

## City council recognizes public works, reviews airport

The meeting began with acknowledgments to civic leaders and civil servants. First up was a proclamation recognizing Terry Luna, the executive director of Pregnancy Care Center of Zephyrhills. The proclamation recognized Luna's 20 years of service with the pregnancy center.

Next up was a Water Reuse Proclamation issued to utilities director John Bostic and wastewater superintendent OJ Kurk. The proclamation stated that Florida is one of the leading states in water reuse, utilizing 820 millions gallons of it, per day. It also proclaimed May

16-22 as Florida Water Reuse Week.

The last proclamation recognized the Zephyrhills Public Works Department. Public works director Shane LeBlanc, flanked by public works employees were present for the proclamation denoting the week of May 16-22 as National Public Works Week.

Zephyrhills City Manager William Poe Jr. challenged anyone to find cleaner sanitation trucks and said that the Zephyrhills Department was one of the top ranked and called them the "face of the organization."

Three Consent Agenda Items were bundled together and passed unanimously, councilman Ken Burgess filing the initial motion. Item 2.1 approved the minutes from the April 26 meeting. Item 2.2 was an agreement to piggyback with Seminole County for hydrant valve installation, repair and maintenance, extending the contract to Dec. 10, 2023. Item 2.3 was also a piggyback agreement, this one an extension of the agreement with Wastewater Gravity Lines & Manhole Rehabilitation with Hinterland Group, Inc. and Palm Beach County. ## Pasco Schools transitions to "Masks Optional" after May 28

Pasco County Schools' requirement that students, staff, and visitors wear masks or face coverings on all Pasco school campuses and district offices will end at the close of business on May 28. After that date, masks and face coverings will be optional.

May 28 is the last day of school for teachers and May 26, is the last day for students. The mask requirement will effectively remain in place through the end of the 2020-2021 school year.

The "mask optional" change will affect high school graduations that occur after May 28. The district will encourage graduates and their guests to bring a mask, as it is likely that crowds will gather at concession stands prior to the ceremony. All but one of the graduations held after May 28 will be held outdoors in stadiums.

The "masks optional" approach also will affect the Extended School Year (summer school), which

starts June 7.

Though it is impossible to predict what course the pandemic will take in the coming months, Pasco County Schools is fully expecting the "masks optional" approach to carry over into the 2021-2022 school year.



# Wealth of Health

## Food's important role in overall health

Nutrition is a popular topic of conversation, particularly among those embarking on a weight loss or maintenance

plan. Individuals carefully study food macros and pore over various diets to get the most out of the foods they eat.

When the end goal is simply looking good, it may be easy to forget about the other benefits of nutritious diets, including

their link to overall health.

A close relationship exists between nutritional status and health. Experts at Tufts Health Plan recognize that good nutrition can help reduce the risk of developing many diseases, including heart disease, stroke, diabetes, and some cancers. The notion of "you are what you eat" still rings true.

The World Health Organization indicates better nutrition means stronger immune systems, fewer illnesses and better overall health. However, according to the National Resource Center on Nutrition, Physical Activity, and Aging, one in four older Americans suffers from poor nutrition. And this situation is not exclusive to the elderly. A report examining the global burden of chronic disease published in The Lancet found poor diet contributed to 11 million deaths worldwide - roughly 22 percent of deaths among adults - and poor quality of life. Low intake of fruits and whole grains and high intake of sodium are the leading risk factors for illness in many countries. Common nutrition problems can arise when one favors convenience and routine over balanced meals that truly fuel the body.

### Improving nutrition

Guidelines regarding how many servings of each food group a person should have each day may vary slightly by country, but they share many similarities. The U.S. Department of Agriculture once followed a "food pyramid" guide, but has since switched to the MyPlate



resource, which emphasizes how much of each food group should cover a standard 9-inch dinner plate. Food groups include fruits, vegetables, grains, proteins, and dairy. The USDA dietary guidelines were updated for its 2020-2025 guide.

Recommendations vary based on age and activity levels, but a person eating 2,000 calories a day should eat 2 cups of whole fruits; 2 1/2 cups of colorful vegetables; 6 ounces of grains, with half of them being whole grains; 5 1/2 ounces of protein, with a focus on lean proteins; and 3 cups of low-fat dairy. People should limit their intake of sodium, added sugars and saturated fats. As a person ages he or she generally needs fewer calories because of less activity. Children may need more calories because they are still growing and tend to be very active.

Those who are interested in preventing illness and significantly reducing premature mortality from leading diseases should carefully evaluate the foods they eat, choosing well-balanced, low-fat, nutritionally dense options that keep saturated fat and sodium intake to a minimum.

Business Items 3.1 and 3.2 were next steps in items that have already passed the council's oversight, more than once. Item 3.1 changed the qualification guidelines and allowed for two alternates with regard to the Historic Preservation Board. Item 3.2 was a zoning change for a 0.19-acre parcel at the corner of 11th Street and 7th Avenue. It asked for a zoning change to allow for a single family residence.

