Zephyrhills Little League reaches midpoint of season

League president informs players, coaches and families about all-star cancellations for regionals and nationals

It's a typical Monday night in the Zephyrhills Little League with four of five ballfields occupied. They are filled with baseball and softball players with three practices under way and a junior baseball game being played.

Two softball teams, the Major Yellow Jackets and Senior Blue Dogs, go through practice drills as the sun sets. The Yellow Jackets and Blue Dogs are trying to improve on their records of 4-3-1 and 4-4, respectively.

Meanwhile, the Minor Baseball Braves work on fielding and running drills on a nearby field. They have lost their first eight games and seek their first victory.

"We're still in search of our first win," said assistant coach Tim Mericle as he hit baseballs to fielders and other players lined up to run the bases.

Kristen Polanco, another assistant coach, notes that the seaso is about much more than wins and losses: "Every other team likes to play us, because we like to have fun."

As for the softball teams, the Blue Dogs were released a bit earlier than expected with coach Chris Matthew saying, "They've been doing good. I think they're just tired today. It's good to get back out

here, getting them ready for high school."

The Yellow Jackets took fielding drills with coach Shannon Oney going over situational baserunning. In the field helping the young softball players with their positioning and instructions on which base to throw to was Paige Transue, a 2015 Zephyrhills High graduate who played for the Bulldogs after years spent in the local

"It's very rewarding to take the girls from the beginning of the season and watch them grow. It's like a gift," she said. "I get to teach

the girls to love the game that I loved growing up playing." Another struggling team in the league is the Junior Baseball

Residents dump unwanted items in city cleanup

Revived effort, a project canceled twice within the past year, took place on Saturday at Shepard Park

For the first time since March of 2019 the city organized a cleanup effort for Zephyrhills residents. The general consensus of the long-awaited project being that it was about time.

The coronavirus pandemic led to the cancellation of plans for two cleanups this past year. On Saturday from 8 a.m. to noon at Shepard Park, city workers were available to collect trash and debris, which included metals, tires and various other items.

"It's unfortunate because we have to help the residents as much as we can," Mike Sutton, a code enforcement officer, said of the missed cleanups. "It really helps our job out. A lot of people don't want to make the trip out to Handcart (for the East Pasco County Recycling & Transfer Station). It's nice for us and for them to bring stuff. We say we'll make the trip for them."

Sutton was quick to point out the contributions of the city's public works department, which provided workers and oversaw the project.

"We wouldn't be able to pull this off without the public works," Sutton said. "They came out and brought out the equipment, the dumpsters, the man-power. We couldn't do it without them."

Shane LeBlanc, the city's public works director who has oversees the projects, reported the cleanup

Bulldogs, Neal advance to state track meet

Zephyrhills advanced the 4*x*100 meter relay team as well as hurdler Maguire Neal to the state meet at the *University of North Florida*

It was a blistering hot day in Eagle Lake, just south of Lakeland for the Class 3A Region 2 track meet at Lake Region High School. Zephyrhills runners and jumpers had the luxury of competing on the same track for their district meet but it could not have prepared them for the overwhelming temperatures beating down on the track and infield at the high school.

"I think the heat was exhausting,"

boys head coach Bryan Thomas said. "We think Clayton (Cornelius) might have had

Thomas said that Cornelius, after his 400 meter race, threw up and then could not keep any water down for several minutes afterward. While Cornelius managed to finish his wheelhouse race in 50.33 to grab fifth place, it was not fast enough to advance the senior to states. Worse yet, it forced Thomas to scratch Cornelius from the 4x400 meter relay, where he thought his boys had a good shot at making states. Cornelius would have been the anchor leg on the relay but they sunk to 10th place in his absence.

More misfortune struck the Bulldogs when high jumper Maya Llanes was not given a bid to qualify for the state meet. In Thomas' words, Lake Region assigned a volunteer to judge the high jump that was





not a certified official. Thus, the FHSAA scrubbed all the marks from the Region 2 female high jumpers. Only the event champion and the runner up, who otherwise are automatic bids, advanced to states. Llanes' 1.53 meter jump would have qualified her but her mark, as well as the marks of the other jumpers not finishing first and second, were scrubbed, leaving the event at states with just 14 competitors. There are 16 in all other events.

Controversy continued when triple jumper Tymar McKever had his best jump of the afternoon called a scratch by the volunteer raking the sand jump pit, as opposed to the event official. The event official is supposed to be the one that decides if a jumper touches the line or not. This decision was made by the guy with the rake and he then raked over the mark McKever had left, leaving Thomas no recourse to challenge the decision.

"I thought the jump was close to 14 meters (13.66 meters won the event)," Thomas said.

Pasco junior Darrien Smith wound up winning the event. Smith trained at Zephyrhills the week leading up to regionals as

the track at Pasco High is still under construction. It wasn't all doom and gloom. Junior Maguire Neal had a whale of the day sweeping both hurdle events and placing third in the open 100 meter. Neal hit 14.72 to win the 110 meter high hurdles and 39.23 to win the 300 meter hurdles. The 14.72 was just off of Neal's personal record of 14.51 and Thomas is con-

ing to run against the clock. "He (Neal) runs faster when he's pushed," Thomas said. "I had him sitting at fourth (going into states) if he can run against

cerned that Neal might end up in the slower heat at states, hav-

The FHSAA is not running event finals at states but rather a faster and a slower heat with the best times taking the places. Neal could end up in the slower heat but he will have the advan-

tage of having competed at states before. 'It's his (Neal's) second time at states, he knows what he has

to do," Thomas said. Neal's 39.23 in the 300 meter hurdles won regionals and was more than a second faster than the second place runner. Neal's 10.87 in the 100 meter is a personal record, even though he might not run that race through in order to focus on his hurdle races. Neal will also anchor the 4x100 meter relay, which took second at regionals behind Orlando Jones High School. The other three runners, Willie Queen, TJ Jackson and Cornelius helped put together a 42.59, just shy of the school record of 42.27. It was their season best and while the relay might not make the podium this weekend, they stand a very good chance to break the school re-

"They might just shock themselves," Thomas said.



