### Fellowship of Christian Athletes hosted third annual All-Star baseball game for Pasco County seniors

With the East comfortably leading 5-2 late in Saturday's Fellowship of Christian Athletes All-Star baseball game, the West was down to its final at-bat. Four runs later, the West had a 6-5 comeback victory at Bishop McLaughlin in Spring Hill.

Afterward, Bob Durham, FCA's area director who has organized all three annual all-star baseball games for Pasco County seniors, seemed to be just as thrilled as the winning team and its fans. "It looked like the game was going to be over," he said, adding that the all-star format "is fun for the players and the parents getting to see their kid play one more time."

Certainly, but that is only part of what the all-star game and

week-long celebration is about. It all starts with a banquet with a Christian message on the Sunday before the all-star game. Guest speakers are brought in and awards to deserving seniors are doled out for the event held at the Word of Life Institute in Hudson.

Durham also has organized a countywide football game for outgoing seniors, an exhibition contest that has been played for the past five years in December at Sunlake. He organized a baseball game after Matt Wicks, the county's athletic director, asked if he would organize another sport for county seniors.

Spreading a Christian message is the ultimate goal of the events, which include the banquet, a couple of practices during the week and the exhibition games.

"The games are just something we do on the side, but it's so much fun," Durham said.

"The week leading up to the game was cool," added Joe Neale, Cypress Creek's baseball coach who formerly coached at Pasco High and Centennial Middle. "It's kind of one last hurrah for these guys."

Fellowship and camaraderie — on and off the field — are what players and coaches enjoyed the most, regardless of the outcome.

### Summer 7-on-7 offers coaches and players a chance to keep the saw sharp

*For fans, it's a great way to see their team in action over the summer and for coaches and players, it's a chance to hone certain skills ahead of the fall season*

Years ago 7-on-7 was just a practice drill. It pitted a quarterback and six backs and receivers against seven defenders. No pass rush, just a four-count before the ball has to come out or the play is dead. It's always been a great way for receivers to learn their routes and for quarterbacks to develop their timing. For defenders, it's always been a great way to hone backpedalling skills, the transition from backpedal to running and running different coverage schemes.

At some point, it got turned into a game. No one knows exactly where or with whom but what began as a simple practice drill is now a national phenomenon with big-time sponsorships and recruiting opportunities.

The Zephyrhills News spoke with former NFL linebacker Ryan Fowler, who remembers 7-on-7 as simply a practice drill.

"We would call it Pass Skel or Skelly as in pass skeleton and from high school to college to the NFL,

## East can't hang on as West pulls away for decisive 9-1 all-star win

### Second annual softball showdown for county seniors hosted by Fellowship of Christian Athletes

Bob Durham, area director for the Fellowship of Christian Athletes, organized an all-star football game for Pasco County's seniors and it has been played at Sunlake in Land O' Lakes ever since. The format, however, did not stop there and it continues to expand.

Three years ago, Durham expanded the FCA all-star program to baseball and last year softball was added thanks to the prodding of county athletic director Matt Wicks.

On Saturday at Bishop McLaughlin, the second annual all-star softball game was played with the East hanging close and trailing just 4-1 before the West pulled away late for a decisive 9-1 win.

"It was still competitive," Durham said at the midpoint of the nine-inning contest that evened the annual series up at 1-1.

The score to that exhibition, however, was not nearly as important as the experience and time shared with the county's best softball players for the final game of their high school careers.

"It was fun," Pasco pitcher Rachel Roberts said of the two practices with players from other schools during the week before the all-star game. "It was different to see how they played."

"It was fun, because we all grew up playing together," said Cypress Creek's Payton Hudson, alluding to many girls who have played together or against one another on various all-star and travel softball teams. "It's an honor."

Also honored, only for him it was to be chosen as an umpire, was Joe Galyan, a teacher at Woodland Elementary who umpires and referees several sports throughout the county.

"It's definitely an honor and a privilege to be asked to participate in this," said Galyan, who umpired along the first base line during Saturday's all-star game. "It's to relax and have fun."

Lauren Pasquale, a former Zephyrhills standout who in her first season coaching Wesley Chapel led the Wildcats to the

region semifinals, recalled playing in an all-star game in Ocala during her senior year. That game, which capped a stellar career for the 2011 graduate, was hosted by the Florida Athletic Coaches Association and featured players from throughout the state.

"This would've been more convenient," she said of the county all-star format while coaching the East squad.

Durham is not sure what sport could be added next, but he did say another would join the list since the concept has gone over so well. Soccer and basketball are among the sports being considered, but nothing has been decided yet.

