Bulldogs can't keep pace with district rival Gators

Zephyrhills drops to 1-1 after a 72-66 loss to defending district champion Land O' Lakes

A season-opening win over River Ridge had no bearing on the second game of the season for the Zephyrhills boys basketball team. The host Bulldogs lost 72-66 to defending Class 5A, District 6 champion Land O' Lakes on Alan Reed Court. Both offenses played at a fast pace while there were few stellar plays on defense for either team.

That makes it two consecutive losses to the Gators, who defeated the Bulldogs in last season's district championship game. Zephyrhills dropped to 1-1 for the season, 0-1 in the district, while Land O' Lakes improved to 2-0 overall as well as in 5A-6.

"Obviously, we didn't protect the ball," said Mike Novak, who is in his fifth season as the Zephyrhills coach. "We made a few good plays, but then we turned the ball over. We'd make a little run there

and then we'd have a guy (on Land O' Lakes) wide open."

The game was close for most of the first half with Land O' Lakes taking a 16-14 lead in the first quarter before Zephyrhills rallied for a 35-34 halftime lead. Gavyn Dorsey hit a 3-point shot before scoring on a steal and layup to give the Bulldogs a quick 5-0 lead in a fast-paced first half. That lead, however, did not hold up.

The downfall for the Bulldogs came early in the third quarter when the Gators went on a 13-2 run. That stretch began with a 7-0 run and although Zephyrhills made a late rally it was not nearly enough to overcome that deficit, which resulted in Land O' Lakes' 21-11 scoring advantage.

Kevin Pagan, Zephyrhills' junior power forward who finished the game with 17 points, acknowledged that Zephyrhills made a late run with a 20-17 scoring advantage in the fourth quarter. But, he noted, it was not enough to overcome a bad third quarter.

"We gave up in the second half," he said. "We responded in the fourth quarter, but it was too late."

Aside from Pagan Zephyrhills had two other scorers in double figures. Dorsey, a senior guard, had 21 points to share game-high scoring honors with Land O' Lakes' Nate Santana, that team's captain and senior point guard. Jimmy Mcauley added 16 for the Bulldogs, who also got eight points from Makell Toby.

Bulldogs open season on the mat

Short-handed Zephyrhills comes up short in a 47-30 loss to Wiregrass Ranch in wrestling opener

There has been quite a transition for the Zephyrhills High wrestling team, which lost two of three coaches in the offseason and once again has a short-handed roster that leaves some weight classes vacant.

That said, head coach Mike Martinez, an assistant last year, is optimistic about the program's future. Still, he would like a little help since he is handling all the coaching duties after the departures of former head coach Daniel Fleshood and former assistant Shawn Lewis. Both left Zephyrhills to coach the Wesley Chapel wrestling team.

"I've got to be that way, because I'm doing something I love to do," Martinez said of his optimistic outlook.

It is somewhat of a family affair for Martinez. His wife, Kahlia, films the meets while his son and daughter wrestle for the Bulldogs. Jaiden is a junior who competes in the 138-pound weight class and Kohana is a sophomore who wrestles in the 106 division.

"My kids wanted to get into wrestling, so I stopped what I was doing and learned about what they were doing," said Martinez, a former martial arts competitor in California and Florida.

Zephyrhills opened the regular season with a 47-30 home loss to Wiregrass Ranch. Even though the Bulldogs had to forfeit in six weight classes they racked up five pins, four at the varsity level and one in the junior varsity matchup.

"Not bad for what we had because of the forfeits," Martinez said. "The good thing is they didn't quit. They were aggressive. They were still trying to win. For a small team it was very positive. They pushed through."

Zephyrhills has three girls on the roster for a second straight season. Martinez's daughter and Gabby Popolillo return while Annaleese Thomas has replaced Ashlynn Porter. Last year marked the first time the Bulldogs had female wrestlers.

Kohana Martinez pinned her opponent while Thomas was pinned. Popolillo also was pinned but

Stewart Bulldog soccer takes first win of season in 6-0 style

Both the Bulldogs and Cyclones were winless coming in, but the Bulldogs would emerge with their first victory

A frigid night at Pasco High School left the Stewart Bulldogs and Centennial Cyclones chattering their teeth as they awaited the finish of the first half of the double-header. Pasco and Pineview middle schools clashed in the early game. The Bulldogs and Cyclones did their best to keep warm while waiting to take the field. Both teams were in search of their first win of the season.

The Bulldogs would strike early and often. The Bulldogs put immediate pressure on the Cyclone defense. Malachi Woodard was part of that early pressure and in the first 15 minutes. He pushed a shot deep into the 18-yard box but Centennial's Norman Kline got in front of it for the deflection. Bryce Cencerik also made some defensive stops to keep Stewart off the board.

