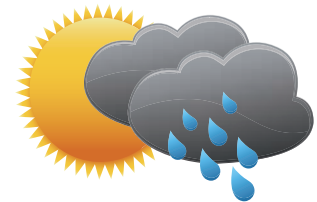

12th Annual Pigz in Z'Hills BBQ & Blues Festival accommodates BBQ competitors by moving to March

The venue adjacent to the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport was the place to be Saturday with barbecue and musical entertainment highlighting the Zephyrhills Chamber of Commerce's largest fundraiser of the year. Proceeds benefit youth and educational programs.

A chamber of commerce day with plenty of sunshine helped lure people from the city, surrounding areas and even out-of-state to the 12th Annual Pigz in Z'hills BBQ & Blues Festival. Activities included a sanctioned state barbecue championship, live entertainment, an automobile show, cornhole tournament, kids fun zone and various vendors.

Due to the coronavirus pandemic, the festival was cancelled last year with only a concert taking place at the community venue adjacent to the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport. Last weekend was the first time the festival took place in March and it will be the last, according to Melonie Monson, the chamber's executive director.

Opening Day for Zephyrhills Little League

Little League veteran Jan Spivey returns to take charge of the local league with a better turnout and more sponsors

A familiar face has returned to the Zephyrhills Little League and it could not have come at a better time. As the league struggled in recent years, partially due to the coronavirus pandemic, participation and sponsorships dwindled.

Jan Spivey, a longtime board member who also has coached, umpired and been the league's president is back in that latter role.

Not coincidentally, the numbers look a little better for the 2022 season. For Opening Day on Saturday at the Sam Pasco Recreation Complex off Chancey Road, the league had about 350 players. That marks a substantial increase from last year's turnout of about 175 boys and girls.

"It's mainly because she's back," said Darryl Oney, a longtime coach and board member. "I love it because she's old-school like me. She likes to do things the right way. Because of her connections in the community, we've been able to double our size and our sponsorships."

Spivey, who has been involved in the league since 1991, had sons Jason, now 46, and Jeff, 40, play there. Now, she has two grandsons — Ryan on a senior baseball team and Jason, who is at the coach-pitch level — in the league.

"They called me out of retirement," Spivey said. "Some of the board members and people from the district called me because it was going down the tubes. I've got 30 years in the league, so I just couldn't let it go. There was a lot of stuff not being done properly. I came back to get them going in the right direction."

Vote-by-mail ballots

Voter turnout posted on website,
sample ballots available

Brian E. Corley, supervisor of elections, announces that vote-by-mail ballots for the April 12 Municipal Elections for the cities of Dade City, New Port Richey, Port Richey, St. Leo and San Antonio will be mailed on March 3 to voters with requests already on file. The deadline to request a vote-by-mail ballot is April 2.

Voted ballots must be returned to the elections' office by 7 p.m. Election Day, April 12. Please allow enough time for first-class delivery by the U.S. Postal Service, or hand deliver ballots to any of the three Supervisor of Elections' Offices in Pasco County. Voted ballots are also accepted at city halls but may not be turned in at the polls on Election Day.

Voters who wish to vote in person before Election Day may vote at Dade City, New Port Richey, Port Richey, St. Leo and San Antonio city halls. Voters are encouraged to ensure their voter registration is up-to-date, and if voting by mail, that a current signature is on file.

To order a vote-by-mail ballot call (800) 851-8754 or use the online request form at PascoVotes.gov. Requests may be submitted in writing to P.O. Box 300, Dade City, Fla. 33526, and must include date of birth, address, last 4 digits of SSN or Florida DL/Florida ID number.

Sample ballots are available online at PascoVotes.gov. Election day voter turnout and election results will be posted online at PascoVotes.gov after the polls close at 7 p.m.

