Betmar remains in hunt with defeat of Ralph's Park

Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League reaches midpoint of the 2019 season

Betmar Acres defeated Ralph's Park 26-11 as the Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League reached the midpoint of the 2019 season. That allowed host Betmar to remain in a close race for first place.

Betmar, which finished third overall last season, is in a two-way tie with Morningside Estates, last year's league runner-up who last week beat Spanish Main 26-6. Betmar and Morningside are locked in second with eight points apiece. Front-running Hunters Run, the defending league cham-

pion, is atop the current standings with 10 points.

"It always is this way," Morningside's Tom
Reynolds said. "We're in pretty good shape."

While Morningside and Betmar each have eight team points in what should be a close race to the finish, Morningside has a slight edge due to winning 109 games compared to Betmar's 87. Both teams trail Hunters Run's total of 129 victories.

"Morningside is a little better than we are, but

we haven't played them yet," said Bert Packs, the league president and captain of Betmar.

Betmar and Morningside square off on Feb.

27 at Morningside with the winner having a legitimate shot at upending Hunters Run, which has captured five of the past six titles.

"It could determine the title," Packs said of that upcoming matchup.

As for last week's home win over Ralph's Park, Betmar got a nice contribution from newcomer Deb Thyng. She played years ago up in Maine with her husband Jim, but just came out last

"I love horseshoes and I'm retired," she said. Apparently, Thyng made quite an impression on the opposition by contributing to the scoring in her Betmar debut.

'You'll definitely be a force to be reckoned with once you get your sea legs," Jannis Hunt, of Ralph's Park, told Thyng during a halftime break for coffee and donuts.

Enjoying a cup of coffee with his Betmar teammates was Don House, who has played for that team for 18 years but has been sidelined of late. 'I've got back problems, so I'm out today," he

Three local wrestling teams compete in tournaments

Zephyrhills, Pasco and Zephyrhills Christian Academy get ready for the postseason

Wrestling teams from Zephyrhills, Pasco and Zephyrhills Christian Academy had their final tuneups last weekend before the postseason tournaments begin this weekend. First up for the public high schools is the Sunshine Athletic Conference tourney hosted Friday and Saturday by River Ridge in New

Last weekend, Zephyrhills and Pasco competed in dual meets while Zephyrhills Christian went to the prestigious Ippolito Memorial tourney at Brandon, named after the late Tony Ippolito who was Brandon's as well as Hillsborough County's first-ever state champion.

The Warriors, depleted by injuries did not fare well and finished 23rd with host Brandon claiming its 31st title in the 35-year history of the event. Like Brandon, runner-up Fort Lauderdale Cardinal Gibbons and Naples Barron Collier, have won state

"It's just a strong tournament," said Zephyrhills Christian coach Mark DeAugustino, who formerly coached at Pasco and Land O' Lakes.

Robert Keldie, a junior, had the best finish for Zephyrhills Christian in a competition featuring some of the highest-ranked wrestlers in the state. Keldie, who took sixth in the 170-pound category

after being pinned by Manatee's Jackson Beyer, has a 24-10 overall record.

"I'm going to states this year," said Keldie, who came up short of that goal as a freshman and sophomore. "I throw pretty well and I'm working on my

Javan Smith, a senior who went 4-2 at 132, Gage Flanagan, Caleb Gaskin and Elijah Austin also wrestled for Zephyrhills Christian. Noticeably absent was heavyweight Malik Jones, who placed third in last year's state meet but missed the tourney to take college entrance exams; and Jonathan Casarez, who has been out injured but aims to be back for district, regional and state competitions.

DeAugustino, recently elected to the National Wrestling Hall of Fame, expects both back in time for the postseason run; especially Jones who has his sights set on a state championship. As for Cesarez,

adults. Adults between the ages of 26 and 65 are advised to get seven to nine hours of sleep per evening. However, six hours or 10 hours also may be acceptable. People over the age of 65 need roughly seven to eight hours of sleep each night, though between five and six hours also may be fine. Generally speaking, anything under five hours is not recommended based on data reviewed by sleep experts.

Many older adults do not get enough sleep due to insomnia, states Jack Gardner, MD, a neurologist certified in sleep medicine. They're concerned about health issues, may have sleep apnea, can experience pain or frequent urination, or may be taking medication that impedes sleep. Dr. Leila Kheirandish-Gozal, director of clinical sleep research at the University of Chicago, says that, over time, insufficient sleep can impact metabolism, mood, memory, and heart function.

Various strategies can help people get more sleep and enjoy better sleep quality. • Create a luxury bed environment.

Splurge on the largest mattress you can afford

and one that is comfortable for both parties (if married/coupled). A roomy bed routinely invites sleep. If you have a restless partner, try

two separate beds pushed against each other. Consider white noise. The sounds of the house or outdoors may be keeping you up. Many people find that the gentle hum of a fan or a white-noise machine with a calming sound effect makes it easier for them to dose off than complete quiet. It can also block out extraneous



DeAugustino said, "I might sit him out next week too. He really just needs to get ready for districts."

Zephyrhills, which has struggled to get enough wrestlers to even field a team in recent years, had the best overall performance among the three teams mentioned.

The Bulldogs were runners-up in the Hudson Duals, coming in behind champion East Lake with a 4-1 team record. Along the way Zephyrhills defeated Fivay, Anclote, the host Cobras and Brooksville Central.

