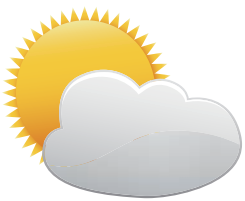

Zephyrhills defeats Hudson 10-0 to send their four seniors out with a victory

For eight consecutive seasons — basically every year since former Zephyrhills High ballplayer Rusty Guynn began coaching baseball at his alma mater — the Bulldogs have won on Senior Night. Make that nine in a row after last week's 10-0 shutout of Hudson, a game that ended in the sixth inning due to the mercy rule.

Celebrating with their families and friends during pre-game introductions and later relishing the win against Sunshine Athletic Conference opponent Hudson were seniors Jaxson Rivera, Martin Calhoun, Bryan Santiago and Rielly Perez. Three of the four have been Bulldogs for four seasons while Perez has been with the team for three.

"It's a good group of kids," Guynn said. "It's going to be tough to replace them."

All four players were introduced with their families before the game at John F. Clements Field. Each received a wooden bat with their names and Class of 2022 emblazoned on them.

Businesses continue to target Zephyrhills and its growing community

Residential projects are ongoing in east Pasco with several commercial developments already open or under way

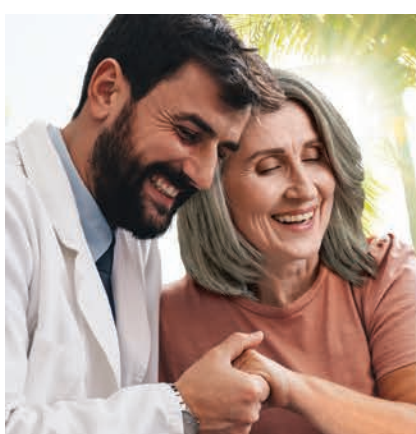
Aside from ongoing residential development in the single-family and multi-family categories, there continues to be an influx of commercial development in Zephyrhills. Those businesses are in the medical, retail, restaurant and sports fields in an area of east Pasco that is constantly expanding of late.

Chiropractors recently expanded to the area from Wesley Chapel, a gymnastics facility opened near the Zephyrhills Municipal Airport and a new Dollar General is going up along Gall Boulevard, not far from another store of its kind just up the road.

Drs. Sean Padgett and Rachel Settles, who already operated Innate Chiropractic & Wellness in Wesley Chapel, took over a facility on 5th Avenue, across the street from the Alice Hall Building at Zephyr Park. Familiarity contributed to that expansion with Padgett, Settles and Dr. Jennifer McDuffie being former classmates at Palmer College of Chiropractic in Daytona Beach.

"(McDuffie) asked if we would like to step in at her practice," said Padgett, noting that McDuffie left due to being pregnant with her fifth child. "We've had our eyes on serving smaller towns in the Tampa area."

Tax collector offices collect over \$13,000 for Fostering Change Foster Closet

During the month of March, the Pasco County Tax Collector's Offices accepted donations totaling \$13,179 on behalf of Fostering Change Foster Closet, a non-profit program. Fostering Change Foster Closet was created to provide children who are removed from their homes and put into foster care to pick up needed clothing, personal care supplies and even food. Based in Pasco County, Fostering Change Foster Closet offers help to any child who has entered foster care and were unable to bring even the most basic of personal care needs from their home at the time of removal.

"Thank you to Mike Fasano, Greg Giordano, Pasco County Tax Collector Office's amazing staff and to this incredible community," said George Agovino, Founder & Director of Fostering Change Foster Closet. "This donation goes directly to helping children in foster care and children and families in need. We could never do any of this without you. Thank you from the bottom of my heart. Our community gives Hope to children/families when they feel there was none."

It is estimated that in the Suncoast Region over 3,900 children are removed from their homes each year and placed into foster care. This is a large portion of the over 6,000 children who enter foster care in the West Central Florida region. Most children stay in foster care for about 13 months until they are reunited with their families or put into permanent placement with a new family. The Fostering Change Foster Closet helps bridge the gap in clothing and supplies for the children during their stay in foster care.

