Stewart Bulldogs beat heat at the Pasco County Special Olympics

On an unseasonably-hot Friday afternoon, the Stewart Bulldogs Special Olympic team had a string showing and took home some top awards

The first ever Special Olympics Games were held at Soldier Field in Chicago in 1968. The event was the vision of Eunice Kennedy Shriver, who worked to create a panel called the Joseph P. Kennedy Jr. Foundation under the John F. Kennedy Administration. Shriver wanted the families and neighbors of people with intellectual disabilities to see what the individuals could accomplish.

Special Olympics Florida was founded in 1972. Today, Special Olympics is a worldwide movement with over 103,500 competitions around the world.

Special Olympics Florida breaks down into 66 smaller counties. On Friday afternoon, at Wesley Chapel High School, the Special Olympics Pasco County Middle School Division took to the football

stadium and athletic fields. The special Olympians are currently in the Athletics or Track and Field part of the season. The Athletics events feature different types of throws, sprints and bicycle rides. The students have been training for a month and a half and the Stewart Bulldogs, who brought 10 athletes to the competition, performed admirably, even in the face of record heat.

"We had to rotate some of our coaches in and out of the shade canopy," Stewart Special Olympics coach Lorraine Concilio said. "We had some good runners today, some kids even ran two events."

Stewart Track and Special Olympic coach Norman Scheuerman helped train some of the athletes during their time with him in P.E. class. Scheuerman, Concilio, supportive teacher Gayle Lovelace as well as Amanda Williams and Susan Phillibant shared duties overseeing the Stewart Olympians in their exploits.

"Amanda and Susan would bring the kids in and based on the events they did, we would put them through different workouts," Scheuerman said. "We would train three or four days per week. Half the class we'd train and half we'd do something fun that they enjoy."

Kicking off the ceremonies was Jacob, 13, who

Zephyrhills eliminated once again in region quarterfinals

District runner-up Bulldogs come up short in first-round playoff loss to Crystal River

The fact that Zephyrhills made the playoffs for a fifth straight season and sixth time in seven years is a testament to the once downtrodden program that was rejuvenated by former coach Alan Reed — the home court was named in his honor this season — and maintained by current coach Mike Novak.

Being eliminated in the first round of the post-season for the third year in a row, however, indicates that the recent teams are not quite up to par with the 2015-16 squad that won 27 games en route to district and regional titles, as well as the state semifinals. Zephyrhills, led by former standout Jeremy Oppenheimer, lost to Kissimmee Poinciana, coming within one game of playing for a state championship that season.

"Ups and downs," is how third-year coach Novak described this season following last Thursday's 56-44 loss at Crystal River in a Class 6A region quarterfinal. "We had a lot of highs and lows."

The final game, which followed two out of three wins in the Class 6A, District 8 tournament at

Betmar tops rival Morningside 20-12 in horseshoe rivalry

Longtime rivals always seem to battle for the spot behind perennial champion Hunters Run

Take nothing away from the longtime rivalry between Betmar Acres and Morningside Estates, even if those teams have to settle for runner-up status behind perennial champion Hunters Run in the Zephyrhills Winter Horseshoe League.

Host Betmar defeated Morningside 20-12 last Wednesday to take over second place in the league standings, knocking Morningside to third and trailing only front-running Hunters Run. Last season, Betmar finished third behind runner-up Morningside and defending league champion Hunters Run, which has claimed five of the past six titles.

"It's going to be tough," Betmar's Sonny Allen, who teamed with Lee Hutchins in a win last week, said of catching Hunters Run. "We won (against Morningside), so you never know."

The win against Morningside, which also lost the season opener to Hunters Run, was very rewarding for Hutchins, especially with the way things turned out last season.

"Last year (Morningside) beat us because we had to play the No. 1 team twice and they didn't," said Hutchins, whose wife Betty also plays on the Betmar team. "We get pumped up for Hunters Run, but it doesn't do us any good."

Watching Allen and Hutchins team up for a victory last week, Morningside's Tom Reynolds described Allen as "the best player they've got."

Dennis Frey, a Morningside player pointed out

that Betmar is as much a rival for his team as is Hunters Run.

"I wouldn't say it's any more than Hunters Run," he said. "All three of us are going to be in it till the end."

Making sure to not overlook Morningside while his team chases Hunters Run, Betmar's Bert Paul, who also is the league's president, said during last Wednesday's match, "These guys are tough."

Betmar's Greg Paul mentioned differences in

the surfaces, that often lead to each team winning at home. Betmar has dirt in its pits while Morningside uses clay and plays that to its advantage.

"They practice and play with clay, so they have a pretty good advantage over us when we're playing them," Paul noted while leaning on a board at the end of the pit. "They have some pretty good players over there. Of course, it's different over here."

fluid, known as a dialysate, and put in the abdomen through a catheter to absorb waste from blood that passes through vessels in the abdominal cavity. The fluid remains there for several hours before being drained into a bag. This is called an exchange, advises NKF. This type of dialysis is typically done at home.