Centennial flipped the field when Brandon Temple drove the ball deep into Stewart territory only being thwarted by a save from the Stewart keeper. That's when the Bulldogs ramped up the attack. Maverick Darrough just missed on a point-blank shot-on-goal after a lively foray in the 18-yard box. It won a corner kick but even that would not land in the net. Finally, Dylan Fleshood got loose on a breakaway and buried the ball inside the near post for a 1-0 Stewart lead. Centennial keeper Christian Jacobs would make a great save just before the water break of the first half.

Woodard continued to pressure the Centennial defense. When Andres Pamas checked in, the two combined to terrorize the Cyclone defense the rest of the way. Just minutes after the water break,

Foods that can positively affect mood

No one is immune to the occasional bad mood. Whether it's the weather, waking up on the wrong side of the bed or another variable, various factors can have an adverse affect on a person's mood.

- Nuts and seeds: The minerals selenium, copper, magnesium, manganese, and zinc have all been linked to mental health, and nuts are rich in each of those minerals. Hackensack Meridian Health notes that almonds, sunflower seeds, pumpkin seeds, walnuts, and peanuts are particularly good sources of the immune system-boosting minerals zinc and magnesium.
- Dark, leafy greens: Dark, leafy greens like kale, spinach and collards are rich in iron

and magnesium, both of which can increase serotonin levels and help reduce feelings of anxiety. Dark, leafy greens also help the body fight inflammation, which can have a positive effect on mood. A 2015 study published in the journal JAMA Psychiatry found that brain inflammation contributed to certain behaviors, including low mood, that appear during major depressive episodes.

- Dark chocolate: Chocolate lovers may be happy to learn that dark chocolate can improve mood. A 2009 study published in the Journal of Proteome Research found that dark chocolate helped to reduce levels of the hormone cortisol, which has been linked to stress. Hackensack Meridian Health notes that, when consumed in moderation, dark chocolate made of at least 70 percent cocoa can help people relax.

Various foods can have a beneficial effect on mood, potentially helping people to stay positive when doing so proves challenging.

Peppermint Bark Is Taste of Holidays

The holiday season tastes like peppermint, and most of us can't get enough. Peppermint mocha brightens the morning, peppermint ice cream makes us dreamy at night, and cute red-and-white-striped candy canes evoke festive childhood memories during the hours in between.



While on the topic of peppermint whatevers, I can't leave out yummy — and trendy — peppermint bark. Who can resist the sweet layers of dark and white chocolate topped with crunchy peppermint bits? The bright holiday tins filled with the confection at high-end kitchenware stores are tempting to buy, but they're also pricey.

This year, make your own batch or two of peppermint bark with this easy, economical version using ingredients from the baking section and candy

aisle of the grocery store. Older kids can melt candy coating (almond bark) in the microwave, while preschoolers pound candy canes into small bits with a toy hammer to sprinkle on top. Working together with you, the entire prep takes less than half an hour. The kids can scoot off to another activity while the bark cools and hardens.

EASY HOLIDAY PEPPERMINT BARK

- 1 pound good-quality chocolate confectionary coating, broken into pieces. (Look for it in the grocery baking section, sometimes labeled "almond bark" or "candy coating")
- 1/2 teaspoons pure peppermint extract
- 12 ounces good-quality white vanilla-flavored confectionery coating, broken into pieces
- 1/2 cup crushed candy canes

1. Line a baking sheet with foil sprayed with nonstick cooking spray.
2. In a microwave-safe bowl, heat chocolate coating, uncovered, for 90 seconds on high power, and stir. Continue to microwave and stir at 30-second intervals until almost melted. (Be sure to use a dry bowl and utensils.) Add 1 teaspoon peppermint extract, and stir until smooth.
3. Pour onto the foil-lined baking sheet. Spread evenly into a thin layer, approximately 10 by 14 inches.
4. In another microwave-safe bowl, heat white coating as in step 2. Add 1/2 teaspoon peppermint extract (optional), and stir until smooth. Spoon evenly over chocolate layer, which should be setting up, but not hard, as you want the white layer to bond with the base layer.
5. Immediately sprinkle peppermint pieces over all and lightly press them into the white layer with a spatula or a spoon. Don't wait on this step, or the top layer will harden and the candies won't stick.
5. Let stand for an hour or refrigerate until hardened. Break into pieces. Makes about 1 3/4 pounds.

I call this recipe Christmas Chicken because it's a beautiful holiday dish with lots of colorful red tomatoes, white pasta and green basil or parsley. It's also inexpensive, simple to make, and can be doubled to easily feed a crowd.



I look forward to sharing it with my family and friends for years to come. Merry Christmas, and have a blessed holiday season!