"It was a great honor for our office to feature Fostering Change Foster Closet as our Charity-of-the-Month in March," said tax collector Mike Fasano. "George Agovino and his team have made an impact on the families in the foster care system that can't be measured. 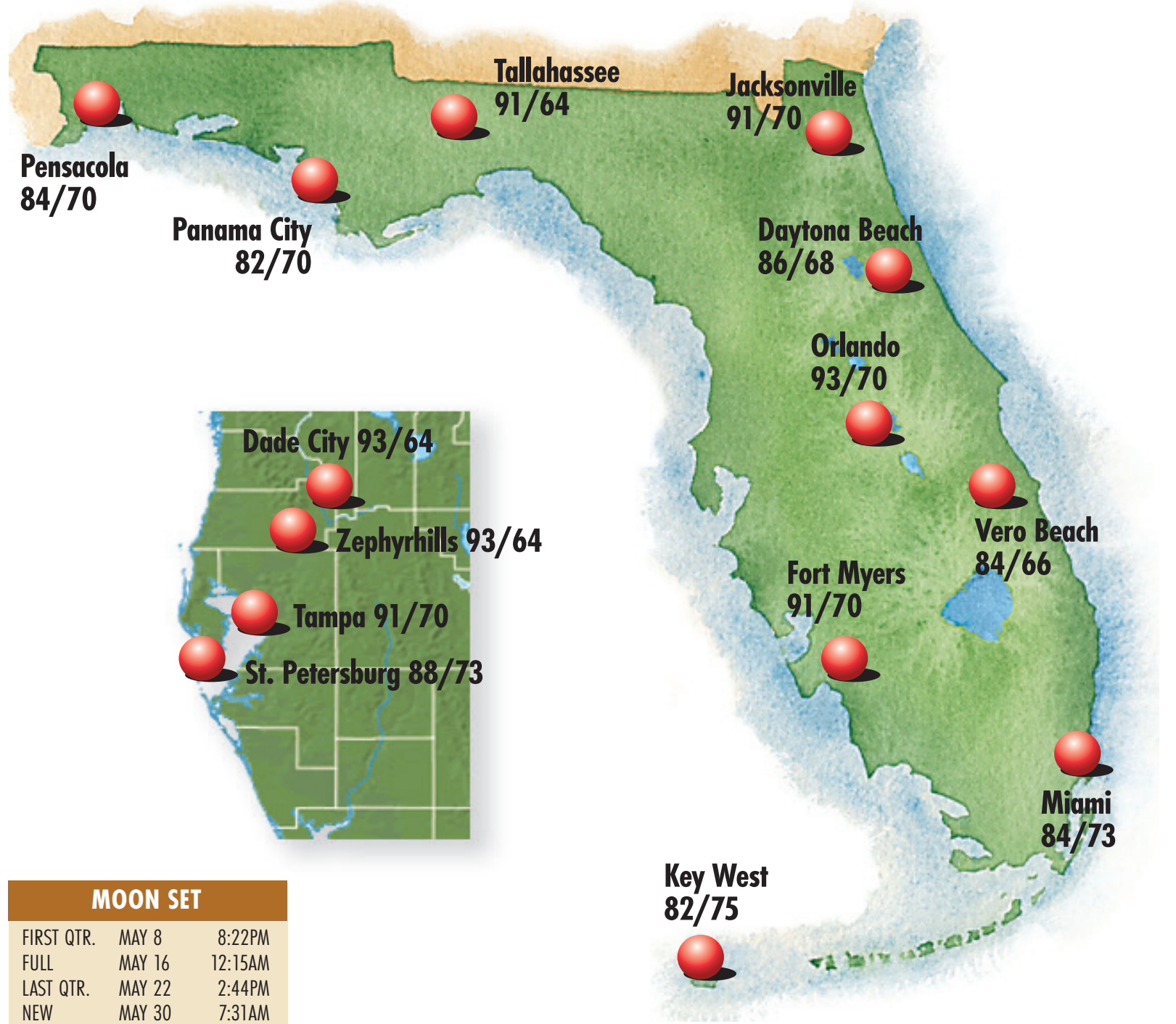

