

Defense sparks host Bulldogs

to 26-0 shutout of Hawthorne

Zephyrhills heads into the 9-Mile War against arch-rival Pasco with five consecutive victories

Week after week, Zephyrhills keeps proving that it is a much better football team than the one that got off to a dubious 0-2 start. The host Bulldogs made it five wins in a row last Friday night with a 26-0 shutout of Hawthorne from Alachua County.

For the Bulldogs, it marked their third shutout of the season as they improved to 5-2. Zephyrhills next plays in Dade City in the 9-Mile War game against arch-rival Pasco this Friday.

"There's no better feeling than to have a goose egg up there," coach Nick Carroll said, alluding to the scoreboard with a 0 on the visitors side. "That was important, us getting that fifth win to go to

Dade City."

Zephyrhills led 6-0 midway through the third quarter, before extending that by adding 20 points the rest of the way. The Bulldogs kept the Hornets off the scoreboard with a tough defense that forced four turnovers and came up with three key stops on fourthdown plays.

"In playoff football, we're not going to score every time," said defensive coordinator Matt Jackson, a 2007 Pasco graduate. "We've got to learn to stop people on fourth down, and to bend but not

break."

"There were some hard hits tonight," Carroll added.

The hard-hitting Zephyrhills defense forced four turnovers with Larence Graham and Tre Gallimore each intercepting passes from Hawthorne quarterback Chaz Mackey. Nick Sheldon and Theotis Smith added fumble recoveries.

Graham returned his interception 73 yards, which came on Hawthorne's opening possession and stopped a long eight-play drive. That set up Zyre Roundtree's 13-yard touchdown run for the only score of the first half.

Playoffs or bust for Bulldogs

Zephyrhills girls basketball team raises bar with goal of winning a district championship at home this season

The Zephyrhills girls basketball team came so close to making the playoffs last year. This season, the bar has been set a bit higher with the ultimate goal of winning a district championship and making a deep playoff run

a deep playoff run.

"Absolutely, as well it should be," Zephyrhills coach Chris Smith said of the players' mindset.

"There's no reason we can't win 20 games this year. When I took this over I felt we should win the district in three years and that's what we're going to do this year. I can tell from the intensity at practice that the bar has been raised."

Smith, who enters his third season, coached the Bulldogs to a 10-10 record in the 2018-19 season. That marked the first .500 season for Zephyrhills, which posted losing records for more than a decade before that

Last season was even better with Zephyrhills going 18-8. Bolstered by a seven-game winning streak at the end of the regular season, the team's lofty expectations were dashed with a first-round loss to River Ridge in the Class 5A, District 6 tournament. The Bulldogs were the No. 1 seed in that tourney, which was eventually won by the Royal Knights.







Gallimore's pick in the left corner of the end zone thwarted the Hornets' deepest drive of the game — to the Zephyrhills 10-yard line and came on the final play of the first half.

Hawthorne converted one of two fourthdown plays in the first half. On a fourth-and-2 at the Zephyrhills 47-yard line, Mackey was stuffed for a loss by Brian Ashmore and Maguire Neal. The Hornets made on a fourth-and-12 play with Mackey completing a 35-yard pass to Johnquavis Jones, but when that pair tried to hook up again in the end zone, Gallimore came up with his interception.

The Bulldogs thwarted two more fourthdown attempts by the Hornets in the second half. Needing just one yard from the Zephyrhills 11-yard line, fullback Dre Lawrence, who rushed for a game-high 106 yards, was gang-tackled for a loss. Then, with Hawthorne needing less than a yard on fourth down from the Zephyrhills 28-yard line, Sheldon tackled Brian James at the line of scrimmage for no gain.

'That's a huge focus for us, not only to take the ball away, but to score," Jackson said.

While they did not score on a turnover like last week when Smith returned an interception for a touchdown in a win over River Ridge, two stops on fourth downs and Smith's interception of Mackey set up three late Zephyrhills touch-

Leading 6-0, the Bulldogs got two long scoring runs from Gallimore and another from Jaylin Thomas late in the game. Gallimore, who

had just three carries for a team-leading 88 yards, scored on runs of 53 and 39 yards. The first came on a burst through the middle of Hawthorne's defense and the second score was a run down the left sideline.

Following Smith's fumble recovery, set up by Dajuan McCullough's hard tackle on Mackey, Thomas took a pitchout and ran down the left sideline for his touchdown.

Zephyrhills entered the game against Hawthorne with 14 takeaways for the season and increased that number to 18.



