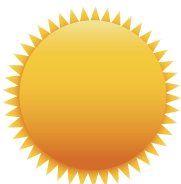

## 80 years and counting for humanitarian organization

Community service organizations, in many cases, represent the heart and soul of a city. The Zephyrhills Lions Club are just such a group and last Saturday evening members and guests celebrated its 80th anniversary. Established in 1943, the Zephyrhills club at 5826

Dean Dairy Rd. had a celebratory dinner with a social hour before and musical entertainment provided by Aloha Kev afterward. For his part, Kev, whose real name is Kevin Taggerty, was only too happy to be the disc jockey as well as call out numbers and letters for a bingo game. Like the Lions members he said it's all about giving back. "If we don't, who will," said Taggerty, a U.S. Air Force veteran who served from 1991-2014 and has since retired. Roderick Wright, Past International Director for the Lions, was among the key dignitaries to attend the event. He spoke proudly of the humanitarian organization, which locally is a primary organizer of the Toys for Tots program and helps pay for people

## Main Street team debuts its Golden Egg Hunt

*Innovative version of a downtown scavenger hunt coincides with popular Main Street Market*

The aptly put slogan for Main Street Zephyrhills is "preserving tomorrow's hometown" and a pair of recent events exemplified that with the aim of popularizing downtown activities. The non-profit organization, which is behind several events throughout the year, hosted Sip & Stroll Art Walk and Night Market earlier this month, as well as this past Saturday's Golden Egg Hunt that coincided with the more traditional Main Street Market. "We're doing more and more to get people downtown," said Antwon Gildon, Main Street's economic vitality chairman. "We want them to walk into local businesses." Main Street Market, featuring local vendors lining the downtown square, is a tradition that takes place every third Saturday of the month. Last weekend, however, a creative event was added to the mix. The Golden Egg Hunt — not to be confused with an Easter Egg Hunt like the annual one at Pioneer Florida Museum in Dade City — had people coming downtown, young and old alike, hunting for golden eggs filled with \$5 bills. During the impromptu scavenger hunt, people searched up and down Main Street to find the eggs hidden in the nooks and crannies of a few selected local businesses. The unique idea came from Christine Bennett, Main Street's design committee chairperson who also owns two Tiny Houses set up as vacation rentals near Zephyr Park. She said she was influenced by her children — Camila, 7, and 4-year-old Aaron Bennett Jr. — who like finding things.

## Local coaches teach basketball fundamentals

*Southward Elite Basketball League, started by former Zephyrhills and Pasco standouts, provides learning experiences for boys and girls*

Nearly a decade ago, John Edwards, a former physical education teacher at Woodland Elementary, tried to get a youth basketball program going at Centennial Middle. That program lasted for just two seasons due, in part, to fees various charged for school services. Eric Southward, a former Pasco High standout, and his wife Natalie, who once starred on the courts at Zephyrhills High, have made that concept work. Their initial foray a year ago into youth basketball was Little Hoopsters Academy. That program entailed teaching boys and girls — some as young as 4-years-old — the basics of the game on an outdoor court adjacent to The Lagoon in the Epperson community of Wesley Chapel. They also began teaching basketball at local daycares in east and central Pasco. The couples' efforts have since expanded to the Southward Elite Basketball League for three age brackets — 5-7, 8-11 and 12-16 — with weekend

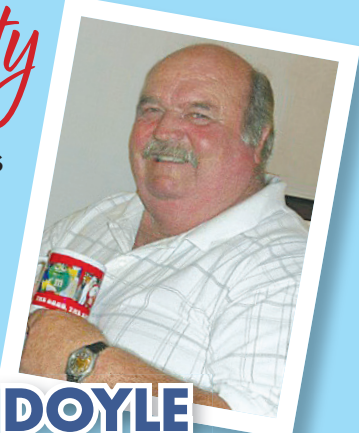

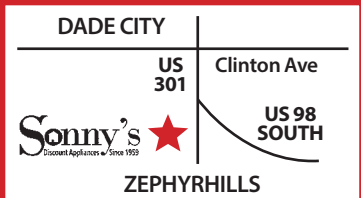

"It's something to attract (people) to downtown; also to the market," she said of the Golden Egg Hunt. "We want them to be able to see that there's a market going on."

Zephyrhills residents Cheryl Black and Chris Baldwin really enjoyed the Sip & Stroll on March 10, which took place downtown from 5-8 p.m. and featured local shops, food trucks, vendors, giveaways, with an art walk, wine, music and a silent auction. Tori Santiago won a TV.

"It was nice, because we got to come out without the kids," Black said. "It was fun discovering all the businesses we've never walked into."

Sip & Stroll followed another event that had traditionally been held during the daytime. A weekend earlier Main Street rescheduled the Founder's Day Parade, which always had taken place during the day, to an evening activity.

