaiah, who played football and lacrosse for the Wildcats and was watching his siblings while their mother kept close tabs on them from a nearby bench.

Others showed up for the first time. Nina Alvarez brought her two girls, Juanita, 6, and 4-year-old Elisa. First, they rode the little express train with an engine, four passenger cars and a caboose as it gave people rides along Paseo Drive.

"Look at them. They never seen anything like this," said Alvarez, smiling as she watched her daughters giggle and reach for the fake snow when it was blasted out of a pole near the large trees.

Asked if she would come back again, Alvarez responded, "Oh yes. I'm not done shopping so I'll bring them back."

Before it got too dark for Symphony in Lights to begin, several people ventured to the two tents with Christmas trees. Galaxy Fireworks' Winter Wonderland was the place to purchase real trees such as Balsam Frasers, Douglas Firs, Scottish Pines and Blue Spruces.

"They appreciate our quality and our pricing," said co-manager Bruce Smith, adding that people who buy real trees "appreciate the smell and nostalgia."

Co-manager Kelly Kalliope said the first delivery of trees came in on Nov. 15 with one tent for displays and another for stock. She estimated that 100 trees were sold over last weekend.

MOMENTS IN TIME: The History Channel

- \* On Dec. 11, 2008, Bernie Madoff, the founder and chairman of Bernard L. Madoff Investment Securities LLC, was arrested and subsequently convicted of fraud for the multi-billion-dollar Ponzi scheme that fleeced investors around the world for decades.
- \* On Dec. 12, 1968, American actress Tallulah Bankhead died at the age of 66 from double pneumonia. A flamboyant personality with a huskily seductive voice and a flair for exhibitionism, her greatest success was as a stage actress (she was the inspiration for Blanche Dubois in "A Streetcar Named Desire"), though she also appeared in several prominent films and on TV and radio.
- \* On Dec. 13, 1642, Abel Tasman, a Dutch explorer and merchant, reached the coast of South Island in New Zealand and named it Staten Landt. The first European in recorded history to land on the Australian island state of Tasmania, he claimed it for the Dutch crown, and it was named for him as well.
- \* On Dec. 14, 1974, disaster film "The Towering Inferno," starring professional rivals Steve McQueen and Paul Newman, was released. The film was shot in sequence so all the actors looked authentically haggard and dirty as it progressed.
- \* On Dec. 15, 1840, Napoleon Bonaparte received a French state funeral in Paris more than two decades after his death on the island of St. Helena, when his remains were exhumed and transferred to the Hotel des Invalides on the initiative of the French prime minister and King Louis-Philippe.
- \* On Dec. 16, 1907, in order to demonstrate America's new presence as a world power, President Theodore Roosevelt embarked on a round-the-world cruise in a group of U.S. Navy battleships, making friendly courtesy visits to a number of international ports.
- \* On Dec. 17, 1986, Special Agent Polifrone went undercover to lure out American mafia hitman Richard Kuklinski. Polifrone gave Kuklinski some fake cyanide to use for a murder. Kuklinski found out later that it was fake and decided not to go through with the hit but was arrested at a roadblock on his way home.

lived in the community from birth to the age of four. Mae McKenzie Pickett also lived in the Hercules Powder Company Camp.

After Hercules Powder Company occupied the site, "The land was sold for \$120,000 and a handshake between Harry Morton, superintendent of Hercules Powder Company and Chester Taylor, Superintendent of the Zephyrhills School District," according to Jerry Morton, son of Harry Morton, who attended the groundbreaking. "It is very nice to see they are going to do something positive with the land."

"After the land was sold, the schoolboard opened the Hercules Aquatic Center," said Erica Freeman of the Zephyrhills Historical Society.

Many people in Zephyrhills still talk about the community pool which closed approximately in 2010. "The property still had walking trails and a playground until 2018," said Freeman.

The groundbreaking ceremony will signify the commencement of construction for the 12-acre park located adjacent to Zephyrhills High and Woodland Elementary schools.

"The event marks a significant milestone in the development of a communal space that promises to enhance the quality of life for Zephyrhills residents and visitors alike," said Kevin Weiss, public information office.

The ceremony opened with Zephyrhills City Manager, Billy Poe speaking. "I would like to thank the city council and numerous city staff for their speedy progress with this project."

The park is designed to be a hub for community engagement, recreations, and natural beauty. It will feature walking and bicycle trails, a nature-based playground, a sheltered picnic area, an open playfield, splashpad and restrooms.