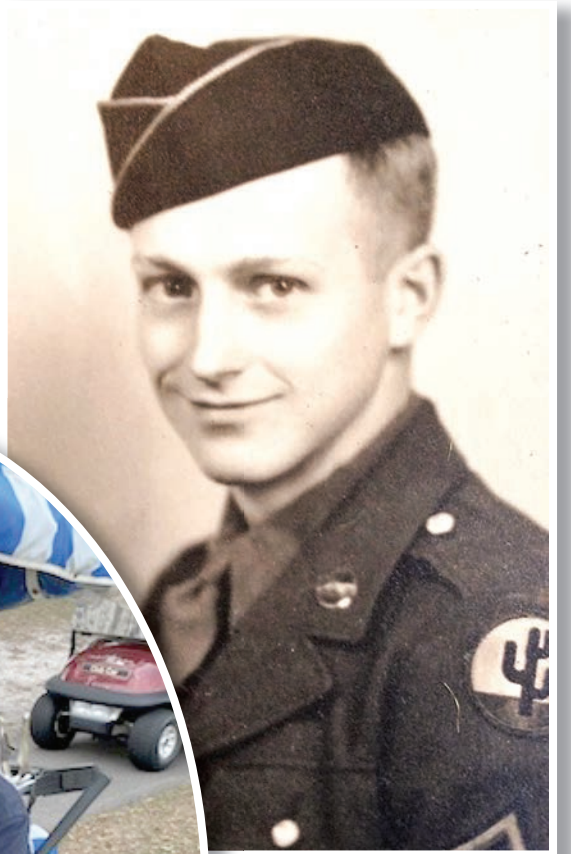

Southport's Centenarian

Gene Poupard served in the Army for several years even being deployed to Europe in the Yankee Division for Chemical Warfare.

Yup. The man is about to turn 100 and he's still out there Hittin' 'Em Straight. And it's not unusual to see him out and about doing yard work or doing some sort of home repair. Gene Poupard, who'll be celebrating his 100th birthday on May 28 certainly is an amazing and inspiring individual. Sharp as a tack and quick witted, he'll definitely give you a run for your money.

Several years ago we did an article about Gene highlighting his military service. For those who don't know Gene and for the newer folks here in Southport. So, here's to a great man with a big heart and a great story:

Gene Poupard grew up on a farm in Monroe, Mich. where he attended Hall of the Divine Child, a private military academy through the eighth grade. He then attended Monroe High School and graduated in 1940. His early education at the military academy along with what was happening in the world (Germany had invaded Poland on Sept. 1, 1939 and two days later on Sept. 3, Great Britain and France declared war on Germany), Gene decided he wanted to join the military and more specifically, he wanted to join the Air Corps.

Following his physical, he was told he was under weight and could not be accepted until he gained a few pounds. He was told eating a lot of bananas and drinking a lot of water would do the trick. Not being someone who accepted defeat, Gene embarked on a plan of action. However, before he was able to gain the necessary weight to qualify, one day his brother came running up to the house from the mailbox carrying a letter from FDR telling Gene he'd been drafted into the Army. So off he went to Camp Claiborne in Forest Hill, La. for 13 weeks.

Something tells me that those early years Gene spent at the military academy paid off; because after only a month in basic training, he was promoted to Private 1st Class. After completing basic training, Gene was assigned

to the combat unit at Camp Howze in Gainsville, Texas and in November 1943 he was deployed to Europe assigned to the Yankee Division for Chemical Warfare where he was promoted to T-5 Tech Sergeant. Like the vast majority of those serving during the "War to End All Wars," Gene was in Europe for the long haul. He found himself on the battlefields of France, Germany, Austria and Italy defending our freedoms as well as the freedoms of our Allies.

He and his fellow soldiers, members of the 103rd Infantry Division liberated the Landau concentration camp located near Welmar, Germany. Gene refused a battlefield commission because he wanted to remain with the guys he'd fought side by side with. Gene emotionally shared a few unsettling stories with me as we spoke.

My own Dad served in the Pacific theater during WWII, and I remember asking him questions about his war years; and now I understand why he wouldn't/couldn't share them with me. And so it is; Gene's stories will forever remain between he and I. Among the list of awarded medals for his service are two Purple Hearts.

Gene was discharged in January 1946. He came home and married his High School sweetheart Alice. He and Alice met while skating on River Raisin, a local gathering spot for young folks back in the day.

But his military story doesn't end there. Gene re-enlisted for three more years and went on to join the Air Force Reserve. This time he didn't have to eat bananas and drink water. The Air Force welcomed him with open arms.

Together, Gene and Alice (who passed away at 96 years young in March 2019) have 12 children, 36 grandchildren, 28 great grandchildren and a great grandchild. Gene was a successful Independent Businessman. He sold Property and Casualty Insurance, was a Financial Planner, a Securities Dealer and a Real Estate Agent. He retired in 1983 at the age of 61. He had (and still has) a passion for antique cars; and I'd venture to guess that his 1926 Model T Touring Car was perhaps his favorite. What an amazing life story.