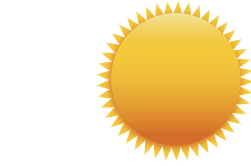

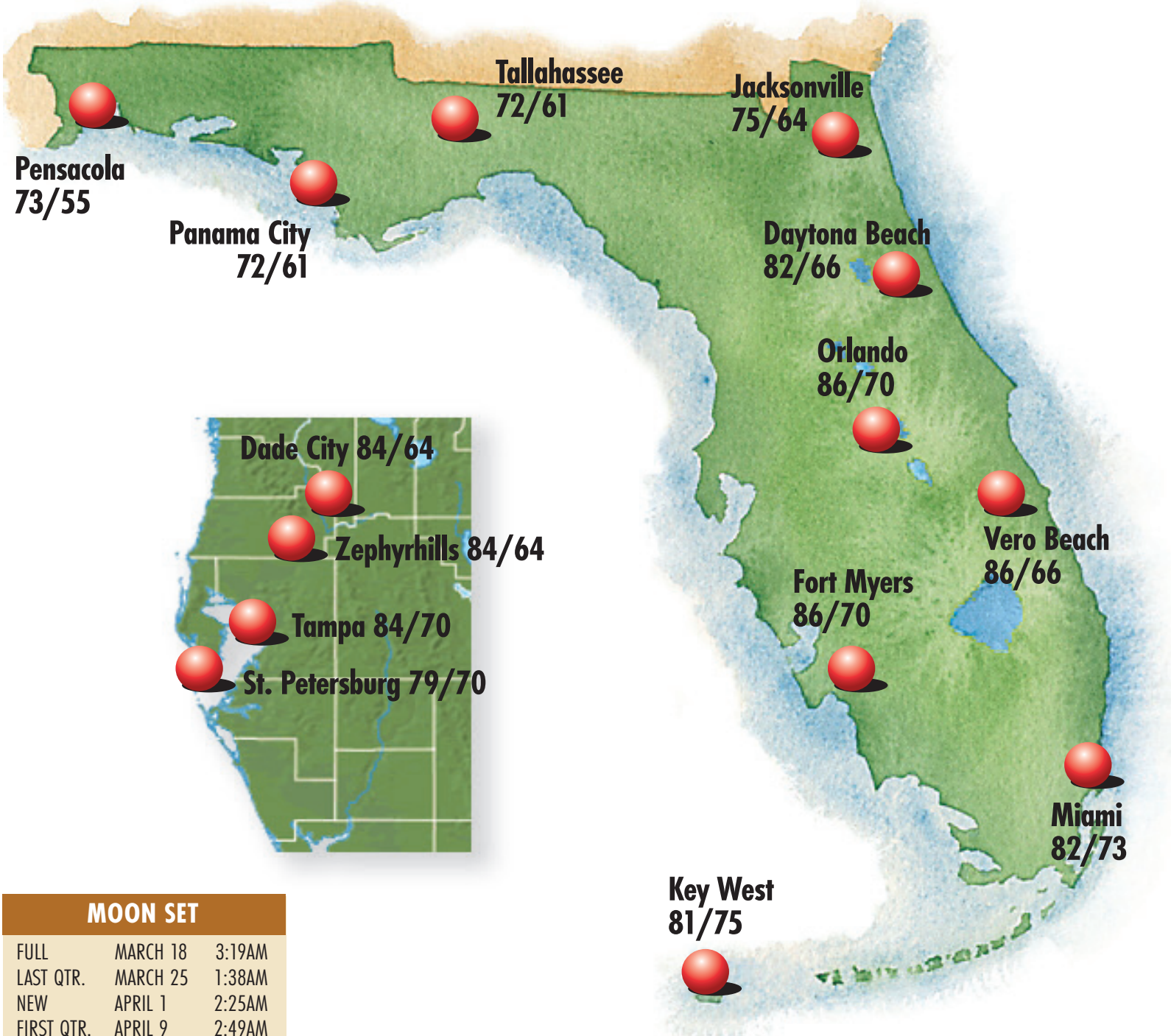

Like many businesses in the community, *The Zephyrhills News* has sponsored Little League teams in the past. The weekly newspaper got back into the game this season by sponsoring a baseball and a softball team.

"I sponsored two teams this season because I wanted to help the children and I know operating expenses have increased," publisher Jan Linville said.

One of the aspects of reviving the league that Spivey is most proud of is participation at the T-ball level. That division includes nine teams, just one shy of the most ever set during the 2014 season.

