With both teams having early-season victories in which they scored in double digits, the outcome came down to hitting — a lot for Cypress Creek, not so much for Zephyrhills. The Coyotes racked up 10 hits throughout the game and capitalized on four Zephyrhills

errors, scoring in all but one inning.

"We're starting to come together," said Cypress Creek coach
Joe Neale, adding that after the close loss to Sunlake "we just decided to show up at the ballpark and just play together. They had a

The Bulldogs did not fare nearly as well on offense with a meager four hits, both of which came in the only inning they scored. Their other two hits came in the top of the seventh inning, but it did

## **Bulldogs make** history by winning two titles

Stewart's varsity and junior varsity boys basketball teams are champions in the same season

For the first time in school history Stewart won boys basketball conference titles at the varsity and junior varsity levels with matching 8-0 records in the same season. The host Bulldogs pulled off that milestone feat against arch-rival Pasco, winning the JV game 52-21 before a 43-15 victory in the varsity

Stewart's JV team had the most recent championship, winning it in the 2016-17 season. The varsity squad won three titles in four years — 1991-92, 1993-94 and 1994-95 — before adding to that list with its

"It just means so much to the school. It's surreal," added Stewart first-year JV coach Brandon Bristow. "The boys put in a tremendous effort. They took

care of business on and off the court."

"It's history in the books," Zephyrhills varsity coach Marcus Mckinley added. "Me and coach Bristow, we had a plan at the beginning of the season. We said if we followed that plan we'd prevail.'

Both undefeated Stewart teams followed their respective plans to the letter, according to the coaches, and shared in their championship celebrations on their home court afterward.

Prior to this season, Mckinley coached Stewart

They were teams in different phases of development. The visiting Cyclones are just coming out of a rebuild and the host Coyotes are a year away from what might be their best team in the program's short history. It showed on the pitch Tuesday night. The Coyotes were up 2-0 before the first water break.

It was not long before Rosa Calcagni made it 3-0. A great shot, angled low to the corner by Annalisse Vizza made it 4-0 heading into the half.

The Coyotes just closed off half of the field. Their stout back line of Vizza, Ashley Rees, Alexa Wainright and Natasha Sax, helped the host team keep almost all of the action on the Centennial side of the field. Virtually every ball that made it near midfield was batted back into the danger zone.

"We have a good, cohesive team and we empower each other," Coyote head coach Terra Corrao said. "We play good defense, have a great midfield, it's just a great team.

Defender Lindsay Fulop helped out on the back line, her traditional position, but in the second half, Corrao cut her loose to the forward position. Fulop showed just why she's the team's leading scorer. Fulop scored just minutes into the second half to make it 5-0. Again, just a few minutes later, Fulop was free on a fast break and buried a nice shot, low to the far post.

# Wealth of Health

Eggs are a topic of conversation each spring, largely because of their relationship to the Christian celebration of Easter. Brightly colored Easter eggs are on display, chocolate eggs line store shelves and egg-lined birds nests in trees and bushes dot spring landscapes.

Eggs take center stage in early spring, but they're more than just novelties to include in Easter celebrations.

• Eggs are nutritious. Eggs are loaded with vitamins A, D and B12 and the nutrient choline. They're also an excellent protein source in a small package. At 72 calories and packing six grams of protein, eggs can make for a great, filling meal at any time of day.

• Eggs boost brain health. The choline in eggs is a crucial nutrient for memory, mood and muscle control, according to the University of Missouri Health Care system. Choline also is essential in fetal brain development and can help prevent birth defects.

• Eggs don't always have to be refrigerated. In countries outside of the United States and Canada, eggs may not be refrigerated and do not have to be chilled. Also, outside of North America eggs are not washed prior to commercial production. However, according to the food resource TheKichn, power-washing eggs removes a protective coating and makes the eggs porous and vulnerable to contamination. A synthetic coating is put on washed eggs.

Shell color does not matter. The color of the eggshell doesn't indicate taste, nutritional value or even egg quality. The color of the eggshell reflects the breed of hen that laid the egg. Redfeathered hens tend to lay brown eggs, while hens with white features lay white eggs. Similarly, the shade of yolk is representative of what the chicken is eating. A dark, yellow yolk means the hen was probably fed green vegetables.

Lighter yolks coordinate to corn and grain diets.