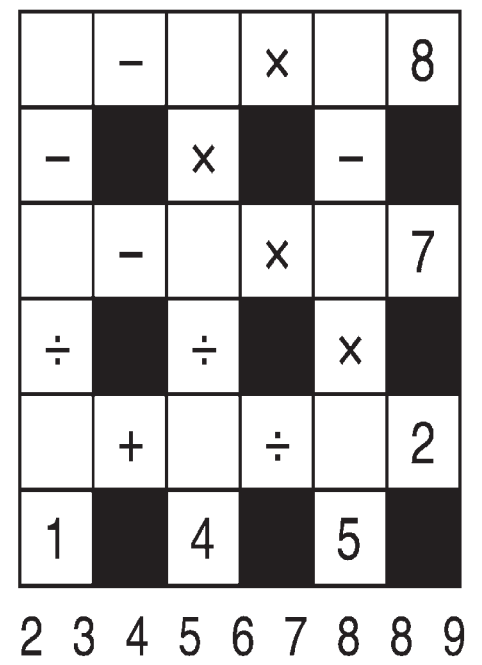

MOMENTS IN TIME

The History Channel

- On May 5, 1904, Cy Young pitches the first perfect game in modern Major League Baseball history as the Boston Americans defeat the Philadelphia Athletics, 3-0. Young's perfect game was part of his then-record 45-inning scoreless streak.
- On May 6, 1991, 51-year-old race car driver Harry Gant betters his own record as the oldest man ever to win a NASCAR event in the Winston 500 in Talladega, Alabama.
- On May 7, 1824, Ludwig van Beethoven's ninth and final symphony debuts at Vienna's Theater am Kärntnertor. Having lost his hearing years earlier, the celebrated composer nonetheless appeared to conduct the first performance of his Ninth Symphony, while the real conductor stood in the wings. Beethoven was several bars off the actual music by the time the piece concluded.
- On May 8, 1933, the first police radio system, connecting headquarters to patrol cars and patrol cars to one another, is installed in Eastchester Township, New York. The system consisted of one transmitter of 20 watts for the headquarters and two transmitters of 4.5 volts each for the two patrol cars.
- On May 9, 1960, the U.S. Food and Drug Administration approves the world's first commercially produced birth-control pill, Enovid-10, made by the G.D. Searle Company of Chicago. Clinical tests of the pill had begun in 1954.

closed out the regular season with a 5-2 victory over Wiregrass Ranch. That gave them eight wins in their last nine games of the regular season.

Perez acknowledged that the team is on a roll of late and said, "We're taking it straight into districts."

They entered the Class 5A, District 10 tournament hosted by Cypress Creek with a 12-4 overall record. Zephyrhills was scheduled to play longtime rival Pasco (3-12), which has struggled of late in the first round of that series.

"We're at a point where we're swinging the bats well," Guynn said. "We're still pitching well and we're playing defense."

Bryan Santiago pitched a complete game, scattering five hits with seven strikeouts and one hit batter. The right-hander did not issue a walk and only one error was made behind him. Santiago only allowed two baserunners in an inning, which came in the top of the sixth.

As for the offense, the Bulldogs came out strong with four runs in the bottom of the first inning to take a commanding early lead. On the second pitch of the game Rivera belted a home run on a towering fly ball over the left field fence.

"I'm swinging for it," he said of hitting a homer on Senior Night. "I'm going big or go home."

Zephyrhills got three more runs in the first. Mark Santiago, a junior and Bryan's brother, doubled to drive in Micah Berrien, who walked.

With two outs and the bases loaded, Mason Denmark drew a walk that plated Mark Santiago and Calhoun hit a sacrifice fly.

Zephyrhills added two runs, increasing its lead to 6-0 in the second. Rivera, who went 3-for-4 with three runs scored and an RBL, doubled and raced home on a double by Mark Santiago, who scored on an error. Santiago wound up with two hits, drove in a pair of runs and scored three times.

Zephyrhills extended its lead to 9-0 with three more runs in the third. Berrien hit a two-run double that scored Calhoun and Rivera and Bryan Santiago singled to drive in Berrien.

