Zephyrhills rewards outgoing basketball players with record-setting 107-2 win over visiting Brooksville Central

Not that any game is a given, but what better way to ensure a victory for a team's outgoing seniors than to schedule an easy opponent. On Senior Night, the host Bulldogs clobbered Brooksville Central 107-2, setting a record for the most points ever scored by a Zephyrhills basketball team.

Honored by that milestone victory for Zephyrhills, which won the 10th of its past 12 games and improved to 17-7, were seniors Taija McCullough, a shooting guard, and small forward Ashauna

"They'll be a significant loss," said coach Chris Smith, before congratulating that pair during a pregame ceremony in which they were honored with balloons and were introduced with family

While McCullough has been a top scorer for the Bulldogs for the past three seasons and is a four-year varsity player, Jones, who played three seasons at Zephyrhills Christian Academy before transferring this season, has come on of late in that depart "She's turning it on at the right time," Smith said."

McCullough scored 21 and Jones 7 against the Bears. "The thing I'm going to miss the most is time spent with my

teammates," McCullough said. Jones said she transferred, because "I just wanted to play with

my friends here." In the most dominant gave ever for the Bulldogs, Maya Llanes led the team with 23 points, Timneta Clemons added 20 and Madison Driggers had 16. Alexis Martin led the players coming off the

"I think we're peaking right now," said Smith, whose said his players told him at halftime that they "want to score 100."

The outcome was hardly in question from the outset. Smith noted that the struggling Bears had four coaches this season with a bit of roster turnover. The Bulldogs led 39-0 in the first quarter and 71-0 at halftime. The lone basket for Central came at the 1:06 mark of the third quarter when Madison McVey, a junior guard, hit a baseline jump shot from the right side.

As the game progressed, Smith emptied his bench to make sure

### Cowart, Spoon, Vo win state bids

The 2020-21 Bulldogs headed to River Ridge for a regional showdown with perennial powerhouses

The gym at River Ridge High School in New Port Richey is an intimidating place to compete. The Royal Knights are perennial powerhouses. Defending state champion Sunlake is also in Class 2A, Region 3; so are Lake Wales and Winter Springs. There are no free passes to states and even the most elite lifters needed to hit their marks just to qualify.

The biggest showdown was in the unlimited weight class as senior Diamond Cowart battled for the top spot against Sunlake's Juliana Garcia. Cowart has had her sights set on matching Garcia all season. Last Thursday was the head-to-head showdown. Cowart came in on bench press five pounds heavier and both lifters hit their initial marks. Cowart went for 185 and Garcia 180 for the second attempts and again, both lifters hit their marks. On the third try, both lifters called for 190 pounds. Garcia hit hers and it was left to Cowart to press the weight that had defied her at districts. Cowart pressed 190, set a new personal record and tied Garcia heading into the clean-and-jerk.

"I felt better, more confident this time," Cowart said.

In clean-and-jerk, Cowart again started five pounds heavier than Garcia. Cowart hit her first attempt at 175 and Garcia hit hers at 170. Cowart went for 185 on her second attempt, got it up onto her chest but could not quite get the full extension to complete the lift. Meanwhile, Garcia hit her lift at 180 and it was all she would need for a five-point margin and regional title. Cowart, who tallied a 365 composite score, will head back to states this weekend with a chance to place and possibly get past Garcia.

The next big showdown was at 183 pounds where sophomore Autumn Spoon was in a battle for

# Stewart sweeps host Pasco in boys basketball

Dominating wins at the junior varsity and varsity levels give the Bulldogs bragging rights over the arch-rival Pirates

Season openers in middle school boys basketball often are filled with inconsistent play marking the performances of both teams. Typically, there are standout plays made by the top

players, which sometimes can be offset by fundamental mistakes that are usually corrected later in the year.

That was not the case, at least for Stewart, which last week swept the season-opening games at arch-rival Pasco in Dade City. A 39-19 junior varsity win preceded the varsity team's 39-21 victory for a sweep by the Bulldogs. Stewart's offensive units gave steady performances in both games while Pasco's squads struggled with inconsistency.

"It's still a rival game and it's just to see where you're at," Stewart varsity coach Marcus Mckinley said afterward.