Zephyrhills Mayor Melonie Bahr Monson spoke next. "I feel the rich history that served the community well. This park was truly a community park with citizen input. I helped design it when I was a citizen. I started my input then."

Commissioner Ron Oakley went on to say how grateful and proud he was of this project and the City of Zephyrhills. "There is lots of history in this park. Since the last census, Zephyrhills is the largest city in Pasco County. I am grateful for the people coming to the city," said Oakley. "We are also going to have a large bakery nearby creating 600 more jobs in the city."

The event consisted of a board that all attendees could sign. It will be kept on the premises for the duration of the construction of the park. The park is slated to open in December of 2024, marking the City of Zephyrhills first newly built park in over forty years. Wharton Smith gave away back packs with goodies inside. And there was a ceremonial shovel groundbreaking with the City of Zephyrhills Council, Department of Public Works and employees of the Wharton Smith Company Construction Group. # Approval of salary study, carwashes and airport zoning wrap up 2023 city council

*Monday's meeting saw the final acceptance of the Mr. Carwash annexation as well as finalizing other business*

It was another crowded Consent Agenda. 10 items were on the list, some formalities. Item 1.1 asked for approval of the minutes from the 2023 salary study workshop. Basically, most city employees receive the suggested five percent increase with an additional two percent added by council decree. Members of ZPD have a more complicated pay raise structure.

Item 1.2 asked for approval of the Nov. 13 regular meeting minutes. Item 1.3 Asked for approval of the Oct. 9 regular meeting minutes. Item 1.4 was actually pulled from the agenda.

Item 1.5 asked for approval of a scope and fee proposal for box hangars at the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport. The \$191,441 of the \$6,600,000 allocated for the box hangars at Taxiway F and are 100 percent funded by state appropriation.

Item 1.6 was also related to the airport, this item was for the same scope and fee service but for the design and bidding services for Taxiway F. The \$172,311.58 for the service is part of the \$6,600,000 state appropriation.

Item 1.7 asked for a one-year renewal of an R&M Services Contract for hydrant and valve maintenance, as well as repair and flushing services. The annual cost for the service is approximately \$65,000 and includes testing over 800 hydrants. The cost is included in the FY24 Budget.

Item 1.8 asked for approval of the purchase of a flatbed truck, an All Roads Kenworth LLC FSA23VEH21 for the street department. The not-to-exceed cost is \$169,215 and has \$185,000 allocated for capital budget in Penny for Pasco funds that the city receives.

Item 1.9 asked for approval of a complete replacement of all remaining carpet in the ZPD building. Gulfcoast Commercial Flooring will replace carpet in 14 rooms at a cost of \$33,167.57 and is just below the budgeted amount of \$35,000.

Item 1.10 asked for approval of the purchase

of a water division pipe hunter vehicle, as the existing one is becoming irrelevant. The quoted cost is for \$182,792 and is under the \$200,000 approved budget item in the FY24 Budget. All items except for item 1.4 were bundled and passed together 5-0.

In Business Items, both items pertained to the Mr. Carwash annexation and rezoning. Both these items have come before council twice before. Item 2.1 was the annexation of the parcel into city boundaries and Item 2.2 changed the zoning and Future Land Use Map Amendment (FLUMA). Much discussion regarding water use took place in prior meetings. Monday was more of a formality. Both business items were approved 5-0.

In the City Manager's Report, Item 3.1 was an interlocal airport zoning ordinance agreement with Pasco County, Florida Statutes require Zephyrhills and Pasco County to enter into an interlocal agreement or create a joint board to handle airport protection zoning regulations. City staff elected to enter into an interlocal agreement. It includes:

- Map 605-4, the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport Overlay District of Pasco County's LDC shall be effective in the incorporated areas of the city;
- County staff shall notify the city of any development proposals within the district within 10 days for FLU changes, rezonings, applications needing FAA review, use applications within the Approach Surface Floor, Airport Zone, or Airport Influence Area;
- County staff shall notify the city of noise-sensitive land uses quarterly;
- Both parties will notify the other of correspondence with FAA or FDOT regarding land uses at the airport and airport operations;
- City staff shall notify the county when the Airport Master Plan is updated and allow the county to comment;
- City staff will provide written notice to Pasco about any change in airport use, activities, or operations which may reasonably have an impact on adjacent or nearby land uses within 30 days of implementation.