Aside from the practices and exhibition game to close out

## Should you skip breakfast while dieting?

The secret to losing weight involves a careful balance. The number of calories that go into a person should be exceeded by the energy expended by exercise and the normal biological functions of the body. This often involves controlling caloric intake, which can be simple when people cut back on portion sizes.

Some people believe they can lose weight by limiting what they eat and even skipping certain meals altogether. But skipping a meal like breakfast could actually have an adverse effect on weight-loss efforts.

People who lose weight and keep it off are generally those who eat a large, healthy

breakfast. In a 2017 study about meal frequency and changes in body mass index published in The Journal of Nutrition, researchers found that those who made breakfast the largest meal of the day were more likely to have a lower body mass index (BMI) than those who ate a large lunch or dinner. A portion-controlled breakfast full of lean protein and whole grains can help people to feel fuller longer. Breakfast can curb hunger pangs before lunch, reducing the likelihood that people will reach for unhealthy vending machine fare to tide them over until their midday meals.

The nutrition experts at Runtastic, a resource for avid runners, find that eating breakfast stimulates the body's natural thermogenic process, which is the use of energy to store food in the stomach, transport it through the digestive system and burn energy. Furthermore, studies have shown that eating a meal in the morning boosts metabolism more than eating the same meal in the evening. That's because, in the morning, the meal is jump-starting the body's metabolic process for the day.

Eating breakfast also can have a positive impact on blood sugar concentration and may reduce postprandial hyperglycemia (higher

blood sugar levels after eating) in people who have diabetes.

The Academy of Nutrition and Dietetics recommends people divide their total daily food intake into four or five meals, including breakfast, over the course of the day. This provides constant fuel and will help one to avoid hunger pangs and blood sugar drops that may lead to impulse eating.

When choosing breakfast foods, certain options are smarter than others. Look for lean proteins, vegetables, whole grains, and low-fat dairy products. High-fiber foods, like oatmeal, can quell hunger pangs quickly and stabilize blood sugar after a meal. Protein also is filling. A 2005 study of overweight women published in the Journal of the American College of Nutrition showed that eating eggs for breakfast instead of a bagel significantly increased feelings of fullness and reduced food intake later in the day. Increasing fiber intake from fruits also can create feelings of fullness and promote weight loss.

Breakfast is an important meal that shouldn't be skipped, even by people aiming to lose weight.

there was almost no difference," Fowler said. "It fit in with the regular flow of practices from warmups to position drills then you would either go with 7-on-7 or 9-on-7."

The two drills are basically inverse images of each other. The 9-on-7, sometimes called Inside Run is a run game drill where just the quarterback, five offensive linemen and three backs, slot receivers or tight ends would run plays against four down linemen and three linebackers or three linemen and four backers. The inverse to that was 7-on-7 where it's only backs and receivers against line backers and defensive backs.

"It was like two halves to a whole," Fowler said. "You did one, then you did the other one right away. Then you'd go to a team period."

Fowler won a state championship with Seminole High School in Pinellas County, started all four years at linebacker at Duke University and spent three years with the Dallas Cowboys, two with the Tennessee Titans and one with the New York Jets. Now he coaches defense at Ravenwood High School in Brentwood, Tenn.

"A lot of sports have become year-round sports with travel clubs and AAU, 7-on-7 is kind of football's answer to that," Fowler said. While some coaches shun 7-on-7, some love it, some can take the good with the bad.

"The passing game in high school football has become 10 times more sophisticated," Fowler said. "If you faced a good quarterback in high school when I was in high school, your team might not have an answer for that if you didn't have a pass rush. The NFL has become more of a passing league and college has followed suit and that is a big reason for the prevalence of 7-on-7 in high school."

It also helps when you're grooming a new quarterback and that's just what most of the East Pasco teams are doing this year. The Bulldogs are bringing along rising junior Nick Novo. Novo got limited reps as a sophomore and can benefit from a summer of working with his receivers.

"(7-on-7) helps develop continuity and timing with kids on both sides of the ball," Zephyrhills head coach Nick Carroll said. "The other thing is competition. Any time you can compete at something, it makes you better."

The Pirates are in the same boat with rising junior Devin Jernigan. Jernigan will be debuting at quarterback in the fall.

"You're going to see some exotic pass combinations you might not see in the regular season," Pasco head coach Jason Stokes said. "But it teaches you how to hide your weaknesses and exploit your strengths."

The Wiregrass Ranch Bulls install rising senior Hunter Helton at quarterback this season. Helton actually plays for the 7-on-7 team, Team Tampa, and won the Adidas East Regional in Miami this year.

