## DAX Car Auction & Auto Event brings gear heads and the general public back

After enduring some hiatus, even facing the notion of shuttering, the smorgasbord event was back this past weekend

They weren't just back, they were back big time. The four-day event rolled a classic car auction, an automotive-leaning flea market and a car show all together in a cornucopia of nuts and bolts and fenders and drive shafts. NASCAR legend Ernie Irvin was even on site signing autographs and taking photos with fans.

"This is our first year hosting the auction, the car show and the flea market," DAX Marketing Manager Ari Simoes said. "When we took it over, we knew the Zephyrhills community and we wanted to grow the event back to what it used to be. A decade ago, there would have been 500 vendors out here."

Simoes remembers when the events would be packed to the rafters. The last couple of years have had a significant impact on the large gathering public events. DAX (Dealers Auction Xchange) organizers wanted to come back strong for their 2021 Fall installment. They went big, combining all three events. It seems to be working. Simoes said that this past weekend's event drew 167 classic cars to auction, over 100 registered car exhibitors and 175 vendors. Not the numbers from a decade ago but a clear indication that events of this sort are on the come back.

"We already have as many vendors that are here today, signed up for the February event," Simoes said. "We hope to work more with the community and the chamber of commerce to promote future events. We also try to support local businesses."

DAX used local business Song Printing for their flyers, tickets and wristbands. They tapped Red Pelican on 5th Avenue to screen print the t-shirts for the event. Joe Lambert

It had been two years since Main Street Zephyrhills hosted Halloween Howl, but apparently the wait was worth it as hundreds of people filled the downtown streets for an evening of trick-or-treating, entertainment at the Eiland Bandstand and hayrides.

The event was cancelled last year due to the coronavirus pandemic and was the second organized by

Main Street Zephyrhills in the past two months. The non-profit organization organized Music & Motorcycles in September.

As for Halloween Howl, local organizers, as well as plenty of revelers that included lots of children and families, were thrilled with its return.

"After being inside for a full year, folks want to have that new normalcy," said Devin Alexander, Main Street's vice president in charge of promotions. "I think folks are just ready to get things back to normal."

Melonie Monson, executive director of the Greater Zephyrhills Chamber of Commerce, stood in line with her daughter and granddaughter for a traditional hayride. Two tractors pulled two flatbed trailers with hay bales and straw.

## Bulldogs takes a bite out of district rival Cobras

Zephyrhills' 49-20 win highlights homecoming night and secures 50th win in coach Carroll's six seasons

Just one week after clinching the Class 5A, District 9 title with a decisive road win at Nature Coast Tech and with the 9-Mile War against arch-rival Pasco looming, the Zephyrhills football team returned to Bulldog Stadium

last Friday. The home team celebrated a milestone win, 49-20 over district rival Hudson on homecoming night.

The significance of the homecoming win took on a special meaning when coach Nick Carroll informed his team that it was the 50th win in six seasons since taking over for Reggie Roberts in 2016. Roberts and Carroll are former Zephyrhills players with Roberts, now a captain with the Zephyrhills Police Department, posting a 39-23 record (2010-15). Carroll is now at 50-15.

"I'm very happy for all you guys who have been here and all the guys in the past," Carroll said in a post-game

from Red Pelican was happy to be a part of the massive event.

The 1966 Olds is the first American-made car with front-wheel drive since the 1930s Cord. It also has a fascinating speedometer that is a barrel that rolls as the car accelerates.

Bob Heckman of Lakeland brought out his 1937 Diamond 1 to exhibit and it too had a lofty pricetag on it.

"The Diamond 1 was the Cadillac of trucks when it first came out," Heckman said. "This event has been great, so far, I hope it keeps going."

The event has full plans to keep going. The dealer auction continues weekly. The flea market, in light of many area flea markets closing, endures and classic car shows aren't going anywhere. The winter tri-fecta event, like the one this past weekend, is already set for Feb. 10-13, 2022.

"It's amazing to see all these people in downtown Zephyrhills once again," she said. "This is for the kids." "We knew this was coming up and we're so happy they didn't cancel it again," said Alyssa Sands, a Zephyrhills resident who brought her young daughters Taylor and Victoria. "Not a lot of people in our neighborhood do trick-or-treating, so we've always liked coming down here."

Down near the Village Inn at the west end of 5th Avenue was a haunted house. Jodi Wilkeson, the city council's vice president, dressed as the Queen of Hearts and took tickets for a haunted house next to Your Turn, A Board Game Café. There were two versions of the haunted house, non-scary for young boys and girls earlier in the day and a scarier set-up later in the evening. "It's for the little kids," said Gail Hamilton, director of the city's community redevelopment agency. "We don't want to scare them."

Proceeds from the haunted house were earmarked for events put on by Main Street Zephyrhills, noted Hamilton, adding, "It's just nice to see people at a downtown event."

There were costumes galore as people walked up and down the downtown streets, many stopping to peruse items at various vendors' tents. Among those were food and drink stations, local organizations welcoming visitors, jewelry, candles and photography.

A popular destination were the bounce houses and inflatable slides. Some youngsters went up and down the slides repeatedly while others waited in line to take their turns inside the bounce house.

"This couldn't be better for him," Kim Whitman said while watching her 7-year-old son Carson jump to his heart's content in the bounce house. "He's got a lot of energy."



Among the people who work downtown and enjoyed the event by dressing up was Alex Olivencia, a tattoo artist at Main Street Ink. He and his girlfriend, Audrey McClain, dressed as vampires.

"We need something like this here, to get the community hyped about something," he said.

The next downtown event is Festival of Lights on Dec. 4. Billed as a Candyland Christmas with the annual tree lighting and Christmas Parade along 5th Avenue, that Dec. 4 event is from 4-9 p.m.

Before that, however, Main Street Zephyrhills will partner with several other organizations for a Veterans Day celebration that lasts three days, Nov. 12-14. It takes place at 5200 Airport Rd. and features a World War II reenactment, parade and weapons demonstrations among other activities.