"It makes my heart skip a beat," she said during team introductions, noting that during that 2014 season the Zephyrhills-based league had more than 500 baseball and softball players.

Spivey noted that while there are junior and senior divisions, players in the 14-17 age range are still needed to round out those rosters.

"We need a few more for our older boys (teams)," she said.

Hunter Bowman is a 14-year-old on the junior baseball team who plays first base and pitches some. He has been on Little League teams in Zephyrhills since he was 4 and continues to play "just to stay in

shape."

Bowman also has played on the offensive and defensive lines for the Stewart Middle football team.

Teams were actually selected in February and practices have been ongoing for the past few weeks. On Saturday, the league got right into game action with teams in several divisions taking the fields for their respective season openers.

During the Opening Day ceremonies, Spivey reminded parents and league supporters that board members, coaches, umpires and concession workers are all volunteers.

"The board of directors has worked very hard to keep this league running," Spivey said. "There's almost a whole new board."

Like many board members, Ashley Stover coaches. She coaches a T-ball team that includes her children Mackenzie and Wyatt with three more in the league. Max and Chase play at the Minor B level while Landon Pressley is on a junior baseball team.

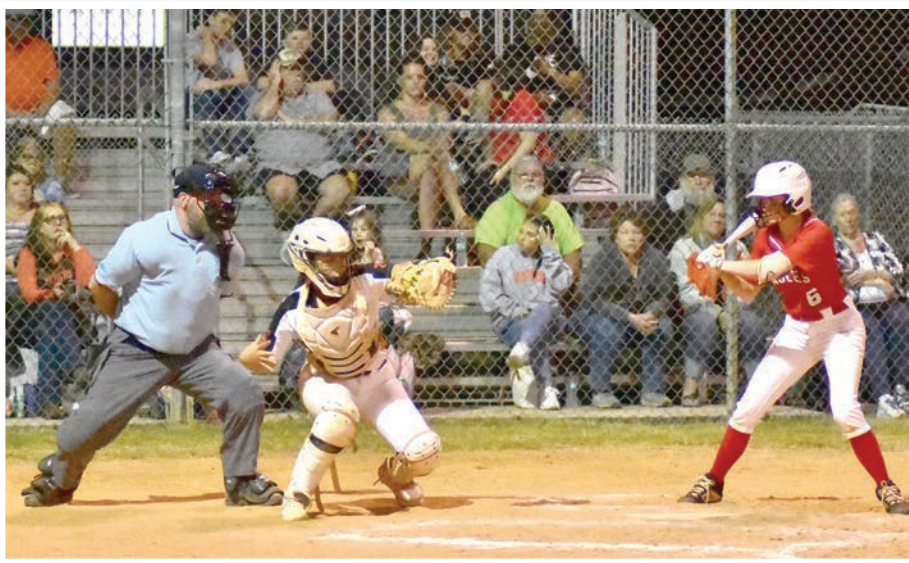

Late rally falls short in 11-4 loss to Springstead for Bulldog softball

The Bulldogs survived a 10-0 onslaught in the first two innings to make a game out of the matchup with visiting Springstead

It was a rough start for the Bulldogs on Friday night. The Springstead Eagles dropped five runs off an error, a two-run single by Kendal Wistling and an RBI single from Reagan Lanning. The second inning saw even more damage done by the Eagles. An RBI single from Leanna Freeman, an RBI double by Wistling and a shot to the center field wall by Ava Miller, overshadowed a terrific cut off throw to home by Zephyrhills second baseman Alex Bowe-Wooten that punched out a Springstead base runner trying for home.

The Bulldogs got one run back in the bottom second after a lead-off double by Izabella Mathis and infield single by Bowe-Wooten but they faced a 10-1 deficit heading into the third inning.

By the third inning, Bulldog reliever Laila Woolfolk had come in and she managed to stabilize the situation. The Bulldogs added a second run in the bottom third off a sacrifice fly from Mathis. It would have been very easy to close up shop at that point but the Bulldogs hung in there.