Cypress Creek is the one team that returns their starter from last year, Jehlani Warren.

"(7-on-7) helps keep your mind on football all summer, kids come out more focused and bought in," Coyote head coach Mike Johnson said. "Of course there are some things that don't transfer (to 11-man football) but some little things do transfer to actual games."

The Wesley Chapel Wildcats will bring up rising junior Owen Libby this season. Libby played last season and even got some starts. He will be the full-time guy in 2019 and a summer

of 7-on-7 will certainly help.

"One of the biggest things is it allows you to practice with the football all year," Wildcat head coach Tony Egan said. "It also helps with team chemistry and in getting the timing of your routes down."

Egan is aware of the benefits and also the drawbacks. There are tendencies that 7-on-7 players can get used to that will haunt them when the pads come on. Egan and his staff at Wesley Chapel try to combat this by doing things like having players put their hands up to distract the quarterback or hit him with pads to simulate pressure. On defense, it's hard not to get programmed into a pass-first mentality and that's definitely something you want to erase. Egan does it by making his defenders take a "run step" forward on each play during 7-on-7. "It might hurt us in 7-on-7 but it will help us in the fall," Egan said.

That notion is not lost on Fowler and his Ravenwood defense. Fowler will make his linebackers do up-downs to break that habit in fall practice. He'll make his defensive backs take a "foot pop" or "read step" during 7-on-7 competition to nip that habit in the bud. But overall? "I think the good out-weighs the bad by a lot," Fowler said.

Where can you find your team this summer?

Zephyrhills: Starting June 4 you'll be able to catch the 2019 Bulldogs at Fivay High School in Hudson at 6 p.m. on Tuesdays. There are six teams in the group, currently. Carroll says that the Bulldogs are trying to organize a regular 7-on-7 tournament over on the east side of the county, so stay tuned on that. Beyond that, the Bulldogs are slated to participate in the huge USF Sling and Shoot 7-on-7 Tournament that begins June 15 and continues through June 16 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. at the Lee Roy Selmon Athletics Center.

Pasco: The Pirates are travelling down to Skyway Park in Tampa near the airport where they'll mix it up with a lot of Hillsborough County teams. Those events are on Wednesdays at 4:30 p.m. Big events on the Pirate calendar are the June 8 King of Kings Tournament sponsored by the Fellowship of Christian Athletes. That event takes place at One Buc Place in Tampa. The Pirates will also head off to Lakeland Christian on June 20 for another FCA-sponsored tournament.

Wiregrass Ranch: The Bulls will go regularly at the Larry Sanders Park in Riverview. They play there on Wednesdays at 4:30 p.m. Kantor, Helton and the Bulls are also planning on attending the USF Sling and Shoot.

Wesley Chapel: The Wildcats will be in rank with the Bulldogs at Fivay on Tuesdays but they won't start until June 11. Ahead of that they'll be up at One Buc Place for the King of Kings tournament. June 13 the Wildcats plan to attend a tournament hosted by Bishop McLaughlin in Spring Hill. On July 15 they'll ship out to Orlando for a 32-team tournament.

Cypress Creek: The Coyotes are likely going to fall in with the other Pasco County teams at Fivay but Johnson was not 100 percent certain about that commitment. If Carroll and the Bulldogs get one going on the east side, it's likely the Coyotes will jump in. The Coyotes do have both the King of Kings (June 8) and the Bishop McLaughlin (June 13) dates on their calendar.

"I knew of them," Ricky Dunn, a pitcher and first baseman for Zephyrhills, said of some of his all-star teammates on the East squad. It's nice to finally meet them."

Zephyrhills catcher Dylan Wood, for one, spoke of how much making an all-star team to cap his senior years meant to him.

"It feels pretty amazing," he said in between innings and before taking his first at-bat in the third. "I worked all my life for something like this. It's cool to get recognized."

Pasco's four seniors shared that sentiment. While their team was at-bat they stood at the railing in front of the dugout and reminisced. That group included Brandon Mills, Caleb Johnson, Bristol Sargent and Emilio Villa.

The all-star format also was appreciated by Zephyrhills coach Rusty Guynn, who recalled a similar effort by former Zephyrhills coach Bruce Cimorelli (now that school's athletic director) and longtime Land O' Lakes coach Calvin Baisley when he was a player.

"One year we did an all-star game, but it wasn't much or anything like this," Guynn said. "It's got that (his players as well as those from other East teams) got to play with each other in a not so stressful environment. They have fun."