The varsity game was close early on before Stewart broke off a 9-0 run to take a com-

# Recognize signs of heart attack in women

Many people are familiar with the image of a heart attack sufferer clutching his or her chest or feeling surprising, tingling sensations in his or her left arm. While those symptoms are common, heart attacks can produce a wide array of symptoms, and some of them may actually be much less apparent than chest pain or tingling in the left arm. The organization Go Red for Women, which highlights women's heart health during the month of February, advises that many symptoms women can experience when suffering from heart disease may be overlooked or misunderstood as signs of less threatening conditions. However, jaw pain, nausea, pressure, and sweating all may be indicative of a heart attack. A failure to recognize that and act quickly could prove fatal.

The American Heart Association says that heart disease is the foremost killer of women in the United States. The Heart and Stroke Foundation says heart disease and stroke kill 31,000 women in Canada annually. Despite those figures, many women are unaware of the threat of heart disease and its symptoms.

Heart attack occurs when blood flow to the heart is blocked by a buildup of a substance called plague in the coronary arteries. Heart attack can strike any woman, though women who deal with high stress, are overweight or are heavy smokers are at the greatest risk.

#### Symptoms of heart attack

Symptoms of heart attack in women generally are more subtle than in men. These can include but are not limited to:

- shortness of breath as though you just ran a marathon
- a feeling of a squeezing rope tied around the upper back
- dizziness
- lightheadedness or actual fainting
- unusual fatigue
- neck, jaw, shoulder, upper back, or abdominal discomfort
- indigestion
- perspiration



#### How heart attacks are different for women

Women tend to have blockages not only in their main arteries, but in the smaller ones that supply blood to the heart,. This is a condition called coronary microvascular disease, says the Mayo Clinic, and it may be why symptoms are more vague and not as apparent in women as they are in men.

Women also can have symptoms while resting or even when asleep, and emotional stress can trigger heart attack symptoms in women.

A woman's risk for heart disease increases if she has diabetes, has experienced mental stress or depression, smokes, has gone through

menopause, has had complications during a pregnancy, has an inflammatory disease, and/ or is physically inactive.

Women of all ages should take heart disease seriously and schedule a check-up with a doctor to discuss risk and heart health. Women who suspect or notice any symptoms of heart attack should not hesitate to call for help. If you suspect you are having a heart attack, call 9-1-1 immediately; do not drive yourself.

every single player on the Zephyrhills roster got into the game. As the team approached the 100-point mark, it was not quite clear who would get that milestone basket as Smith was interchanging his starters and backup players throughout the second

That question was answered when Kylie Walton, a freshman forward, took an inbounds pass under the basket from freshman teammate Jessica Morgan and banked the ball off the glass. That historical basket came with 3:24 left in the game.

"It's a big deal for them, because they put in the work all week long at practice," Smith said. "It makes them feel like they're more a part of the team."

With Zephyrhills taking such a commanding halftime lead, a running clock was implemented for the entire second half. In basketball, once a team is ahead by 35 points, the Florida High School Athletic Association mandates that the clock does not stop after that. An exception is an injury timeout

For his part, Smith was torn about building the lead. He did note, however, that he played the backups a lot after the break and encouraged long-rang shots rather than driving into the lane. That strategy had come rather easily by the starters in the

"I can't be happier for the girls," the coach said of his players surpassing the 100-point mark. "That's what they wanted to do. It means a lot to them. It's big. It's all about them having positive experiences."

### **Jason Statham**

HOLLYWOOD -- Actionstar Jason Statham was discovered by film director/ screenwriter Guy Ritchie (once married to Madonna). Ritchie cast Statham, age 31, in the hit "Lock, Stock and Two Smoking Barrels" (1998). Ritchie next cast Statham in "Snatch" (2000), with Brad Pitt and Benicio Del Toro, another hit. However, their third film together, "Revolver" (2005), with Ray Liotta, flopped. Ritchie's most recent release was "The Gentlemen" (2019), with Matthew McConaughey, Charlie Hunnam, Henry Golding, Hugh Grant and "Downton Abbey's" Michele Dockery, which scored big.