Item 3.1 was passed 5-0.

Item 3.2 was simply a request to cancel the Dec. 27 regular city council meeting. This item was approved 5-0.

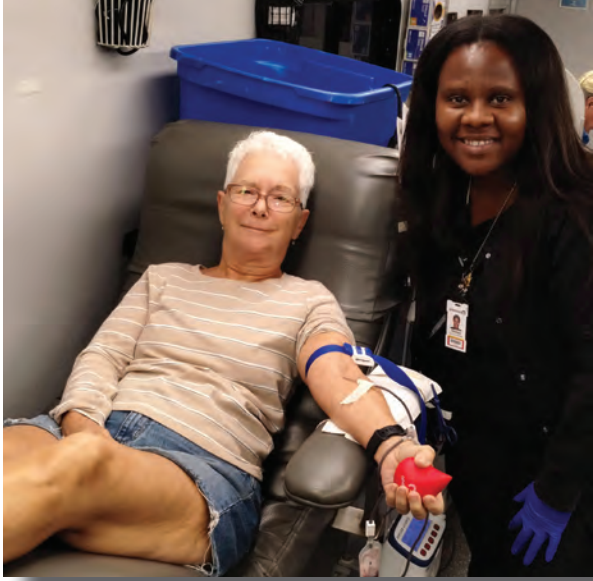

13 that showed up last November. Ribbons and terras were awarded for winners in 14 divisions.

The Princess Punchout represents an increased focus on girls wrestling throughout the state. Last year, Cypress Creek hosted the first all-girls Sunshine Athletic Conference meet.

"Girls wrestling has really blown up," said Ketler, a strong proponent for girls wrestling in Pasco County. "Every year we get more and more girls into the sport."

Aside from the host Bulls, other local teams to compete were Zephyrhills, Wesley Chapel, Cypress Creek and Pasco.

Wiregrass Ranch and Zephyrhills each list eight girls on their rosters, which represents

school records for both. The previous best for Zephyrhills was three girls who wrestled in 2019. Ketler noted that 15 girls came out for his team but he cut the roster to eight.

The Wildcats, who had the best finish among local teams, were runners-up to champion Kissimmee Harmony. The host Bulls came in seventh, one place higher than Cypress Creek. Zephyrhills and Pasco, which had just two and one wrestlers, respectively, finished at the bottom of the standings.

Kohana Martinez, a first-year Wesley Chapel assistant and former Zephyrhills wrestler, spoke highly of her team.

"We have a good group of girls," said Martinez, a two-time state qualifier, two-time regional runner-up and two-time district champion on whose 104 career wins are the most among female wrestlers in the county.

"They're tough and they wrestle hard. They're confident."

Gabbie Asabi, at 120 pounds, and 190-pound competitor Paisley Murphy won their weight classes to lead the Wildcats. Aniya Miranda took third at 235 with fourth-place finishers Katherine Traynor, 100, and Brianna O'Neil at 135 adding to the team's point total.

The finals of the Princess Punchout took on a dramatic aura. Much like televised professional wrestling, the Wiregrass Ranch gym was darkened with music playing in the background while opponents vying for division championships were introduced one-by-one under a spotlight.

"The fans got a chance to cheer," Ketler said. "It was just trying to make it special. We gave the girls an opportunity to go back to their programs and say, hey, that was fun."

Earlier in the day, the Fifth Annual Sgt. Simmons Battle at the Border Duals took place in the same gym. That boys-only competition honored former Wiregrass Ranch coach Matt Simmons, who once was a Sgt. in the Army National Guard and who is currently battling multiple sclerosis.

The host Bulls won with rival Wesley Chapel placing second. "My new guys showed a lot of heart," said Wesley Chapel coach Dan Fleshood, a former Zephyrhills assistant, adding that it was good "Just seeing them get in the work."

Wiregrass Ranch's two dual wins came against Lakeland and Freedom by margins of 42-35 and 58-17, respectively.

Racking up two victories each for the Bulls were: Lorenzo Sanchez, 138; Gianni Gonzalez, 144; Pete Simkins, 150; Sathwick Yarlagadda, 157; Sean Williams, 165; and Andy Garcia, 190.

Wesley Chapel's double winners included Carter Nix, 126; Lance Stone, 132; Christian Bird, 175; and Riley Connolly, 190.
