Bulldogs follow up second victory ever in a postseason with a 32-0 loss to Orlando Jones to finish 8-3 overall

Just one week after winning its eighth straight game to turn around a dubious 0-2 start to the 2020 season, the Zephyrhills High football team bowed out of the playoffs after last Friday night's 32-0 road loss to Orlando Jones.

The Bulldogs, who had six shutouts this season and made the playoffs for the sixth time in seven years, were coming off 26-0 and 62-0 playoff wins over Weeki Wachee and Anclote, respectively. Those two games gave Zephyrhills back-to-back playoff wins for the first time in school history, but the Class 5A region semifinal loss ended the Bulldogs deepest playoff run ever.

In fairness, however, Orlando Jones has had more experience in the postseason. Last year, they made it to the state final and lost to Miami Northwestern.

"They're a good football team. There's no doubt about it," Zephyrhills coach Nick Carroll told his players afterward. "Good things come to an end. You overcame a lot of adversity and made history. I'm very proud of you guys and what we accomplished this

Carroll, a former Bulldog player, specifically thanked the group

"Seniors, it's been a pleasure," he said. "I've enjoyed coaching you for the past four years. It didn't come out the way we wanted

to. We were district champions and we won a lot of games.' "You stuck around and decided you wanted to build something for the future," added defensive coordinator Matt Jackson.

"The future is very bright." Some of that adversity came early on when a player contracted COVID-19 and the Bulldogs had to cancel the first two games on their schedule. Plus, the Orlando Jones game initially was scheduled to be played at Bulldog Stadium, but the venue was changed

when the Pasco School District banned fans from games for last

week and the foreseeable future. As for Zephyrhills' final game of the season, Orlando Jones took a 22-0 halftime lead. The Fightin' Tigers capped their opening 10-play, 75-yard drive with a gutsy fourth-and-21 play. Quarterback Tysan Robbins connected with A'ceon Cobb on a 38-yard scoring

Fourth quarter push can't close gap on Sunlake as **Bulldogs fall 68-64**

Despite trailing by as much as 10 points, the Bulldogs brought it to within one basket in the fourth quarter

The Bulldogs were riding a 3-0 record, the Seahawks had just endured a thrashing at the hands of Carrollwood Day School in Tampa. The Bulldogs got caught with their heads in the clouds, the Seahawks had their heels in the dirt.

You can't be good if you can't put into play what you've been practicing for two weeks," Zephyrhills head coach Chris Smith said. "We need to do some soul searching. We're not as good as we think we are. We need to play basketball."

The Bulldogs' vaunted press defense lasted just Sariyah Waller shredded it, jumping out to a 7-2 and then a 12-2 lead, as Waller picked off a pass and took it to the other end of the floor for a layup. A threepointer from Maya Llanes cut the lead to five points minutes later but Waller would strike again, going coast-to-coast. Llanes answered the fast break and just before the end of the quarter, dished one off to Madison Driggers for a basket to make it 16-11.

Driggers returned the favor to start the second quarter, hitting Llanes on an outlet pass that cut the lead to four. Llanes followed it up with a steal at the top of the key and took it back in for a score. The Bulldogs were making errant passes and were operating a little too fast, edging into recklessness. Fouls began to stack up on both sides and it would be Zephyrhills first into the double bonus.

Preseason split on the court for the Bulldogs

Zephyrhills welcomes tough boys basketball teams from Polk County for preseason classic

The Zephyrhills High boys basketball team opened the regular season with three home games on the schedule this week. However, before taking on Sunshine Athletic Conference rivals River Ridge, Land O' Lakes and Fivay, the Bulldogs prepared for the upcoming season by playing a pair of tough opponents from Polk County.

Zephyrhills played two games last week

at Alan Reed Court, splitting with those talented squads from a county to the east of Pasco. Zephyrhills opened the preseason classic with a thrilling 65-61 win over Lake Gibson before a 62-49 loss to Lakeland George Jenkins. Those teams have come to Zephyrhills for preseason games since 2016.

Coach Mike Novak put that short series into proper perspective, noting that he purposely schedules teams with a high level of skill during the preseason. That way, he figures, he can get a barometer of how good of a team he has.

We try to play good competition from Polk County," said Novak, who is in his fifth season as the Bulldogs' head coach.

As for the first three regular-season foes, Novak gave a brief assessment. "River Ridge is rebuilding. They're







now a football school," he said of the Royal Knights, who just two years ago were challenging for district and conference championships. "Obviously, Land O' Lakes is the defending district champion. They're always tough."

And, he added, that Fivay is an up-and-coming team with two consecutive winning seasons.

While the preseason loss to George Jenkins was hardly close, the Lake Gibson game turned into quite the battle. The Bulldogs led most of the way, taking a lead early in the first quarter and

never trailing.

The Braves got a 3-point shot by Idzen Rosado Rosa tied the score at 58 with 1:13 left in regulation. Zephyrhills' Marc Dortch put the home team ahead with a trey, but Lake Gibson got another 3-pointer for a 61-61 tie with just 32 seconds left.

From there, the Zephyrhills defense tightened and did not allow another score by Lake Gibson. Offensively, captain Gavyn Dorsey took over in the waning minutes. The senior forward hit a pair of free throws before making a steal and a layup at the buzzer to account for a thrilling four-point victory.