On Feb. 19, 2019, Pasco County deputies and detectives responded to the discovery of a deceased man located in Zephyrhills. The deceased subject was discovered in a pond directly behind the Home Depot on Eiland Boulevard and State Road 54. Investigators eventually learned in the coming days, the decedent was 38-year-old Carlos Saint Louis. Louis had been reported missing in Tampa by his family on Feb. 5, 2019 after learning he had not shown up to work.

He was last seen by his father the evening of Feb. 1. On Sunday, Louis' brother received an early morning text message from him indicating he should be home within the next couple hours; however, he was never heard from or seen again. Louis' vehicle, a grey 2015 Chevrolet Sonic LT, has since been located and recovered and the Pasco Sheriff's Office continues to investigate leads from the evidence collected during the investigation

From what is know, Louis led a personal and private life but he was loved by his friends and family. He was known to volunteer his time and worked with the Broward Outreach Center, feeding the homeless and providing education to people living with HIV/AIDS. He expressed what a great experience it was to have the opportunity to give back to the community and speak with different people, all with different backgrounds. He said, "A lot in return was given back to me."

After learning about Louis' death, his brother, who knew something was wrong when he didn't show up for work, said he is "definitely going to miss him" and his plea- "Bring justice to the family because this person needs to be off the streets.'

One friend said, "I miss him so much. We laughed, joked, and talked for hours, made ways to be there for one another. Everybody he came in contact with thought very highly of him."

For his part, Smith took that defeat on his shoulders, acknowledging that he changed the team's style somewhat from its typical up-tempo attack.

"I wanted to make sure they knew that was on me," he reasoned.

As for the late-season winning streak that lifted the Bulldogs from a team hovering around the .500 mark to the top seed for the tourney, Smith said, "I think everybody just bought in to what we were trying to do and they became more of a team. We played pretty good against

teams we thought we'd struggle against."

The Bulldogs boast a solid core or returners to go along with senior Ashauna Jones, a forward-guard who transferred from Zephyrhills Christian Academy. The other starters are: Taija McCullough, the team's leading scorer last season who is a senior point guard; guards Makenna Campbell and Maya Llanes; as well as Mikayla Cintron, a 5-foot-10 center-forward.

"Taija is the leader on and off the court," Smith said. "Everybody follows her lead and her temperament.' Senior Mercedes Krueger, who can play

forward and guard, is the first player off the bench. Smith considers Krueger and Jones as the team's quiet leaders.

Part of the reason for the team's turnaround in recent seasons stems from Smith's involvement beyond the high school team. He also has organized the Zephyr Elite, boys and girls teams that play an Amateur Athletic Union schedule in the offseason. This past spring and summer, however, that program was shut down due to the coronavirus pandemic.

Smith also attends the Stewart Middle games to check out the local players coming up through the system.

"I go to as many of the middle school games as I can," Smith said, adding, "We've got

to keep this going." While the younger players are realizing that Smith cares enough to show up for their games, his high school athletes are well aware of that as well. Smith shows up as often as he can to watch his basketball players when they

participate in other varsity and junior varsity

"I'm here for the girls," he said. "I take pride in that."

Zephyrhills opens the regular season on Nov. 16 with a home game against Mulberry. Before that, however, the Bulldogs will take part in a preseason classic hosted by Wesley Chapel. In the first preseason game of that tour ney, they go up against perennial powerhouse Lakeland Santa Fe Catholic, which has three standout players.

"I want to see us compete against them,"



HOLLYWOOD -- There's no denying that one of the greatest films of all time is 1972's "The Godfather," which received 10 Oscar nominations and won Oscars for: best picture; best actor, Marlon Brando; and best adapted screenplay, Mario Puzo (who wrote the original book) and Francis Ford Coppola (who also directed the film). It grossed \$287 million. Three years later "The Godfather II" won four Oscars for: best picture; supporting actor, Robert DeNiro; again for best adapted screenplay for Puzo and Coppola; and best director, Francis Ford Coppola. It grossed \$80 million. But when 1990's "Godfather III" was released, the bloom must have been off the blossom, winning no Oscars but still besting "Godfather II" grosses with \$137 million.

Director Barry Levinson, who directed "Diner" (1978), "The Natural" (1982), "Good Morning Vietnam" (1987), "Bugsy" (1991) and "Rain Man" (1991), for which he won a best director Oscar, is directing "Francis and the Godfather." Oscar Isaac ("Star Wars'" Poe Dameron), will play Francis Ford Coppola and Jake Gyllenhaal has been cast as Robert Evans, the former actor who was the head of Paramount Pictures, the studio that made "The Godfather" films.