CHRISTMAS CHICKEN

- 1 pound boneless skinless chicken breasts, chicken thighs or a combination of both
- 2 tablespoons poultry seasoning, divided
- 2 teaspoons salt, divided
- 2 teaspoons ground black pepper, divided
- 3/4 teaspoon cayenne pepper
- 1 cup all-purpose flour
- 8 ounces penne pasta
- 1/4 cup olive oil
- 1/4 stick butter
- 1 large yellow onion, chopped
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 (28-ounce) can Cento or San Marzano crushed tomatoes
- 1/8 teaspoon ground cloves or nutmeg

- 1/4 teaspoon sugar
- 1 cup fresh flat-leaf parsley or basil, cut into ribbons
- 1/2 cup grated Parmesan or Romano cheese

1. Cover chicken breasts with plastic wrap and pound each piece to an even thickness, about 1 inch in the thickest parts. Remove the plastic and sprinkle each piece of chicken on both sides with 1 tablespoon of the poultry seasoning, 1 teaspoon each of the salt and 1 teaspoon freshly ground pepper, and 1/8 teaspoon of the cayenne pepper.
2. To the flour, add 1/2 tablespoon of the poultry seasoning, 1/2 teaspoon salt and 1/2 teaspoon of the black pepper, and mix well. Press the chicken into the flour on both sides, shake off the excess and set aside.
3. Make the pasta according to package directions. When the pasta is cooked, drain it but reserve 1/2 cup of the pasta water to add to the sauce.
4. Meanwhile, heat the olive oil and butter in a large heavy skillet over medium heat until sizzling, about 2 to 3 minutes. Add the seasoned chicken and pan-fry for 4 to 5 minutes on each side until golden brown.
5. Place the chicken on a plate and set aside. Add the onions to the pan and cook for 2 minutes. Add in the garlic, tomatoes, the remaining 1/2 tablespoon poultry seasoning, 1/2 teaspoon salt, 1/2 teaspoon pepper and 1/2 tablespoon cayenne, and the cloves or nutmeg and sugar. Turn heat to simmer, and cook to a sauce-like mixture, about 5-7 minutes. Add the reserved pasta cooking water as needed if the sauce is too thick.
6. Cut the chicken into strips and add it to the sauce. Stir in half of the parsley or basil. Top the drained pasta with the sauce and stir to combine over medium heat for about 1 to 2 minutes. To serve, sprinkle the pasta with the remaining parsley or basil and the grated cheese. Serves 4 to 6.

In addition to Santana, the Gators got 15 and 14 from Kobe Dillon and Jordan Massie, respectively.

In the River Ridge game, Pagan paced the Zephyrhills attack with 22 points. Mcauley had 17, Dorsey 15 and Toby 12.

At the junior varsity level, the Bulldogs improved to 2-0 with a 60-53 win over the Gators. They opened the season with a 73-38 defeat of River Ridge. Both games were played at home.

Zephyrhills led Land O' Lakes most of the way and beat that team's press late to hang on for the win. Coach James Kirk felt his team could have won by a greater margin if not for being deficient in one category.

"If we rebounded the basketball, we would've had about 30 more points," he said.

Gilbert Vargas, a recent transfer from Puerto Rico, paced the home team's offense with 17 points. Preston Linville added 15, which included a pair of 3-pointers. Teammate Ken McCullough also chipped in with two 3-point shots.

it came in the third round against Josiah Keim, a Wiregrass Ranch freshman wrestling in his first varsity match.

"She's strong and she resisted for a long time," Keim said.

"That was the match of the night," said Bulls coach Jamey Ketler, who described Popolillo as "one of their hammers."

Parnias banged one just over the crossbar and Woodard connected with a cross, using his chest to tap in the team's second goal. That 2-0 margin would hold into halftime.

The Bulldogs came out fast for the second half. Parnias harried the Cyclone defenders and only some gritty saves from Jacobs kept the match from being a runaway.

"He (Jacobs) is so strong when it comes to defense," Cyclone coach Amber Larson said. "If he wasn't my only keeper, he could play anywhere."

Yet, in the first 15 minutes of the second half, the Bulldogs would strike again, this time on a penalty kick. Just minutes later, Faris Alkhafaji made it 4-0 after a great save by Jacobs

The writing was on the wall during the last 15 minutes of the match but the Bulldogs were not going to put it in cruise control. Parnias banged in a rebound off of Jacobs and would strike again on a highlight-reel play, splitting two defenders and banging it in near post to make it 6-0.

"They can see now that they can play," Bulldog coach Jamie Rulison said. "We needed to get this win and we were not going to give up."

The win gave the Bulldogs time to celebrate but the time isn't likely to last as they face two of the toughest teams in the county next - Pineview and John Long.

"These next two games are going to be tough," Rulison said.