• All eggs are "hormone-free." The term

"hormone-free" on egg cartons does not signify anything special. It's like advertising that snow is cold. The United States Food & Drug Administration banned the use of hormones in all poultry production in the 1950s. All eggs are

• Size and eggshell thickness indicates the age of the hen. Eggs come in different sizes, such as medium, large and jumbo. The age of the chicken determines the size, with older hens producing larger eggs. Age also affects shell thickness, with younger hens laying thicker-shelled eggs, says Eat This, Not That!

hormone-free.

• Eggs won't hatch. Eggs sold for consumption are not fertilized. Hens that have laid them haven't mated.

• Many birds lay eggs. Kiwis lay the largest egg in relation to their body size of any species of bird in the world. However, the ostrich, emu and cassowary lay the biggest eggs.

• The sink or swim test can say a lot about an egg. Eggs become more porous as they age. You can tell if an egg is old by putting it in a glass of water. If it sinks, it is fresh. If it floats, it is an



## Introducing K9 Maddie

We Fight As One

The Pasco Sheriff's Office currently has 31 K9 teams, trained in a variety of specialities, which are paramount in keeping Pasco safe.

When selecting new K9s, trainers look for at a variety of traits, such as intelligence, obedience and a personality that compliments the handler. As the unit continues to grow, PSO has introduced new K9 specialties to expand our capabilities and assist the citizens of our community in different ways.

The latest iteration of this is livefind detection, and PSO added its first K9 of this specialty in May 2020. As a livefind detection dog, K9 Maddieis able to locate people that are still alive and buried in debris or rubble. This two-year-old Labrador Retriever's courage, keen sense of smell and hearing made her an excellent candidate for the team. Her capabilities are instrumental when assisting in the aftermath of natural and man-made disas-

Similar to other canines, K9 Maddie is trained to track through woods, swamps, neighborhoods and buildings, during varied weather conditions. K9 Maddie also gets the unique opportunity to train on PSO's two in-house rubble pile training facilities, making quality training that

Her handler, Dep. Robert Lewis started at the Pasco Sheriff's Office in 2015 and joined the Canine Unit in 2020. Dep. Lewis has been around dogs all his life and knew he and K9 Maddie would make a great team. They have developed a strong bond through training together.

"At work, she is easy-going and just wants to get out and run," stated Dep.

Lewis. "Whether it's training on

rubble pile, agility equipment or running around on a break, working with her is the best thing I could ask for."

K9 Maddie passed Fundamental Assessment (FSA) test in under three months. This test is a state certification for FEMA and assess a K9's ability to maneuver through difficult obstacles, follow the handler's directions and

locate live humans. Dep. Lewis and K9 Maddie are currently waiting to be accepted to a Federal Task Force to complete K9 Maddie's Certification Evaluation (CE). This will allow Dep. Lewis and K9 Maddie to be deployed out of state and possibly even out of the country.

Along with live find detection, PSO's canines are specialized in tracking, evidence recovery, building/area searches, criminal apprehension, narcotics detection, explosives detection and human remains detection. The Pasco Sheriff's Office also added two therapy dogs last year, who assist our Behavioral Health Intervention Team (BHIT).

Like all of PSO's K9s, the funds for K9 Maddie were donated by citizens of Pasco County. Ed and Angie Moore wished to honor of their daughter Madison "Maddie" Moore, who passed away in 2017. Madison wished to pursue a career in forensics and the Moores are thrilled that K9 Maddie will continue Madison's memory for years to come. Dep. Lewis and K9 Maddie will work hard to honor Madison's memory and keep Pasco safe.

Centennial finally pushed the ball through to the Cypress Creek end and they had a look at the goal but it evaporated. Very quickly, the pressure was back on. Fulop, in the last 20 minutes, would punch a great shot to the right, off the right side of her foot to the far corner of the net to make it 7-0.

A couple more near misses for the Coyotes and Piper Adams would close it out blocking a Centennial goal kick, slipping around a defender and scoring to make it an 8-0 mercy ruling.

Centennial did manage to beat Stewart 3-2 this season but they are looking ahead to next year as well. Head coach Amber Larsen, a former Zephyrhills High School soccer player, is in her second year at the head of both the boys and girls teams.

not pay off as Zephyrhills left the bases loaded with two outs without getting a run in.