Both items passed unanimously, with councilwoman Jodi Wilkeson filing the initial motion on both.

Item 4.1 saw Economic Development Planner Harry Walsh of the Tampa Bay Regional Planning Council give a presentation on a potential Zephyrhills Aviation Cluster. With the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport Runway Extension allowing for more flight traffic, the notion of creating "clusters" of affiliated businesses was presented. Walsh showcased clusters of furniture stores, jewelry stores and other types of retail clusters at other airports. He also spoke about airport related clusters like repair and parts manufacturing. While the uptick in traffic, once the runway is completed, is unpredictable, Walsh stated that the airport has plenty of land to develop - roughly 442 acres. Walsh did make it clear that commercial aviation is a depressed industry right now.

Item 4.2 was an amendment to the Robert H. Gagne PUD Master Plan. It asked for a rezoning of the area south of Chancy Road and east of State Road 39. One of the requests was to change the PUD Master Plan of that area from multi-family apartments to a mix of single family and multi-family townhomes. The requested change amounted to a net decrease in the number of homes on the property but allowed for more flexibility of uses. Some questions arose addressing the types of landscape buffering and noise mitigating fencing, as well as what the mix of 40-foot and 50-foot lots would be. The questions were partially addressed but as the item was more of a presentation and not in need of action, it proceeded. Burgess nodded to the mix of commercial and residential uses.

"It fits with what we're trying to do," Burgess said. There were also wetlands and a nature trail as part of the amendment. Poe did stipulate that if portions or the whole of the property falls within the flight pattern of Zephyrhills Municipal Airport, that potential residents needed to be notified of it. No formal action was taken but a general consensus from the council allowed for city attorney Matthew Maggard to draw up an ordinance and start the codification process.

The City Manager's Report contained item 5.1, an amendment to the Zephyrhills Municipal Golf Course Lease Agreement. While there were questions about ADA compliant restrooms, youth programs and the like, a few key evolving factors shaped the discussion. First, the airport runway extension having an impact on the golf course and second, that the National Guard had eyes on part of the property as well. The lease does not expire until April of 2023 and, after some discussion, councilman Lance Smith made a motion to table the discussion until some of the issues developed. The measure passed unanimously and will be revisited at a later time.

Next up was a departmental update for the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport. Airport manager Nathan Coleman took the podium and presented details about the evolving facility. There are currently six employees at the airport, they maintain 840 acres of real estate, manage 15 private business leases, maintain 175 buildings, maintain 12 miles of lighted airfield as well as pavement, maintain fuel farms, storm structures, 230 customer accounts, 45,000 to 50,000 general aviation operations and 75-100 full service jet operations.

The big question revolved around the 6,200-foot runway extension. The extension will allow for 15 new and larger types of aircraft to use the runway. It's nearly impossible to ascertain just how much increased traffic this will provoke but it will enable both B-Class and C-Class, the different classes denoting how much airspace, communication and runway length the planes require. There still remains some mitigation on 6th Avenue before B-Class planes are permitted but the overall completion date for the runway extension is set for Feb. 12, 2022.



# The Jeffries House; a brief history

*The historic home built by the man largely credited with founding the City of Zephyrhills, could see big changes with a Request For Proposal (RFP)*

Captain Howard B. Jeffries was born in Lafayette, Ind. on April 17, 1843. By 1860, the Jeffries Family had moved to Lycoming County, Penn. Jeffries' father Cyrus (Siras), according to the 1860 Census, worked as a painter. Jeffries, just 18 at the time, is

listed as a "printer." It would not be long before the looming conflict between North and South would alter Jeffries' trajectory.

On April 12, 1861, Fort Sumter in Charleston Harbor was evacuated and occupied by South Carolina state troops. That month, Jeffries went to Philadelphia and enlisted in the U.S. Army. He would enter into Company F, 28th Pennsylvania Infantry. The 28th Regiment would be mustered into the army on June 28, 1861, just days after the Battle of 1st Bull Run (Manassas). The unit served mostly in northern Virginia and participated in battles at 2nd Bull Run (2nd Manassas), Antietam (Sharpsburg) and in the Chancellorsville Campaign in May of 1863.

That July, Jeffries transferred from the 28th infantry to the

21st Pennsylvania Cavalry. He received a commission as 2nd Lieutenant of Company E and served with the unit until April of 1865. The 21st was attached to the Army of the Potomac and participated in action at Cold Harbor, the Siege of Petersburg, Five Forks and was present for Lee's surrender at Appomattox Court House.

The Army of Northern Virginia's surrender was not the end of Jeffries' military career. Not just yet, anyway. That same month, Jeffries traveled to Covington, Ky. to accept a captain's commission of Company B, 72nd United States Colored Infantry. The unit never saw action and was never mustered into the army. Recruitment efforts stalled and were discontinued on May 3, 1865, just one week after Joseph E. Johnston surrendered his force to William T. Sherman near Durham, N.C., effectively ending the American Civil War.