Try this tasty recipe for 'Cold Mango Soufflés Topped with Toasted Coconut" from "The Complete Mexican, South American & Caribbean Cookbook" (Metro Books) by Jane Milton, Jenni Fleetwood and Marina Filippelli.

COLD MANGO SOUFFLÉS TOPPED WITH TOASTED COCONUT

(Makes 4)

- small mangoes, peeled, pitted and chopped
- tablespoons water
- tablespoon powdered gelatine egg yolks
- 1/2 cup superfine sugar
- 1/2 cup milk

cups heavy cream

Grated rind of one orange Toasted flaked or coarsely shredded coconut, to decorate

Place a few pieces of mango in the base of each of four 2/3-cup ramekins. Wrap a creased collar of nonstick parchment paper around the outside of each dish, extending well above the rim. Secure with adhesive tape, then tie tightly

Pour the water into a small heatproof bowl and sprinkle the gelatine over the surface.



Leave for 5 minutes or until spongy. Place the bowl in a pan of hot water, stirring occasionally, until the gelatine has dissolved.

Meanwhile, whisk the egg yolks with the superfine sugar and milk in another heatproof bowl. Place the bowl over a pan of simmering water and continue to whisk until the mixture is thick and frothy. Remove from the heat and continue whisking until the mixture cools. Whisk in the liquid gelatine.

Puree the remaining mango pieces in a food processor or blender, then fold the puree into the egg yolk mixture with the orange rind. Set the mixture aside until starting to thicken.

Whip the heavy cream to soft peaks. Reserve 4 tablespoons and fold the rest into the mango mixture. Spoon into the ramekins until the mixture is 1 inch above the rim of each dish. Chill for 3 to 4 hours, or until set.

Carefully remove the paper collars from the soufflés. Spoon a little of the reserved cream on top of each soufflé and decorate with some toasted flaked or coarsely shredded coconut.





HOLLYWOOD -- Here we go again! Remember when HBO Max considered dropping "Gone With the Wind" from its playlist because a film director of color objected to the depiction of slaves in that classic film? Now an article in The National Review called TCM Movies "an enemy of film watchers because they've succumbed to political fashion because of films that were made before 'wokeness.' This process reexamines the vagaries of art with disapproval. They're looking for flaws, errors and offenses." The internet has given voice to people who have a right to opine but not to demand censorship. Such as the those who suggested "Grease" be banned because it was "sexist, homophobic and slut shaming."

TCM hosts often appear before or after films with comments about the making of the film or its stars, but they also can go too far. We need to do something to stop this "cancel culture" before all the great films and books have been picked apart ... as in Ray Bradbury's brilliant "Fahrenheit 451," which was about burning books because the government wanted to keep people illiterate!

Speaking of classics, Oscarwinning actress Helen Mirren (for "The Queen"), now 75, hits big screens June 25 in "F9," followed by ""White Bird: A Wonder Story," with Gillian Anderson, before taking on Golda Meir in "Golda." Nobody has played the former Israeli prime minister since Ingrid Bergman won an Emmy for "A Woman Named Golda" (1982). Meir lived to be 80, leaving "lots of wiggle room" for Mirren.

numbers. In all, there were 70 driveups with people dropping off 50 cubic yards of waste, 64 tires, 12 televisions, three appliances and two lawnmowers.

"It's a team effort for all city departments to get something done like that," he said.

Several residents who pulled up in their vehicles to drop off items expressed their gratitude for the city's community-wide effort.

Bill Shannon pulled up in his truck and dropped off some metal, a lawn mower and an old go-kart frame.

"It's very convenient," he said, adding that "I usually wait (for the cleanup)."

"I think this is incredible," added Paul Turner, another resident who pulled up with unwanted items in the back of his truck. "I would've had to pay \$40 at Angelo's (Recycled Materials in Dade City) to dump this stuff. My wife found this on Facebook and I couldn't believe the luck I had."

Bettie and Scott Messer also got word about the cleanup through Facebook. Bettie's mother, Tammy Harrington, saw it online and recommended they bring some of their yard debris, metal and drywall.

"My mom said you guys need to get rid of that stuff," Bettie said. "This is very conve-

The Messers also were appreciative of the generosity of the city employees, who refused to accept donations or help with the unloading

"We offered to get out and help them, but they said to stay in the truck," Scott said. The process was for city residents only.

To ensure that, Denise Finch, a customer service representative for public works, along with environmental stormwater coordinator Amy Knoechelman, verified licenses for people dropping things off.

Everyone's so excited and thankful we're doing this," Finch said.
"We've had a couple of people who have

been through here five times," Knoechelman

In the past, the cleanups have been set up at various sites throughout the city. The previous one took place at the former SunTrust Bank

building off Gall Boulevard. "They switch it up just to get out where people can see it," Knoechelman said of the lo-

With no organized cleanups for more than a year, Rob Funnell, the streets and stormwater superintendent, noted how city workers have had to drive around and pick up large items off the sides of roads.

'This right here is going to help us out a lot," he said.