The parade and festival followed a two-year hiatus due to the coronavirus pandemic in 2021 and conflict with the Pigz n' Zhills BBQ and Blues Festival last year. Main Street Zephyrhills plans to keep the parade at night.

"Sip & Stroll was one of our first new events geared toward the nighttime," Gildon said. "It went over so well that plans are in the works to continue it. The Main Markets will transform to the evenings, beginning in May through the summer."

Baldwin, who brought her four children and a grandson to Saturday's event, said, "I like it. It gives us something to do and it's fun for the whole family."

Zephyrhills residents Alexis DeGroot and her friend Tracy McCoy also enjoyed the market.

"It's nice to walk around outdoors and see the different items," McCoy said. "I get to make friends and meet local vendors."

Among those strolling downtown on Saturday were city councilman Lance Smith, his wife Tammy and former city manager Steve Spina, who is running for a city councilman seat.

"I think they have some momentum going," Spina said of Main Street events, adding that the Golden Eggs addition "is a good idea. They're thinking outside the box."

MOMENTS IN TIME: The History Channel

\* On April 6, 1896, the first modern Olympic Games opened in Athens more than 1,500 years after the last Games, which originated in Olympia in southwestern Greece. Two hundred and forty-one athletes from 14 countries took part.

\* On April 5, 1955, Winston Churchill, who was instrumental in initiating the alliance between the U.K., the U.S. and the Soviet Union against Nazi Germany, resigned as prime minister of the U.K. His political career spanned half a century.

\* On April 3, 1973, Motorola employee Martin Cooper made the first public mobile telephone call, on a Manhattan sidewalk, to Joel Engel of Bell Labs. Cooper later told the BBC

that his first words were, "Joel, I'm calling you from a 'real' cellular telephone. A portable handheld telephone."

\* On April 8, 1974, Hank Aaron, aka "Hammerin' Hank," of the Atlanta Braves struck his 715th career home run, smashing Babe Ruth's legendary record of 714 homers. Over the preceding winter, Aaron had endured death threats and hate mail from people who didn't want to see that record broken by a Black man.

\* On April 7, 2003, the U.S. Supreme Court voted 6-3 to uphold a 50-year-old Virginia law making it a crime to burn a cross as an act of intimidation. The practice is widely associated with the Ku Klux Klan and is still protected by the First Amendment at Klan rallies.

\* On April 9, 2009, the U.S. stopped running its global network of secret prisons used to detain and interrogate terrorism suspects, sometimes with "torturous" methods. CIA Director Leon Panetta added that any remaining sites would be decommissioned. President Barack Obama had promised to shut the facilities down shortly after taking office.

\* On April 4, 2013, American film critic Roger Ebert died of cancer just two days after announcing he would write fewer reviews due to the disease's recurrence. His thumbs up/thumbs down rating system with fellow critic Gene Siskel turned the pair into household names and became a popular part of American culture.

games played in the indoor gym at Wesley Chapel District Park as well as the Dade City Armory.

"We get players from all over the place," said Southward, listing players from Wesley Chapel, Zephyrhills and Dade City with some even coming from the North Tampa area.

In the league's first year there are 110 kids

who signed up. Co-ed teams play an eight-week regular season from early March through April 30 with playoffs after that.

"Eric's taken it to the next level," said Edwards, who has since retired. "The league is good. It's fundamentals. Eric and his wife seem to do a good job."

Brandon Bristow, a former basketball coach at Stewart Middle who works for the Pasco County Parks and Recreation Department, noted that players, coaches and parents alike welcome the new league. He also spoke fondly of the couple and their teaching abilities.

"They do an amazing job with the league," Bristow said of the Southwards. "They do a great job teaching the fundamentals to the little ones."

"We teach them the fundamentals; motor skills, dribbling, shooting, coordination and balance," Southward said.

"They just need to learn the basics."

He and his wife have the experience and passion for the game to impart their messages. After Pasco, Eric went on to play for Pasco-Hernando Community College then at Johnson and Wales University in Providence, R.I. Natalie, whose maiden name was West when she played at Zephyrhills, later played for Southeastern University in Lakeland.

Edwards, who has coached high school boys and girls basketball at Pasco, boys basketball at Zephyrhills, along with women's basketball at Saint Leo University and the University of South Florida, now coaches an older group in the Southward's league. He came back to coaching, in part, because of the Southward's concept of learning the basics of the sport above winning.

"The kids are really good. They're very open and wanting to learn," Edwards said. "The objective is to do the best we can. If we win we win, if we don't we don't."

Setting up the academy and league are ways in which Southward and his wife hope to spread their love of the game to local youngsters. With the younger ones, Southward noted that some of the parents have expressed doubts that their children would be able to pick up the basics of the game.

"A lot of parents, they're shocked that we do basketball at that age," he said. "We teach (young boys and girls) to understand basketball and love it at an early age. That's the most exciting thing about it."