Levinson will soon be announcing actors to play Marlon Brando, James Caan, Robert Duvall and Diane Keaton, among others. When Marlon Brando won his Oscar, he sent American Indian Sacheen Littlefeather to accept his award and deliver a message about the plight of the American Indian. Brando went on to make epic films such as "Last Tango in Paris" (1972), "Missouri Breaks" (1976), "Superman" (1978) and "Apocalvpse Now" (1979) (directed by Francis Ford Coppola) and his last film, "Superman Returns" (2006). Levinson redeveloped this screenplay, which was based on a Black List script, but that's another story among the many to be told about the making of "The Godfather."

When asked what he thought of Barry Levinson making this film, Coppola said, "Any movie Barry Levinson makes about anything will be interesting and worthwhile!"

Ricky Martin, who hasn't made a film since 2018's "The Assassination of Gianni Versace," in which he played Antonio D' Amico (Versace's lover), is shooting Netflix's Nov. 13 release of "Jingle Jangle: A Christmas Journey," a live-action musical film with Keegan-Michael Key, Phylicia Rashad and Forest Whitaker, who plays a toymaker Jeronicus Jangle, whose prize creation is stolen. It will feature original songs by "The Voice" judge and EGOT member (Emmy, Grammy, Oscar and Tony Award winner) John Legend, Philip Lawrence and Davy Nathan, and includes "This Day," performed by Usher and Kiana Lede.

Ricky Martin plays Don Juan Diego, a devious 12-inch matador. If he doesn't sing in this one, it will be a bunch of bull!

the state meet at Apalachee Regional Park in Tallahassee.

Madison, battling through ankle pain mos of the season, finally got to the bottom of the problem, identifying a tendon/ligament issue that she found stretches for. The specialized stretching alleviated the problem to an extent and it has taken the spur out of her shoe, so to speak. Madison Poe turned in a third-place performance at the district meet in 23:45.

That time may seem slogging but nothing could more aptly describe the course at Sand Hill than, "slogging." Runners tackled a series of hills but even more dragging were stretches of sand; in some cases, the powdery sugar sand that sucks at feet, slowed down runners. The top female runner Mia DeRonda of Nature Coast only ran a 22:08.

"The ankle was good all the way until the end on that final hill," Madison Poe said. "Then it, my hip, my whole leg started hurting. I was still determined to get in that top four to make regionals. I knew the Nature Coast girl (DeRonda) was going to be first, so I tried to just stay with her. She left me by about the third mile but I tried to keep her in my view."

William Poe, in his first ever district cross country meet, turned in a fourth-place finish in 18:40. Again, a relatively slow time, Poe's times have been in the 17's most of the season but the slow course needs to be taken into context.

Race winner John Carbone of Central ran a 17:15. Runner up Zack Poekert of Cypress Creek ran an 18:01. Poe's finish qualifies him for the regional meet, also his first. The siblings will have the finish to this season and the full 2021 season to make their marks on Zephyrhills cross country...together.

"My goal, the whole time, was just to keep that third-place Cypress Creek guy (John Rowsell) in my sight," William Poe said. "I would just try to see where he was and if I needed to speed up."

The boys team placed fourth at the meet

out of six teams. The girls behind Poe, got a regional qualifying bid from senior Emily Franklin. Those three will race at regionals.

Cypress Creek made their mark on Saturday with the boys team winning the district title and the girls team taking the district runner-up hardware.

"I'm excited, this is not bad for my first year to start as a coach," girls coach Elsie Rehberg said. "Everyone decided to show up today with an intent to win."

Rehberg, in just her first year as coach, takes over the program as former boys coach John Hoffman, who built the program, took a position with Florida Virtual School and now is a volunteer coach for the Coyotes.

There's promise for the Coyotes, as well. Top male runner Zack Poekert is just a sophomore. He managed to place second at the district meet in 18:01.

"I was in front at the beginning but the sand and those hills got to me," Poekert said. "Everyone on the team stepped up today. They

knew what they had to do.' Behind Poekert came senior John Rowsell in third. Rowsell along with Adam Rahman, Justin Ludwig and Lathen Falk would be the five scorers for the Coyotes. Their runs helped the Coyotes edge the Nature Coast Sharks by just three points to claim the Class 2A District 9

title. "This is so gratifying," Hoffman said. "It was super close, every kid on the team had an impact on the results today. Our three to nine runners have been in different places throughout the year. They use each other to compete and it pushes everyone."

The Coyote girls got fourth and sixth-place finishes from Carlie Ortiz and Virginia Webb, respectively.

"I was so nervous for this meet," the freshman Ortiz said. "Our team members are all so nice and friendly, it calmed me down."

Jenna Stahlgren, Sienna Silvest and Christyn Trappey rounded out the scoring for the Coyotes and the whole team will compete Friday morning at regionals.