"The biggest thing was moving our base runners," Bulldog head coach Kristen Dumont said. "We've been inconsistent. Sometimes we

have a fast start and then slow down or we start slow and finish strong. We've got to learn to go seven innings."

This was consistent with the stat sheet as the Bulldogs ultimately tallied 11 hits to Springstead's 10 but stranded most of their base runners. Springstead would hang one more run on the Bulldogs in the top of the fourth inning off an error but in came reliever Bowe-Wooten and she kept the Eagles scoreless the rest of the way.

The Bulldog bats woke up in the bottom seventh. Shyannah Sutton got on base with a single, only to steal second a couple pitches later. Ariaah Drovandi smacked an RBI double to center to add one run to the total. Isabella Rivera laced another double to center to drive in Drovandi and the Bulldogs tallied two in the inning but that was as close as they would come in the 11-4 loss.

Some stellar defense by catcher Rivera, stopping a number of wild pitches and holding runners where they were, was a big factor in keeping the game from becoming a mercy-ruling.

"She (Rivera) is a freshman and a darn good catcher," Dumont said.

Also otherwise lost in a lopsided loss was a tremendous play by third baseman Maddison Schroeder in the top seventh, snagging a laser of a hit and zipping the ball to first base for the put out.

The Bulldog hitters were hampered by the solid pitching and wicked change up from Springstead starter Miller. Miller would finish with a full seven innings, striking out six and not issuing a single walk. Woolfolk and Bowe-Wooten gave the Bulldogs a chance in relief but the hitters could not stack the necessary runs to close the gap opened up in the first two innings.

"They (Bulldogs) bit on it (change up) too," Dumont said. "She (Miller) was hittable. She wasn't throwing anything fancy."

Still, it was a solid night for Mathis, going 2-for-4 with a double and an RBI. Drovandi went 3-for-4 with a double and an RBI.



Traditionally held in January, the schedule change was made to accommodate those competing in the 2022 Florida State BBQ Championship. That change, however, might have adversely affected attendance, although Monson did not have an official number by Tuesday afternoon.

"We were looking for between 5,000-6,000 people, but it looks like we had about 4,000 or 4,500," Monson said, citing other events last weekend such as a boat show in Tampa and seafood festival in Manatee County. "It just ended up not being a good time for our area. It'll be in January next year."

As for the barbecue competition, which featured 56 entrants competing for \$10,000, the grand champion was Accutech BBQ of Sarasota with Hot Wachulas BBQ of Bartow as the reserve champion.

"On that side of it we were thrilled," Monson said. "Everybody wanted to be part of a state championship."

Among the local entrants competing in the backyard division, Bahr's BBQ was fourth and Coleman's BBQ fifth. Both are from Zephyrhills.

For a second straight year the festival included a Kidz Grillin' competition. Devin Brown won, Aryan Coleman was the runner-up and Daniella Gutierrez placed third.

"It was just so much fun," Monson said, adding that "the mentors (five pitmasters) had a blast."

Safety always is a concern around large gatherings and law enforcement was out there with members of the Zephyrhills and Dade City police departments as well as the Pasco Sheriff's Office watching over the grounds.

Pasco County Fire Rescue also was on hand as was the Zephyrhills Volunteer Fire and Rescue. Longtime civic leader and community resident Bob Winters, a Lt. Col. With the county's fire department, was thrilled that there were no calls to treat anyone with injuries or illnesses.

"If we can put that many people through this place and not have a single incident, I'm pretty happy with that," he said. "I think we had a very good crowd. We could've handled a lot more people."

Bands entertained a crowd gathered around the AdventHealth stage with people surrounding the area in lawn chairs and many getting up to dance in the grass. Among those dancers were sisters Adelia and Amelia Phillips. Joleia and Rodger Phillips, parents of the 4- and 2-year-old respectively, have been to the past four Pigz in Z'hills festivals.

"The music," was Rodger's simple answer as to why they keep coming back.

Others, though, come mostly for the ribs, pork, chicken and brisket.

"Sure, the lines are long, but the best ones have the long lines," said Marie Belanger, a Plant City snowbird from Maine who came with her husband Curtis.

"She likes her ribs sweet. Me, not so much," Curtis noted.