"That's probably the worst we've played yet, but that's probably the best team we've played," Zephyrhills coach Rusty Guynn said. "That's one of the better teams, if not the best team in Pasco (County) right now."

Guynn could have a point. Cypress Creek has a roster featuring four college signees -Peyton Petry, Anthony Menendez, Zach Beulk and Nolan Jamison — and won 17 games in 2019 before going 4-3 in last year's shortened season.

The Coyotes struck quick against the Bulldogs, taking a 7-0 lead through three innings. Dyllan Brown drove in a pair of runs in the first. Ethan Petry, a junior and Peyton's younger brother, hit a two-run single in the second and added two more singles later. He also scored three times.

Trailing 7-0, Zephyrhills' Micah Berrien singled, Bryan Santiago reached on an infield

error and Martin Calhoun walked. That loaded the bases for Mark Santiago, who drove in two runs with a double to the left field fence.

Zephyrhills loaded the bases in the top of the seventh with two outs, but could not get a run home. For the game, Berrien and Mark Santiago each had two hits.

As for the pitching, Cypress Creek starter Caden Kwiat earned the win. The junior righthander allowed three runs on two hits with six strikeouts and three walks in four innings. Seamus Gallagher came on for three innings of scoreless relief, striking out four and allowing three hits.

"He threw strikes and let the defense play

behind him," Neale said of Kwiat. The Santiago brothers each threw three innings for Zephyrhills. Mark started and gave up seven runs, four of which were unearned after costly errors, on six hits. He fanned four and did not walk a batter. Bryan then came in and surrendered four more runs.

"The Santiago brothers threw the ball well," Guynn said.





HOLLYWOOD -- Welcome to the first big scandal of 2021. Armie Hammer, of the hit film "Call Me by Your Name," is in hot water because messages have surfaced on social media, allegedly written by him, in which he, supposedly, gives graphic details about sexual fantasies, some referencing cannibalism. He's denied the accusations and calls them "bulls\*\*t." His estranged wife, Elizabeth Chambers, has publicly said she is "shocked, heartbroken and devastated."

He's also got the Netflix streaming series "Jupiter's Legacy," with Ben Daniels, Leslie Bibb and Matt Lanter, with the first episode due May 7.

Duhamel still has legions of loyal fans from "All My Children," and, oh yes, he was married to the "Black Eyed Peas" Fergie for 10 years, and they had a son. He's a far better match for Jennifer Lopez than Armie Hammer.

to third place and a runner-up finish in his two previous years. "We've got a lot of talent," he said.

In the JV game, Stewart took a 20-11 halftime lead and had a balanced scoring as nine players got into the scoring column. Amontiy Hudson was the only Bulldog in double figures with 12 points. Azuri Jackson had 9, Roosevelt Miller scored seven and three players — Colin O'Malley, Daniel Carter, Jr. and Sanilyn Black — chipped in with 6 apiece. Tyler Gillett added 4 with Gar-

ren Ponder and Noah Porter each scoring 2.
For Pasco's JV team, Brody Carter netted a game-high 13 points. Bryce Frix had 3 with Jayden Knowles and Justino Camarillo each adding a pair of points.

In the varsity game that followed, Stewart jumped out to a

substantial 18-9 lead at the half and cruised to an easy victory. The Bulldogs actually had two seventh-graders as starters, guard Kingston McCullough and Demontia Hudson, a versatile player who can line up at guard as

well as forward.

Leading the way for Stewart was Tristan Lennon,

who scored 10 points as the only player in that game to finish in double figures. McCulllough and Hudson each had 6 points with Samaryna Black, Elijah Williams and Jayden Sanchez Alva-

rez adding 5 apiece.
For the Pasco varsity, Toni Bryant scored a team-leading 7 points. Chance Lowe added 3 with Sage Stinyard and Anthony Norman each chipping in with 2 apiece.

The doubleheader of JV and varsity games took on a special meaning for both teams. With Deori Pope, a Stewart JV player who played for Pasco last season, out of the lineup after playing the first six games of the season, members of both sides wore pins with his face depicted on them. Bristow said he was hospitalized with complications from COVID-19.

"He's going to be ecstatic," Bristow said of when Pope, a shooting guard and one of the team's top players, would be told of the dual titles. "I wish he was here tonight.

Early on there were indications of Stewart's championship possibilities. In the season openers last month, Stewart's varsity and JV teams swept Pasco in Dade City. 