"I've just got to do anything I can to help my team," said Dorsey, more focused on talking about the importance of his defensive play than making clutch baskets down the stretch. 'Coach Novak always emphasizes great defense, so that's what I'm going to do."

Novak talked about his team's valiant effort, especially at the end of the game when Lake Gibson closed the gap

"What a start. They weathered the storm," he said. "I think we lost our composure a little bit. It's a learning experience for

As for Dorsey, who as a captain is expected to take on more of a leadership role this season, Novak said, "He did a great job


Novak noted that he, the assistant coaches and players appreciated solid support from a home crowd that cheered loudly for the Bulldogs: "It was a mid-season atmosphere."

At the conclusion of the two games Novak said his team still had some work to do for a chance to match or even improve on last year's 19-9 record. Zephyrhills has a six-year playoff run going and has made it to the postseason in seven of the previous

There's a lot of things we can definitely improve on," the coach said. "We've just got to be strong on the boards, watch the turnovers, run the floor and play good defense. That's what wins basketball games."



Robbins, who threw for 78 yards, split time at quarterback with Kaylan Calvez, who passed for 48 yards with a 14-yard scoring toss to Jabari Smith. He also ran for a 4-yard touchdown. Orlando Jones also got a safety when Zephyrhills punter T.J. Jackson ran out of the end zone and a 17-yard scoring run by Stephen Sparrow.

Zephyrhills reached the red zone just once, winding up with a fourth-down play at the 5-yard line with eight seconds left in the game. On the final play of the game, quarterback Jaxson Rivera, who struggled to complete 11 of 24 passes for 74 yards, was intercepted for the second time on a pass that was tipped three times before Mekhi Hamilton came down with it in the end zone.

With the passing game struggling, Zephyrhills also was held in check by the Jones defense, which keyed on running back Zyre Roundtree, who gained just 44 yards on 14 carries. Just two weeks ago Roundtree gained 136 yards in the Weeki Wachee game. In the game against Anclote, Rivera passed for 99 yards and four touchdowns. On the other end of those scoring receptions were Tre Gallimore, Clayton Carnelius, Mike Barber and Jackson. Backup quarterback Raleigh Allen also had a touchdown pass.

Two seniors who played for four years at Zephyrhills were offensive lineman Jarrin Galyan and Roundtree.

"I've got peace with what I've done in high school football," Galyan said. "I'm sad that it ended. I wanted more.'

Added Roundtree, "I'm somewhat satisfied with making it to the third round, but I ain't happy tonight."

HOLLYWOOD -- Movie distributors are more than ready to put films into theaters again, but moviegoers aren't ready to take a chance yet. Ryan Reynolds' "Free Guy" was to open July 3, 2020, then Dec. 11, but in November it was pulled. "Death on the Nile," with Kenneth Branagh (as Hercule Poirot), Gal Gadot and Armie Hammer, was due Dec. 18, but was pulled as well. "A Quiet Place: Part 2," starring Emily Blunt, was set to open March 8, 2020, with billboards up and TV ads running, but was sidelined by the coronavirus and rescheduled for April 23, 2021. Undaunted, plans are set for a threequel to open in 2022.

Sophia Loren, one of the last four stars of The Golden Age of Hollywood, scored excellent reviews for her Netflix remake of "Madame Rosa," called "The Life Ahead," which began streaming Nov. 13. The Washington Post said, "Madame Rosa is a prostitute who becomes a caregiver and mother figure for children of her colleagues in the sex-work industry. Sophia Loren inhabits the role with vulnerability and majesty. As one of the four final links to cinema's Golden Age, she is simply magnificent. She's still got it, and as this performance reminds us, she always did!"

In 1956, Sophia was signed to a five-picture deal by Paramount Pictures. Her first American movie was "Boy on a Dolphin," filmed in the Saronic Islands off Greece in 1957, with Alan Ladd and Clifton Webb, followed by "The Pride and the Passion," shot in Spain and starring Cary Grant and Frank Sinatra. Since she didn't speak any English, she learned her role and all her lines phonetically. During filming, Cary Grant fell in love with her, and in 1958 he replaced his then-wife, Betsy Drake (who actually wrote the script), in "Houseboat," with Sophia. Drake divorced Grant, but in the end Sophia jilted him and returned to her real love, producer Carlo Ponti, in 2007. They were married until his death.

Her role in "The Life Ahead" is akin to "Two Women," for which she won a best actress Oscar in 1962. She skipped the Academy Awards that night because of extreme stage fright. Later, she mustn't have realized how big "Dynasty" would become, because in 1981 she turned down playing Alexis Carrington Colby, which went to Joan Collins and made her a major international television star.

Zac Efron, who recently lent his voice to "Scoob!" (as in Scooby-Doo), with Mark Wahlberg, Will Forte, Tracy Morgan, Ken Jeong, Amanda Seyfried and Gina Rodriguez, has found his next project, the survival thriller "Gold," with Anthony Hayes. They play two strangers traveling through a desert who stumble upon and have to protect the biggest gold nugget ever found. Hope it's a bigger gem than his last film, "Extremely Wicked, Shockingly Evil and Vile"!

After draining some free throws, JV call-up Timneta Clemmons banged one in from the low post to take the first lead of the game for the Bulldogs at 28-27. The Seahawks would have the stronger finish to the half with Paige Atwater draining a three in the final seconds to take a