Mark Santiago was hit by a pitch in the sixth and came around to score on a wild pitch to account for the final margin.

The Bulldogs, who won just seven games over the previous two seasons, have their first winning record since 2015. In 2016, Zephyrhills won a district title but wound up at 14-14.

"This year it came together," Calhoun said.

Water safety tips from the Pasco Sheriff's Office

Water safety

The warm and sunny Pasco weather is perfect for days on the water. However, it creates possible dangers for those who do not know how to swim. Fatal drowning rates continue to increase each year. Residential locations, such as a child's home, a family or friend's house or a neighbor's residence count for 71 percent of fatal drowning incidents. The Pasco Sheriff's Office wants everyone to review the following water safety tips in order to reduce the chances of injury or death around water.

Stay alert

Many drowning fatalities can be prevented by adult supervision. Children shouldn't be unattended in or near water. Rather than assume someone else is watching a child in a pool area, designate an adult water watcher. This person shouldn't be distracted in any way and should have a charged phone nearby for emergencies. Although swimming lessons and life preservers are important for water safety, there is no substitute for adult supervision. Additionally, don't leave objects, such as toys near pools, docks, canals or other bodies of water, which can draw a child's attention towards water.

Water safety skills

Learning to swim is crucial for water safety. Between 2015-2017, children younger than 5 years old account for 75 percent of child drownings. Ensuring that children know how to swim and know the rules of pool or water safety are vital for reducing water-related incidents. Establishing clear rules with children, such as don't climb pool fences or stay off of docks while playing can aid in safety as well.

Another way to ensure safety while enjoying water-related activities is knowing CPR and updating these skills regularly. Additionally, keeping rescue equipment and a first aid kit pool-side or easily accessible at all times can help prevent serious injury or death. Starting life-saving procedures prior to emergency personnel's arrival can increase someone's chances of living.

Appropriate equipment

Proper fences, alarms and pool covers are crucial for water safety. Check to make sure all drain covers are secure before entering a pool or spa. Use at least four-foot high fence with self-closing and self-latching gates around all pools. Never prop open gates that lead to water or leave furniture where a child could use it to climb over the fence. Use covers and install alarms, such as a wave-activated alarm in the pool or an alarm on the door



leading from the house to the pool. Ensure all life-saving equipment, such as life rings or reaching poles are in good condition and readily available for use.

Padgett noted that, with him being from a small town in northwest Florida, he relished being in a place like Zephyrhills. He likes the community and identity of the city and its surroundings.

Elsewhere, JAMM Gymnastics has opened off Airport Road. It offers tot, pre-school and recreational gymnastics classes. Additionally, there is a nine-week summer camp program, as well as birthday parties and other arrangements.

The grand opening, complete with a ribbon-cutting that included members of the Greater Zephyrhills Chamber of Commerce, took place April 30.

"We are thrilled to have this new business here in Zephyrhills," said Melonie Monson, the chamber's president. "It is a game-changer for our families who are looking for activities for their children right here in our backyard. We are looking forward to watching them grow and build partnerships with our schools to bring the much-needed extracurricular activity to our youth."

JAMM Gymnastics actually is the second gymnastics facility in Zephyrhills. East Pasco Gymnastics, which also offers cheerleading, recently placed young athletes in state competitions.

Additionally, at the northwest corner of U.S. 301 and Pretty Pond Road site approval has been given for

retail and restaurant usage. Vande Berg said in addition to a car wash at that location, plans call for a Tijuana Flats and a Dunkin' Donuts.

As has been the case in recent years, residential development is flourishing in Zephyrhills. The most recent projects are Tyson Townhomes with about 100 units, according to city planner Todd Vande Berg, going up across from the city's police station off 8th Street.

The other residential development is for 200 apartments that are being planned for Fort King Road, just north of Eiland Boulevard. Vande Berg, who has worked for the city since 1996, and said there have been no new apartments during that span, mentioning that there also will be apartments in the Zephyr Commons area.

"We were probably lacking in some multi-family (options)," Vande Berg said. "The market for multi-family and apartments and townhomes is pretty hot. It is now in Zephyrhills too."

Meanwhile, work is ongoing at several construction projects off Simonds Road. In addition to single-family and multi-family developments on both sides of that road as well as off Eiland Boulevard to the east, a building for dormitories is being built adjacent to the Sarah Vande Berg Tennis & Wellness Center.