Dialysis can take up to four hours to complete and may occur two to three times per week. It can help replace some of the function of healthy kidneys but cannot cure kidney disease. When the kidneys fail

The National Kidney Foundation says people with chronic kidney disease, or CKD, that reaches end stage renal disease (kidney failure) require life-preserving treatment. 1. **Hemodialysis:** This is a system by which the blood is put through an external filter, cleaned and then returned to the body. It can occur at a dialysis facility or at home. A doctor has to access blood vessels with a fistula or graft to enable this artificial kidney, hemodialyzer, to work.

2. **Peritoneal dialysis:** According to WebMD, during this process, the blood is cleaned inside of the body by way of a special

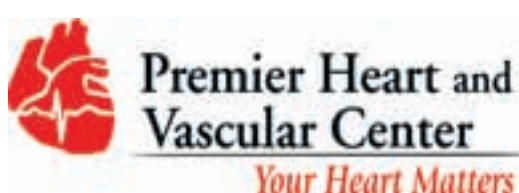

Anclote, resembled the Bulldogs' inconsistent season. They finished as district runners-up with victories over Hudson and Wesley Chapel before a 65-53 loss to Anclote in the 6A-8 final.

Part of the inconsistent season came during two regular-season losses to Wesley Chapel. Zephyrhills avenged those games with a 55-41 victory over the rival Wildcats, who at No. 2 were seeded one spot higher than the Bulldogs in the district semifinals.

In the Bulldogs' final game, the inconsistencies were telling. Zephyrhills took a 19-8 lead in the first quarter by outscoring Crystal River 19-5 following a dunk by the home team's Cayden Gunter, who finished with a game-high 22 points.

That lead increased to 23-13 when Dontae Marchman made his second steal and subsequent layup. His cuts and swerves to the basket prevented problems for the Pirates' defense throughout the game and Marchman finished with a team-leading 14 points.

Aware that Crystal River knocked off Nature Coast in the 6A-7 final by taking an early lead then slowing it down with a stall offense that forced the opposition to take chances and make mistakes, Novak implored his team to keep the pressure on.

That advice, however, was apparently not taken to heart as Crystal River roared back after the break. Zephyrhills, which led 29-21 at half-time, was outscored 35-15 in the second half, including a 17-8 deficit in the third quarter that allowed the Pirates to take a 38-37 lead heading into the final quarter.

"I think they were ready to play," Novak said of his team's fast start in which the Bulldogs made aggressive runs to the basket. "But they got suckered into (Crystal River's) slow-down game. We didn't want to let them get up

on us and then they hold the ball."

That is exactly what happened in the final frame with Crystal River players passing the ball around the perimeter and holding it until Zephyrhills defenders had to take chances and forcing fouls. The Pirates converted 8-of-10 free throws down the stretch to keep the Bulldogs at bay.

"We had a good season, we just couldn't put it all together," said Marchman, a sophomore point guard who will be among the key returners on next year's team. "In the second half we got lazy."

Added Cartell Strong, one of two seniors on the team who missed most of the season with a leg injury, "They just slowed the ball down and played a great game."

With Strong and Tyreese Wigfall, a solid contributor off the bench, being the only seniors on the team Zephyrhills is poised to make another playoff run next year. Novak pointed out that plenty of underclassmen got experience this season and that six players who are juniors will return.

"There's a lot of young players," the coach said. "A lot of kids got varsity experience in big games."

Admittedly, the Bulldogs had a tough time against taller players. Anclote rallied for a comeback win over Zephyrhills in the district final on the strength of two 6-foot-7 forwards and Crystal River had a pair of tall forwards as well.

"We don't match up with some teams that have good, big players," Novak said.

Nonetheless, the coach is encouraged about the prospects for next year's team.

"If they're willing to work hard in the off-season we could be a competitive basketball team next season," Novak said.

got to run a leg around the track while carrying the Special Olympic torch. Jacob would go on to take first place in the 100-meter run and the tennis throw. Christian, 14, won the tennis throw for his group and took second in the 50-meter run. Emma, 13, got second in the tennis ball throw and won her 50-meter race. Cambren, 13, won his longer, 200-meter race and got second in his 100-meter race.

"I was suprised with both Jacob and Cambren," Scheuerman said. "Cambren ran in Jacob's heat in the 100-meter and then 20 minutes later, turned around and ran the 200-meter."

Natalie, 14, was fourth in her 100-meter race and second in her

tennis throw. Haylie, 13, won her tennis throw and took first in her 100-meter race. Patrick, 12, won both his tennis throw and 50-meter run. Destiny, 13, was third in her 100-meter race and second in the tennis throw. Elinet, 13, took fourth in the tennis throw and also ran the 25-meter race. Ayden, 13, competed in both the tennis throw and 25-meter run but had to leave early due to the heat.

"These types of events show the kids what special needs athletes have in common with other athletes," Scheuerman said. "Not everyone can play an instrument or raise a calf but what the 100-meter Special Olympian does is not very different than what any track athlete does in the 100-meter."

From here, athletes will train up for the area competition on March 30 at Lakewood High School in Saint Petersburg, looking ahead to the state games in May at Disney Wide World of Sports.