Jeffries' military career was still not quite complete. On Jan. 6, 1869, Jeffries penned a letter to Secretary of War J.M. Schofield, requesting commission as Army chaplain. Jeffries attached his Ministerial Commission in the Church of Christ to his application. It is unclear if he was accepted or how long he served at the post.

By 1909, Jeffries and his family had travelled to Florida seeking an opportunity posted in the *National Tribune* by James L. Greer, offering land for sale in Florida. Jeffries purchased 35,000 acres in what was then called "Abbott," later Zephyrhills. Jeffries is largely credited with supplying the name "Zephyrhills" to the area, a zephyr being a fresh gust of wind. Jeffries had a vision to make the small hamlet a convalescent/retirement community for Union war veterans.

Jeffries' family home, the Jeffries House, was built in 1911 at present day 38537 5th Ave. The house was built in what is termed as the "vernacular" style - that is, with locally sourced material and most often without the supervision of an architect. Originally a more modest affair, the home was expanded in the 1920s and then again in 1940, after Jeffries' death in 1936.

On Nov. 29, 1995, the home was added to the United States Register of Historic Places. The City of Zephyrhills acquired the historic landmark in 2014 and the house is currently occupied by Main Street Zephyrhills.

At the April 26, city council meeting, a RFP or Request for Proposal was approved unanimously for both the Jeffries House and accompanying Carriage House - built in 1940. The Carriage House has already undergone a major renovation and appears to be aimed at some form of rental occupancy, as opposed to historic preservation.

It is unclear just what types of proposals the city will consider for the Jeffries House, even though there are some outlined "Historic Preservation Considerations" in the RFP, it would be a tragic loss of historical significance if it goes out to the wrong occupant and strict preservation standards are not upheld.

# Return of spring practices for Zephyrhills football team

The Zephyrhills High football team is back on the gridiron for traditional spring practices. This month will feature an Orange-Black game, which basically amounts to an in-house scrimmage combining the varsity and junior varsity player this Friday at 6 p.m. There also will be a May 21 home exhibition game against Sunshine Athletic Conference rival Mitchell. Kickoff at Bulldog Stadium is at 7 p.m.

On a lighter note, another event at home is the annual Powder Puff matchup in which girls compete in flag football and boys dress up as cheerleaders on the sidelines. That fun-filled scrimmage, which always features a wacky halftime show, takes place Friday at 4:30 p.m.

Zephyrhills coach Nick Carroll and his coaching staff are getting their first looks at some players called up from last year's junior varsity squad, along with checking out the further development of key returners from last year's team.

Perhaps nobody is more relieved than Carroll about returning to practice this spring after last May's sessions were cancelled due to the coronavirus pandemic.

"We can't take things for granted," said Carroll, a former standout defensive back who entered his sixth season coaching at his alma mater. "There's nothing given in this world. You've got

to take the opportunities you do have and run with it."

The Bulldogs have a bit of tradition to carry on. They have made the playoffs for six of the past seven seasons, including four of five under Carroll's guidance. He replaced another former Zephyrhills standout in Reggie Roberts before the 2016 season.

As has been the case in multiple seasons, the Bulldogs are expected to have a strong running attack. Replacing 2021 graduates Zyre Roundtree and Tre Gallimore will be a trio of rising seniors that include Jaylin Thomas, Willie Queen and Nick Sheldon. Thomas is likely to be the workhorse in the backfield.

"He's strong and powerful," Carroll said of Thomas, who gained 590 yards and scored a team-high 11 touchdowns last season. He feels way more confident running the football.

Jaxson Rivera returns as the starting quarterback, but the coach said R.J. Allen, the junior varsity quarterback called up late last season, also will get a good look.

"It's Rivera's right now, but we want great competition to make one another better," Carroll said.

Rivera threw for 653 yards and 10 touchdowns with four interceptions last year. He also handles

kickoffs and will split time kicking extra points and field goals with Gabe Coveny.

"He's a good athlete," Carroll said of Rivera, who will be a senior and also plays soccer and baseball. "He's just a really good competitor."

As for receivers, the Bulldogs aim to shore up that unit that includes T.J. Jackson, Maguire Neal, Jakobi Campbell, Maddox Rivera and Ben Raines.

Zephyrhills had 31 rushing touchdowns last year compared to just 11 receiving.

"Obviously we want to be more balanced," Carroll said.

That said, Carroll intends to spread the ball around more. That will include getting the football into the hands of Jackson, a former quarterback who has the makings of a productive playmaker whether catching or running out of different formations.

"He continues to get better," Carroll said. "He had a great offseason in track. He's electrifying, so obviously we want him to get some touches."

Carroll praises the team for how it has progressed in just a few days of practice so far and is eager to see how the players will fare in their upcoming scrimmages.

"I think the fundamentals that we're doing are starting to show up," he said. "I think we are progressing."


