Bulldogs' unbeaten streak ends

Zephyrhills loses in Nature Coast Classic final to an Ohio team, thus halting a season-opening nine-game winning streak

Sooner or later the season-opening unbeaten streak for the Zephyrhills boys basketball team was bound to come to an end. That impressive run concluded with a disheartening 73-49 to Brecksville-Broadview Heights of Ohio in the championship game of the Nature

Zephyrhills (9-1 overall, 3-0 in Class 5A, District 6) began this season with nine consecutive victories. That included 87-41 and 61-43 tournament wins over Tampa Jefferson and the host team from Brooksville, respectively, to set up the final matchup with the team from

"They're a quality team and it just exposed the things we need to work on and get better at," Zephyrhills coach Mike Novak said of the game against the Ohio team. "It's just being consistent. To be good you've got to prove

The Bulldogs, who traditionally compete in the Nature Coast tourney during the win-ter break, skipped last year's series due to the coronavirus pandemic.

'It's a real well-run tournament and it's close by," Novak said. "You get to play some teams you never see."

In 2019, Zephyrhills defeated Alonso in the title game with Kevin Pagan being named the most valuable player. Pagan is now a senior forward for the Bulldogs. Pagan, who led Zephyrhills with 18 points in the final game, made the all-tournament team.

So did senior guard Jimmy Mcauley, who scored 14. The Bulldogs just missed having three players in double figures as Preston Linville, a sophomore shooting guard and the team's leading 3-point shooter, finished with

Żephyrhills has made the playoffs in seven of the past nine seasons, but missed out last year with a district semifinal loss. To make a deep postseason run this year, Novak repeated that the team must focus on becoming more consistent on the court and playing hard at all

As for last year's disappointing district

That changed this year.





"I think it went very well," he continued. "Both are awesome employees. The common theme was that they're both willing to jump into any situation and do what it takes to get the job

Aside from recognition at the city's Christmas party, Carter and Farr received plaques paying tribute to them, a paid day off and a free parking spot with their name on a sign for one year.

Finance director Ted Beason lauded Carter, as much for her job performance as her personality and optimistic outlook.

"Her attitude is superlative," he said. "I count myself fortunate every day that she's working for us."

Water superintendent C.J. Funnell had just as much praise for Farr, saying, "He's kind of a go-to guy. Everyone kind of looks up to him. He's got one of those personalities where he jokes around with the guys and keeps them going."

John Bostic, the utilities director, noted Farr's versatility. Although he is in the water department Farr has the qualifications

to work on sewer lines as well. "He's a hard-nosed guy who gets the work done," Bostic said of Farr, who works on water leaks and breaks while monitoring the lines as well. "We are working on a plan to get everybody cross-trained. It makes it a lot easier when somebody knows both sides.'

Farr found out a week ahead of time, saying, "I knew they were all voting and (co-workers) said we're putting you in. You're an old-timer. It's great. I can park in front, but I don't

Farr actually gets a ride to work on weekdays from his son Jeremy, who also works in the water department. Farr, who has worked for the city for nearly 18 years, has been married to his wife Marie for 41 years. In his spare time he plays in men's soft-

Carter came on board in 2016 as an assistant city clerk and in May of 2020 took on her current role. She graduated from the University of Phoenix in 2014 and has enjoyed working on such city projects as phase 1 of the Sarah Vande Berg Center, intersection realignment at U.S. 301 and Pretty Pond Road and on the Hercules Park project that will alter the old site that once was

home to the city's swimming pool. 'You feel like you're doing something bigger than yourself,"

she said, adding that she enjoys working on capital projects that are part of the city's fiscal 2022 budget of \$75 million.

Carter is married to Michael Carter. Their son Michael Jr. plays baseball at Zephyrhills High while their 8-year-old daughter Hailey is in the Zephyrhills Little League.

A great time of fellowship was enjoyed by all at the clubhouse for hot chocolate and delicious homemade cookies.







HOLLYWOOD -- Knopf Publishing has announced an upcoming memoir by Paul Newman that will cover his thoughts on acting, directing, family, fame, Hollywood, Broadway, love, his marriages, drinking, politics and racing. Newman, who died in 2008, began secretly writing his memoir in the '80s, and it recently was found in his Connecticut home, where his widow, Joanne Woodward, 91, still lives, suffering from Alzheimer's.

More than a matinee idol, Newman became a great philanthropist. Today, many people know him more from his picture on "Newman's Own" bottles of salad dressing, pasta sauce, wine, etc., than from his films. Created in 1982, Newman's Own has donated \$600 million to charities. He was Oscar-nominated 10 times and finally won a best actor Oscar for "The Color of Monev" (1987).

But there was another side to Newman. At 18, I was shooting photos for movie magazines. Paul and Joanne were on Broadway in "Baby Want a Kiss" at a theater next to Sardi's Restaurant. I haunted their stage door for photos, but he always said "No." On their last day, as they went into Sardi's for dinner, I handed him an envelope and watched him read it to Joanne. My poem read:

Dear Mr. Newman, You've rarely been one of those who'd stand still for a picture and pose.

"Take it on the run," is what you always say ... so I do, and a blur is what I throw away.

Mrs. Newman's often difficult too. "Posing," she says, "I never do!"

"I'm a wife and a mother," she always replies, and that always draws a couple of sighs.

As a wife and a mother, she should get off the stage, why can't she be nice, like Geraldine Page?

She's a wife and a mother, just like her, at least she stands still so I don't get a blur.

I followed you to your garage last week and heard you speak ... "Did it ever occur to you it might embarrass me?"

But it's part of fame, Mr. Newman, don't you see. In all the time you take saying what you won't do, I could have taken 10 snaps of you. Why can't you have that old

fashioned vice, instead of being disagreeable, try being nice.

That night I ran after his car, and after saying, "Great poem, you're a great poet," he finally posed, and that photo accompanies this story.

The next week, I encountered Joanne Woodward at Oscar rehearsals. "Don't I know you from New York?" she asked.

"Yes, I gave you the poem at Sardi's.'

"We loved it," she said, "hung it in our basement and show it to all our friends!" Wonder if my poem will be in the book?

appearance, Novak noted that is not something the players on this year's team even think about.

"That's really funny about kids," he said. "They don't seem to remember at all. Every year is different."

Another local team competed in the Nature Coast tourney. Wiregrass Ranch, which lost twice in a series at Lemon Bay, went 2-1 at Nature Coast. That included a 58-53 win over Bloomingdale.

"They bounced back," Wiregrass Ranch coach Jeremy Calzone said. "This team is so good at that."

The Bulls displayed a balanced offense against Bloomingdale with four players scoring in double figures. Wyatt Stoneroad had a gamehigh 19 points, Deshawn Mann added 15 with Josh Martin and King Gonzalez Jr. contributing 10 apiece.

Wiregrass Ranch (9-5) followed the Bloomingdale game with a 104-95 victory

against Sebring before a 79-70 loss to Tampa Sickles.


Wiregrass Ranch returned to the Nature Coast Classic for the first time since 2017. For the past three seasons they played elsewhere in winter tourneys, in part, because Calzone felt that the series repeatedly brought in some of the same teams.

"I want to make sure we see different teams," he said, adding that the winter tourneys are beneficial for his players. "It's just exposure. We tell the parents we don't want to ruin your Christmas, but it gets them exposure"

While the Bulls are off to a solid start, Calzone expects them to get even better down the stretch. Max Bent, a 6-foot-6 senior power forward who injured his right knee playing for his travel basketball team this fall, should return to the lineup soon.

"Of course, he's got to get in shape, but he'll help us a lot; especially defensively," Calzone said.