"We've come a long way," said Russ Schenk, a former champion wrestler who has coached a handful of schools in Pasco and Pinellas counties and is in his third season at Zephyrhills. "I think the kids have bought in, but we've got

to get the numbers up."

Before Schenk's arrival, Zephyrhills did not have enough to fill a team during some years. While depth still is a factor in the Bulldogs' tournament results, the coach is encouraged that more wres-

tlers came out this season.

"It's just meeting them all," Schenk said, adding, "It usually takes about three years to get them coming. We're very fortunate that we've still got 17 kids in the ring every day." Zephyrhills, which improved to 21-10 in dual meets this season, still lacks leader-

ship from upperclassmen. The team consists primarily of freshmen and sophomores. Two of those are standouts in freshman Jalon Martinez, who wrestles in the 126-pound weight class, and 220-pounder Brian Ashmore, a sophomore.

Senior Tristan Cowley, at 132, is another top wrestler for the Bulldogs and senior Seth Blata has made strides as a first-year wrestler in the 138 class. Having lost to an East Lake standout by pin earlier this year the rematch came down to a narrow 11-10 loss.

"His improvement is just awesome," Schenk said. "He's really stepped up.'

Pasco spent last weekend in Lakeland competing in the Lake Gibson Duals and placed seventh.

"We did okay," said coach Tim Maples, a former assistant who took over when DeAugustino went to Zephyrhills Christian three years ago.

Pasco's top wrestlers were Travis Knowlton, who took third at 132, and Kevin Johnston, a fourth-place finisher at 152. Tim Johnson, a state qualifier last season at 195, had a disappointing performance and did not get past the preliminaries.

Sampson had a rough night but rallied on several plays to make stops. Eight goals against is never pretty but considering Sampson's 11 saves, there was a measure of redemption.

In the last 10 minutes of the first half, the Longhorns made it 4-0 when Lola Vargas found herself almost on the far post at the end of a long cross. Just minutes after that, Lilly Meyer made it 5-0 with a sizzling shot that she drove into the top 90 from about 12 yards out.

Sampson got aggressive and moved out to make a stop on driving Ashley Olds.

The Longhorns would strike again in the last five minutes of the half. Jordan Fulop blasted a shot from dead-center, from just outside the 18-yard box that went in just under the crossbar. Sampson would made another great save as Olds tried a high shot on her.

In the waning moments of the half, Karissa Sapp tried Sampson high again. Sampson got her hands on it but the shot was too strong and

went through into goal.

Schell had already made several substitutions in the first half. In the second half, not a starter was left on the field. Still, it only took a few minutes for Lindsey Maronn to ice the game on an eight-yard shot from dead-center. At 8-0 the game was called due to the mercy

rule.

"A game like this we like to use to work on fundamentals," Schell said. "The score isn't as important as working and improving skills."

With a couple of cancellations, the Longhorns are now just 2-0 on the season with a tilt against Pine View next on the slate. The Bulldogs remain winless so far and travel to Weightman next.





Automobile burglaries continue to be one of the easiest preventable crimes, not only in our county but across the nation. Most auto burglaries involve unlocked doors, with items of value left inside. Crooks know the habits of people, and they look for the path of least resistance that can gain them money or valuables to

While most peo-ple wouldn't consid-er leaving their homes or apartments unlocked, we see that all too often cars are left unlocked with purses, wallets, computers, cellphones, even guns inside, that are easy pickings for

With the advent of home security cameras, we often see videos of groups of individuals who will drive through neighborhoods, get dropped off by a vehicle, and then roam through the neighborhoods, testing the doors of cars and trucks parked in the driveway. These roaming bands of thieves will move from house to house, street to street, grabbing whatever they can from unlocked vehicles. No neighborhood is safe, not even gated communities, as sometimes the thieves know someone who will give them the code to enter.

It is important to realize that becoming the auto burglary may only of your problems. If you did leave credit or debit cards inside the vehicle, thieves will quickly use those to make fraudulent purchases as quickly as possible, before you realize that they are gone and can cancel them with your banking institution. I don't have to inform you what the danger of leaving a gun inside an unlocked vehicle can lead to in the hands

> The Pasco Sheriff's Office continues to urge citizens to change their habits, always locking your vehicle doors no matter where you are. This includes at work, when you are running errands like at the store or gym, at school, and of course, at home.

Do not leave anything of value in plain sight in your vehicle, as even a locked door will not prevent a thief from breaking your window to get inside to steal it. If possible, it is always best to park your vehicle inside a locked garage.

If that isn't possible, a lighted driveway may deter some thieves. A security camera system may also help, but it is no guarantee, as we have seen many examples of thieves stealing from cars and trucks on security video.

We started a social media campaign a few years ago where we remind people every night to remember to lock their doors. Called the "9 PM Routine," if you follow us on Twitter or Facebook, you will receive that reminder as well. The campaign has been so successful, it has been copied by law enforcement agencies across the country and Canada.

I urge all Pasco citizens to try and change habit of leaving their vehicle with valuable items in plain sight. I shouldn't have to remind you not to leave the keys in the vehicle as well, but unfortunately, many citizens still do, and are surprised when their cars are stolen.

If you work consciously enough to change a habit, it can eventually be-

come a subconscious one, hopefully like that when you get into a vehicle you automatically buckle up for safety. If you start to work on forming a habit of when you get out of a vehicle, you take your keys and make sure all the doors are locked, it too can become a subconscious routine as well.