As Statham awaits the release of "Wrath of Man," with Scott Eastwood, Josh Hartnett and "Burn Notice" star Jeffrey Donovan, he's shooting his fourth Guy Ritchie written and directed film, "Five Eyes." Statham (now 53) will play an MI-6 agent who tries to stop the sale of a deadly new weapons technology that could disrupt the world order. His co-star is 58-year-old Cary Elwes, who made his mark as Westly in "The Princess Bride" (1987) at age 25. Elwes has had a busy year, starting with the Netflix film "A Castle for Christmas," with Brooke Shields: the comedy "Best Sellers," with Michael Caine, Aubrey Plaza and Scott Speedman; and the upcoming horror film "Shrine, with Jeffrey Dean Morgan.

Veronica Cartwright, star of more than 35 major films, including "The Birds" (1963), "Spencer's Mountain" (1963), "The Invasion of the Body Snatchers" (1978), with Leonard Nimoy, "Alien" (1979) and "The Right Stuff" (1983), is now 71 and showing no signs of slowing down. She's preparing to play real-life psychic June Ahern "In How to Talk with Spirits," based on Ahern's book and psychic work with law enforcement finding missing people in the San Francisco Bay area. the top spot. Spoon had to contend with a senior and junior in Jenna Babinski of River Ridge and Lexi Thomas of Lake Wales. Spoon came in higher on bench press (170 pounds) than both and hit her first lift. Then she ran into some difficulty, executing the next two lifts but her composite score of 300 was good enough to qualify for states.
"I had to hold the bar on my chest, for the second, lift for

way too long," Spoon said.

When a lifter takes the bar off the rack, they must hold it at

their chest until an official gives the command to, "press." Spoon felt as though she was asked to hold in that position for far too long. She said it affected her second lift and caused her to scratch her third lift in order not to burn out for clean-and-jerk. Bench is Spoon's better lift and she played it conservative with clean-andjerk on Thursday, hoping to just get all three lifts in. She managed to do so, hitting 115, 125 and then 130 but it was not enough to catch Babinski and Thomas, so Spoon settled into third but still managed to attain a state qualifying spot.

"That lift (130 clean-and-jerk) probably felt the best of all," Spoon said. "I was so worried with everything going on with the team. I just had to push those thoughts aside.

Only the regional champions are automatic bids to states. The other lifters in each weight class, across the three regions, have the results tabulated and bids to state are determined. What Spoon was referring to was the misfortune that haunted many of the other Bulldog lifters. The most tragic was that

of senior Madison Aguilera. Aguilera was the favorite to win the 139-pound weight class. Aguilera got 135 on her second bench press but missed all three of her signature cleanand-jerk lifts. It was a devastating blow after, just last week, Aguilera pushed out another of her four school records in the lift. It was a blow that would have sent an athlete of lesser

character home in a heap of tears and sorrow. Not Aguilera. She had her moment but came back and stood and cheered in support of her team until the very end, showing an extraordinary amount of character and leadership. While she will not be attending the 2021 state tournament, it's time to print the placards for her four school records.

Teammate Aleah Killebrew had a dose of bad luck, falling backward to the ground on her third clean-and-jerk lift. She still managed to score a 255. Teammate Lauren Vo scored a 270 to position herself in fifth place in the 129-pound class. It would be enough for Vo to qualify for the state meet.


"It was an off day for a lot of us," Vo said. "I am so grateful for my teammates and happy I was able to help out."

A fun matchup to watch was the Pasco-Zephyrhills freshman face off between Pasco's Samantha Williams and Zephyrhills' Payton Leidy. While not in contention for the top spots in the 101-pound weight class, they battled back-and-forth, eventually tying with a score of 185. The tiebreaker in weightlifting goes to the lighter lifter. Both Williams and Leidy weighed in at 98 pounds and thus they share a tie for seventh place.

Pasco sophomore Avary Davis set a new personal record on bench with a 155 on her third attempt. It hoisted her score to 280 and got her into a tie for sixth place. Pasco sophomore Alyssa Mero scored a 225 that got her fourth place. It was enough to punch her ticket to states.

Team-wise, with the mishaps, the Bulldogs fell further down the team standings than anticipated. They managed to place eighth with 11 points but Cowart, Spoon and Vo head to Suwannee High School with a chance to compete against the state's best lifters.
